Dear Editor

The Changing Face of Hagley

In response to the letter from Mrs P Wilkins in the August issue we have sought clarification of the exact meaning of "SPG10" from the Planning Department of Bromsgrove District Council. Their reply is as follows:-

SPG10 - Managing Housing Supply

"This guidance was introduced by the District Council in July 2003 in response to the number of dwellings that were gaining planning permission. Like all Councils, the District Council has to allow a specified number of new houses to be built over a set number of years. In Bromsgrove District the number required to 2011 had been reached so a 'moratorium' on further housing was imposed.

The Council had legal advice to suggest that where planning applications had been lodged i.e. were 'underway' before the guidance came into force it could not be used. A challenge in the courts would be likely to succeed at considerable expense to the Council.

The guidance has now been in force for 2 years and has curtailed virtually all new housing development. The application for retirement apartments in Park Road has been refused permission because of the guidance and for other reasons. It is impossible to say what decision will be made because the Inspector holding the enquiry will have to weigh up the various arguments. However, the housing moratorium has been successful in appeal cases to date."

We hope that this explanation of the position will offer some reassurance to your readers.
