DEAR EDITOR

St. Saviour's Church - Disabled Discrimination Act Building Works

As well as being a place of worship, St Saviour's Church is a focal point for the village of Hagley.

The Disability Discrimination Act 1995 requires us to take reasonable steps to make physical changes to our buildings to ensure equality of access for disabled people. Plans have been drawn up to add a new access ramp and refurbish the existing toilets incorporating a toilet for the disabled. Our fundraising target for the work needed is £30,000.00

We are seeking financial support from the community by asking if people could sponsor a part of the building. The following table comprises a list of 13 sections of the building. People can sponsor units of work varying from $\mathfrak{L}2$ - $\mathfrak{L}20$ per unit. If people can gift aid their donation, then for every 4 units sponsored, we are able to build 5 units:-

External Ramp	£20.00 per inch
Asbestos Removal	£3.50 per square foot
Demolitions & Alterations	£5.00 per square foot
Drainage Works	£4.00 per inch
Internal Walls	£5.00 per square foot
Floor Finishes	£5.00 per square foot
Wall Finishes	£3.20 per square foot
Wall Tiling	£5.00 per tile
New Ceilings	£2.50 per square foot
Electrical Work	£10.00 per foot of cable
Plumbing Work	£2.00 per inch of new pipe
External Paths	£2.00 per inch of path
External Steps	£2.50 per inch of step

Traffic Chaos in West Hagley

You will recall that you published in the November issue of the Hagley Village News my letter dated 28th September 2005 concerning traffic congestion in West Hagley which had been all too evident for some years and especially on Worcester Road B4187, part of which forms the village shopping street where congestion frequently reaches saturation level.

Subsequently Hagley Parish Council has demanded action to deal with the amount of traffic along "Hagley's congestion-hit village centre" and have put forward a series of proposals in the Hagley Parish Plan 2005.

I understand that as the recent Hagley Parish Plan has no formal status it is a matter for Worcestershire County Council as local highway authority to adopt and implement the acceptable highway proposals in that plan.

So again the question in need of urgent response is – precisely how does Worcestershire County Council as local highway authority intend to resolve this problem of intolerable traffic congestion in West Hagley?

Hopefully Worcestershire County Council's Chief Executive or Member for Hagley will be able to provide you with a substantial response for publication in the forthcoming edition of the Hagley Village News.
