

Annual Parish Meeting

This was held on March 20th at the Community Centre. There were reports on the activities of the Parish, District and County Councils. Unfortunately only five residents attended. This was disappointing, especially for the Parish Councillors who give their time free in the interests of the village and its residents.

Play Area

Work is starting on the new play area. It is due to be completed by the date of the Village Fete in July. Please stay clear of the site whilst works are in progress. The new facilities will be well worth waiting for.

Planning Applications

As many of you will be aware, the plan to knock down houses in Park Road and replace them with blocks of retirement flats was turned down by Bromsgrove District Council but then went to appeal. We understand that a local public hearing into this appeal will be held in June (exact date not yet available). More details as soon as we get them, we need as many residents as possible to attend this hearing, to raise comments and objections.

Parking

Hagley Parish Council is working hard with the Police, the Highways Authority and the District Council to improve the parking situation in the village. We shall be conducting a survey on the use of the Worcester Road car park. Please cooperate if you are asked questions, it will help us to make the best use of this facility. We are also working with the other bodies to improve the conditions of the roads and pavements where possible.

PACT meeting

The First Police and Communities Together (PACT) meeting was held in March. This Police led initiative has set the first three priorities as:

- Speeding
- 2. Vandalism in the Railway Station
- Parking/stopping/waiting (mainly outside schools)
 The next meeting will be in June, watch out for the posters.

Village enhancements

Hanging baskets will be going up along Worcester Road this month and you will soon see more colourful displays at the entrances to the village. If you have any more suggestions on how to brighten up the village, please let me know.

CLENT PARISH COUNCIL

FINANCE

BDC has advised that the Grant for Concurrent Functions for 2006/07 will be 50% less than received for 2005/06. Concurrent Functions are those items for which the Parish and the District has responsibility for example grass cutting and street lighting.

PLANNING MATTERS

1. BDC has granted the following applications:-

2005/1095 - Ext - 17 Newfield Road

2005/1114 - Alt. to form room in roof space - 62 Pinewoods Avenue.

2. Application for Council's comments:-

2006/0055 – Replacement Dwelling - 37 Western Road – Council objected on the grounds that increases density as it is larger than the footprint of original building. Could lead to two dwellings.

CENTENARY FIELD

Proposed Cricket Pitch - A working party has met to discuss the way forward with the planning conditions and how the responsibilities will be arranged.

HIGHWAYS

- I. Pinewoods Avenue Traffic Calming letter received from WCC Highways partnership Unit to advise that, due to objections received, the works have been cancelled.
- 2. Western Road/Brookland Road junction letter received expressing concern at the traffic parked at the junction. Council had already alerted PC Lord about the problem. Councillors will be checking the situation.

STREET LIGHTING

The new lamp installed in Western Road is now working. Baffle strips have been inserted for the benefit of adjacent properties.

POLICING IN HAGLEY

I have mentioned in previous issues about the changes in local policing and that our division is a

pathfinder for that process. One aim was to consult the community to establish some local priorities. As a result, on the 13th of March we held our first community meeting in Hagley.

The process we adopted is called PACT, Partners and Communities Together. The principle is that a panel of people drawn from the community, including elected representatives, the police and other partners, ask those present which issues they want to highlight as problems. Those issues are written down and when they are all documented everyone votes for whichever issue concerns them most. All the votes are counted and the panel decides which three issues, with the most votes, to take forward. After three months the panel report back on progress.

The three issues taken from the meeting were speeding, parking and damage at the railway station. Speeding was highlighted in Worcester Road and parking in Brake Lane, Park Road and Worcester Road, generally around school times.

As I write we have just started to address the issues but so far we have made progress. We have contacted British Transport Police (BTP) and Network Rail regarding the Station and they will be dealing with the damage. I have asked our traffic department to look at the speeding issue and officers have so far issued 5 fixed penalty notices for parking offences.

The next meeting will be in June and I will circulate the date as soon as possible.

HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On March 7th society members heard Mr. Roger Pendrill give a talk on "The Pendrills of Boscabel". Mr Pendrill is a direct descendant of Richard Pendrill, one

of the five brothers who assisted Charles II in his escape to France after his defeat at the battle of Worcester in 1651. The brothers were tenant farmers at Boscabel House in Shropshire, a property owned by the Giffords, a loyal Catholic family. Mr. Pendrill described the events leading up to the battle and to the subsequent escape (via Stourbridge) to Boscabel. The house was amply provided with hiding places to shelter priests, but even these were not totally secure; consequently at one point the King had to spend all day hiding in an oak tree. The problem of concealing the King's identity was compounded by the fact that he was unusually tall, at 6ft 4ins, the average height then being about 5ft 8. To hide this he was taught to walk with a stoop aided by a stick. Eventually, disguised as a manservant the King was smuggled past searching parliamentarian troops to Bristol and eventually to safety.

After the restoration of the monarchy the Pendrills were duly rewarded for their efforts with pensions.






