Worcester Road

We hope you have noticed how much cleaner and brighter the main Worcester Road through the village is. The Parish Council is continuing with seasonal planting and a programme of improvements. The new wall and railings at Victoria Passage are now complete and with the help of the Girl Guides, shrubs and bulbs have also been planted around there, with more bulbs in the grass beside Happy Families.

Christmas tree

Due to financial constraints, Bromsgrove District Council will not provide a Christmas tree for the village this year. The Parish Council will be buying a tree and more lights.

Planning

In October, the Parish Council objected to the following planning application:

B/2006/1023 West Hagley Streetworks (A491 Roundabout), Park Road

Installation of a radio base station comprising a 12.5m High Streetworks column, three antennae, one 200mm diameter dish antenna, radio equipment housing and development ancillary thereto – telecommunications notification.

We have also written to the planning department concerning the new building at 1 Eton Walk, which is not, in our view, or as stated in the planning permission, a Dormer Bungalow. Hagley Parish Council would like to wish all residents and visitors a very Happy Christmas.

A CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

Not far behind the seasonal figure of Santa Claus, or Father Christmas, is the historical figure of St Nicholas, who lived at the turn of the 3rd and 4th centuries in what is now south-western Turkey. The association is based on Nicholas' patronage of children, and on the custom in the Low Countries of giving them presents on his feast-day. It's difficult to know now how many of the stories to do with his life are actually strictly true, but one thing we do know about him is that he was committed to helping the poor of his day.

Something that's really taken off in the last few years – and which links the tradition of giving presents with Nicholas' concern for the poor – is the idea of giving alternative Christmas presents. Rather than giving a present to someone who already has more than they need, Christian Aid (and other organisations) suggest that we give a present which would be gratefully received in a poor part of the world. You can buy 16 ducks for a family in Bangladesh, a herd of goats for farmers in Bolivia, a bicycle for someone in Malawi, or a water tap for a community in Nicaragua, and have a card sent to your friend or relative to say what you've done (instead of giving them a present). If you're interested in helping the poor in this way this Christmas, there are "Present Aid" catalogues in both our churches.
