



Annual Parish Meeting

The meeting on 19th March had a very good turnout with more than 30 residents attending to hear reports from the Parish, District and County Councils and to question Councillors. Thank you to all who attended on what was a very wintry night and participated in the discussions.

Recycling Roadshow

Bromsgrove District Council will be running a recycling roadshow on the Worcester Road car park on Saturday 7th July. This will be an opportunity to get advice and assistance with any recycling queries you may have.

Planning

In March, the Parish Council looked at nine planning applications, and objected to the following: B/2007/0170. Land adjacent to 81 Sweetpool Lane, Reserved matters application for access (for 5 new dwellings). We objected to this repeat application to use the track alongside Sweetpool Nature Reserve for vehicle access to the proposed new dwellings.

B/2007/0269. 3 Long Compton Drive. Formation of utility and shower room to rear of garage and bedroom extension over existing garage. This was also a repeat application and we again objected on the grounds that the proposed extension would be overbearing to the adjacent properties.

2. National Trust Advisory Committee 09/02/07. District Councillor Margaret Sherrey reported on the meeting, which included the proposal for a commercial development adjacent to Nimmings Car Park. The Council voted unanimously to object most strongly to this proposal.

Mount Everest Himalayan Trek



Last month one of our members, Jim Austin, successfully completed his Trek to the foot of Mount Everest to raise awareness and funds for the British Heart Foundation. This turned out to be an extremely arduous, but amazing 17-day trek along some very difficult terrain at high altitude, but resulted in Jim reaching the summit of Kala Pattar – 5,545 metres (18,192ft) overlooking Mount Everest and Base Camp.

Over £4,000 was forwarded to the British Heart Foundation, and Jim and members of Heartstart would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who supported this venture, and those organisations and individuals that made generous donations.

Jim is in the process of writing to as many sponsors as possible, to thank them for their support, and will be undertaking a series of talks describing his Trek. He will be showing some of the hundreds of photographs he took of the spectacular scenery, and those depicting the lives of the Sherpas of Nepal, with whom he and the trekking group lived during the expedition.



HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On Tuesday March 6th the meeting opened with Chairman, Mrs. Irene Oliver, announcing that Viscount Cobham had agreed to become our Honorary President. The members present met the news with unanimous approval.

The speaker this month was Mr. R. Harris who talked to us about "The Vernons of Hanbury". The family had originated in the town of Vernon in France; and two of the De Vernon brothers had accompanied William in the conquest of England in 1066. For their services they were rewarded with land. With family tree diagrams Mr. Harris described the history of the various branches of the family; one of which eventually became resident at Hanbury. By the 18th century the family owned a great deal of land in the area and the present Hanbury Hall was built. The estate provided the family with its income, but the collapse of the farming industry in the 19th century (and well into the 20th) depleted the family fortunes. The last Vernon to occupy the Hall was Doris, the widow of George Vernon; she died in 1962 leaving the Hall in a poor state of repair. The hall is now a National Trust property and has been carefully restored.




TREFOIL GUILD






