





POLICING IN HAGLEY

We are currently seeing an increase in the thefts of satellite navigation systems from vehicles.

These are the standalone systems that attach to the dashboard and are obviously a new and expensive technology that is a popular purchase at the moment. Because of this they are also a target for theft and offenders are simply smashing car windows and removing them.

If you have a system, we are suggesting that is it is easily removable then you simply remove it and keep it safe elsewhere. Also we would like you to mark the item, using an ultra violet pen, with your postcode, the number of your house and vehicle registration number. We are looking to distribute pens and stickers warning that the system is post coded in an effort to discourage thefts.

This is a national problem but we need to take a personal responsibility for it. We have found that the retailers are dragging their feet with the security issue, as they sell more when they have been stolen. Insurance premiums may also increase and no claims bonuses may be in jeopardy.

Please help to keep your property safe.
