DEAR EDITOR

Dear Editor

Firstly apologies for not replying to Mr Gemmill's letter published in the August edition of Hagley Village News.

We have been investigating the facts about the question of the application for planning permission for development of the former sewerage farm site made in December 1999. Neither of us were District Councillors at the time and virtually all the then Planning Department staff at Bromsgrove have moved on, so these investigations have not been simple or without cost to the Council Tax payers of Bromsgrove District. The reason that the application was not processed within the recommended eight week time period was that at that particular time there was a great deal of turnover of Planning Department staff. The officer assigned to the application left in April 2000, the Head of Development Control left in February 2000 and various other staff were leaving, on maternity leave or changing departments. Consequently there was a huge backlog of undetermined applications (some 180 applications – incidentally a situation I can assure readers has long since been extremely well addressed.)

When the application went to appeal, Bromsgrove Council argued against the application, just as it probably would have done if it had considered it within the time limit. So the fact that the application was not determined would appear to have made no difference as without doubt it would have gone to appeal anyway.

Mr Gemmill has been corresponding copiously with Councillor Scurrell on the topic of the development of the Sewerage Farm over 4 or 5 years. This has entailed many hours of investigation by Bromsgrove Council officers. No substantive allegations have been made by him and in our opinion the officers' efforts would accordingly have been much better spent on more productive endeavours for the benefit of the Council Tax payers of Bromsgrove District as a whole. We therefore now regard this correspondence at an end.



I have not received reports of crimes or attempted crimes; I trust this is a good sign and not just a failure of incidents being reported to local co-ordinators.



HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

The February meeting of the Society saw the return of Mr. Trevor Antill to give his talk on "The Monarch's Way Part III. The South Coast, South Downs And Escape".

This was the final part of Mr. Antill's account of King Charles II escape to France after his defeat at the battle of Worcester.

At the end of part II Charles and his party had reached the beach at Charmouth in Dorset, but with no boat available, and the Parliamentary troops in pursuit, they were forced to move on. Mr. Antill described how they now proceeded East across the South Downs finally arriving at Shorham near Brighton, where a boat was found to carry the King to safety in France. In this hazardous journey the King was escorted and given shelter by his loyal supporters at great risk to themselves. The whole 615 miles of the Monarch's Way is now well marked for walking and Mr. Antill illustrated his talk with a selection of slides showing many of the historic sites and some of the fine scenery along the route.


