



Dear Editor,

It is evident that Bromsgrove District Council both at Member and Officer level will never, for whatever reason, give a logical answer as to why they granted themselves planning permission in 1993 for the residential development of land adjoining the Sewage Works, but then objected at the local planning Inquiry in October 2000 to the development of houses on the disused Sewage Works site. Consequently the residents of this part of West Hagley are left to form their own conclusions!

Nevertheless the development of the area is now nearly completed and as will be seen from the letter published in the November issue of the Village News from the resident in Church Street, access to and egress from the Milestone Drive extensive estate of culs-de-sac is wholly inadequate.

Of course we, the long established residents, well remember that this was not only the view of but was the advice given by the local highway authority, Worcestershire County Council, to the local planning authority, Bromsgrove District Council, in 1993 when Bromsgrove District Council in their wisdom spurned that advice and granted themselves planning permission for the residential develoment of the cordon sanitaire.

So the questions now arising - how and when are the serious traffic congestion problems thus caused in Church Street and in the village shopping street to be resolved?



HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On Tuesday 7th November the Society welcomed Mr. George Hook to talk to us about "The World of Mother of Pearl". Mr Hook informed us that there had once been some 200 factories and workshops in Birmingham manufacturing mother of pearl products.

The main item of production had been the pearl button, consequently the introduction of the plastic button had a devastating effect on the industry, gradually it declined until today Mr. Hook's company (established in 1824) is the only one left and he is the only employee. Mr. Hook described the methods of manufacture and showed us the various shells he used in the process such as oyster, abalone, trocus and sea snail: these were passed around the audience for examination, with some examples of his work. Today large-scale manufacture cannot compete with goods imported from the low wage far eastern countries and so Mr. Hook specialises in making custom jewellery and fine fashion items, a selection of which he displayed after the talk.

Mr. Hook delivered his talk with a most amusing and fluent commentary, much appreciated by the audience.

The next meeting of the Society is on January 2nd at which Mr. Eric Greenwood will talk about "Historic Houses Around Hagley". All are welcome at St. Saviour's Church Hall Hagley 8.00 p.m. Visitors £1.50 including refreshments.
