





Dear Editor

We finally finsihed, after eighteen months, "The Hagley Parish Plan".

Government Regulations suggest that a Parish Plan Committee should consist of 10 persons, including 2 members of the Parish Council.

Some hope! The Parish Plan Committee consisted for the main part of three Parish Councillors later increased to four, and five members of the public. Another three members arrived at various stages.

For all those individuals and organisations who have complained about various isues in Hagley e.g. Development, Traffic, Facilities, Policing, Parking etc. this was an opportunity missed. Let us hope that at the next Parish Plan, there will be more active members of the public willing to serve.

A 28% response to the Questionnaire! Should we have done better? Perhaps. Next time more people will have a better understanding of the purpose of such a questionnaire and provide for a greater response.

As one of the members of the public and coming from a family whose parents have both served on the Parish Council, I consider that the Parish Plan should go some way to halting future development. There is, however, a need for some of the very accomplished people whom we have living here, to take a greater interest in their village. The Parish Council is still short of members and needs an influx of fresh blood to fight Hagley's corner and lessen the existing Parish Councillors workload.

There is a need for a more active and effective Residents' Association. Surely this could be one organisation where your qualities would be well served. The Park Road development is still around and when the appeal is held, we need large numbers of people there to make sure that it is again refused.

Watch out for the next Parish Plan in six years time andd do your best to participate. Offer your services, as a Parish Councillor, Member of the Residents' Association or whatever, between now and then to ensure that Hagley maintains its Village Environment.
