

Dear Mr Dicks

You will recall that I wrote to you on the 16th November 2006 in your capacity as Acting Chief Executive concerning the chaotic traffic congestion in West Hagley resulting from an inadequate highway infrastructure and uncoordinated planning decisions.

In your response dated 27th November you stated and I quote – "I appreciate the opportunity to be informed about the situation regarding the roads in the area and I will ask the relevant officer to explore with Worcestershire Highways Section the potential for addressing the roads with regard to Milestone Drive."

As approximately 5 months have now elapsed are you yet able following your council's discussions with Worcestershire County Council, the local highway authority, to inform the residents of this part of West Hagley of the proposed positive measures that will be effected to the road network in this area, including routes B4187 (the village shopping street) and A456, to alleviate the frequent and intolerable traffic congestion in West Hagley.

As there were insufficient candidates, there was no election for the Parish Council on May 3rd, all the nominated candidates were therefore returned unopposed. We still have vacancies. Three Councillors stepped down in May. Long serving members Arthur Lewis and Jill Gall have now retired from the Council. We would like to thank them for all the time and work they have put in over the years and wish them all the best for the future.

Planning

In April, the Council objected to the following:

B/2007/0275, 9 Long Close and B/2007/0336, 11 Long Close. Demolition of existing utility and erection of new utility and first floor bedroom. Objection: These proposals would have the effect of making a terrace of houses, not in keeping with the area.

B/2007/0276, The Old Rectory, Hall Lane, listed building consent for the erection of a hardwood timber conservatory. Objection: the means of access will alter the structure of the house.

B/2007/0349, Hagley Golf and Country Club, Wassell Grove Lane, new golf range and academy. Objection: Unacceptable development in the green belt.

We have also written to the District Council expressing dismay at the granting of planning permission B/2007/0170 (reserved matters application access for 5 new dwellings), land adjacent to 81 Sweetpool Lane. We remain concerned about the safety implications of those using the path and the impact on Sweetpool Nature Reserve.

Hagley Surgery Patient Survey 2007

The 2007 Patient Survey results at the last meeting of the Patient Participation Group (PPG) with the doctors and Practice manager and were a marginal improvement on last year.

The main complaint was the difficulty in booking to see a doctor of choice or at specific times e.g. early morning or late evening. Resources will be introduced during the coming year which may help.

- 1) A facility to book appointments on line.
- 2) A touchscreen system enabling patients to book themselves in when they arrive without reporting to reception.
- 3) A system to request repeat prescriptions online.

The telephone system was upgraded last year and, accompanied by an increase in administrative staff hours, should enable reception staff to deal with the increasing volume of calls without affecting telephone waiting times.

The growing patient list for the Hagley Practice is making improvement in the appointment problem difficult, however more patients can be accommodated if they are flexible about which doctor they see.

Some misconceptions were revealed in the survey. For example, that the practice does not have a nurse especially for the elderly, in fact there are two. On a more positive note the survey revealed general satisfaction with the courtesy and consideration by doctors and staff at the practice together with the comfort and facilities in the waiting area.

The PPG will continue to keep these matters under review with the practice management.

HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

A large audience attended the April meeting to hear Mr. Terry Keegan talk about "Milestones And Their Preservation". Mr. Keegan informed us that the first milestones in Britain were erected by the Romans and that their measurement of one thousand (mille)

paces was the origin of our mile. Very little trace of these remain and it was not until road travel became more common in the 16th century that it was necessary to have road measurement: at this point the postal service required more accurate measurement of road distances and a few major routes were calibrated with stones. The big increase in milestone erection began at the end of the 18th century with the building of the turnpike toll roads; it was a legal requirement that they had them. Eventually the building and maintenance of the roads became the responsibility of county councils and they usually had their own individual design of milestone, which accounts for the variety we can see today. Mr. Keegan finished his talk with a series of slides showing the various types of milestones, some of which he has helped to restore.

The June meeting of the Society is on Tuesday 5th at which Dr C. Upton will talk about "Joseph Chamberlain – Birmingham Benefactor". All are welcome at St. Saviour's Church Hall 8 p.m. Visitors £1.50 including refreshments. The June ramble is on Sunday 10th, starting from the village car park at 2.00 p.m.
