

# HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

# Park Road Planning Appeal

The appeal by Pegasus Retirement Homes against the refusal by Bromsgrove District Council to grant permission to demolish 25, 27 and 29 Park Road and build 46 retirement apartments was held on 13th - 16th June. Parish Councillors put our objections to the Inspector and now we have to wait for the decision, estimated to be about five weeks after the hearing.

The Parish Council believes that we could not have been better prepared and represented. There was also representation made by Bromsgrove District Council, the District Councillors, CRPE, Hagley First School, residents and the committee of the Hagley Parish Plan.

Thanks to all residents who sent in comments and to those who attended the hearing. We will keep you informed of the decision.

# Play Area

The long awaited refurbishment of the play area is now completed and offers a wide range of colourful and imaginative play equipment. It was not without its problems, but the Parish Council now hopes that it brings a welcome benefit to the community. Thank you to all those who responded to our requests for suggestions. We hope you are pleased with the result.

Please look after it, it should provide a safe and enjoyable play environment for all for many years to come.

## Dogs

Dog fouling is still a problem in the village, particularly on the playing field. There are red bins provided for dog waste disposal, please use them. Under our bye laws the Parish Council are considering imposing a dog control order, which would result in fines being charged, as the culprits will be picked up on the CCTV. Make sute it's not you.

#### Litter

The Parish Council is launching a campaign to deal with the problem of litter in the village. We are asking shops, businesses, schools and all the residents to join us in keeping our village clean, and a pleasant place to live and to visit.

Litter and dog fouling are aspects of anti-social behaviour and we can work together as a community to reduce this. Everybody can also help by reporting vandalism, under age drinking, drinking in the alcohol free zones, graffiti etc to the police. Call Crimestoppers on 0800 555111 (this is a free call and you do not need to leave your name) or call 08457 444888 and ask for Hagley or report an incident. Where possible the CCTV will be used to investigate reports.

# HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On Tuesday June 6th the Society welcomed Mr. Ron Moss to give his talk on "Wind And Water Mills". Mr Moss has travelled far and wide, including Europe, photographing the various types of mills and with the aid of his slides he described their mechanisms and

functions. Being a keen member of the Black Country Society he was particularly interested in the water mills of the River Stour. The mills of the Stour were built, mainly, to power forges and they produced various metal products, from edge tools to gun barrels. At their peak, in the 19th century, there were numerous mills on the river; but technology slowly overtook them and by the 1950s very few remained. To show how it used to be Mr. Moss played a video of some rare archive film taken in 1956, of scythe making at Belbroughton; the work practices in use then would not be allowed today. Today there are no commercially operating mills on the river.

There is no meeting of the society in August; the next one is on Tuesday September 5th at which Mr. R. Key will talk about "The Clay Pipe Makers of Broseley". New members and visitors are all welcome at St. Saviour's church hall, 8.00 p.m. Visitors £1.50 including refreshments. Annual membership £7.00.

# **SCHOOL NEWS**





The governors at Haybridge recommend that our school should become a Foundation School. Foundation Schools can become Trust Schools, and can be seen as a 'stepping stone' from one to the other. This status has many implications such as what happens to the land of the Park Road site. If Haybridge becomes a Foundation School, the school would own this land. The government's 14-19 education policy has a much greater emphasis on vocational subjects; we fully support this policy, but we need the space and facilities to deliver the new

curriculum. We would like to develop a state-of-the-art Vocational and ICT centre, and make these facilities available to the wider community. By becoming a Foundation School, we would also have greater influence over the usage of the Sports Hall, and more control over any future school buildings at Haybridge.

In June we had two successful intakes for years 7 and 12. The Intake evening for year 7 was an important occasion where students got to meet their tutors and parents asked questions about the school. At the induction day for year 12 Summer Tasks were given in preparation for their courses.

We are now running workshops for parents of Haybridge students. The first meeting was about drugs and local issues and the idea is to form links within the community and to keep parents better informed.
