



# Why does my doctor always run late?

Being called into your appointment late is a common reason for complaints at the Surgery. I thought I'd try to explain why it happens.

In order to offer a reasonable number of appointments, we have to work fast. We book you in at 10-minute intervals. A common mistake is to think that this means you have 10 minutes with us. Sadly not. The 10 minutes involves greeting you, asking about your problem, examining you, filling out relevant test request forms, saying goodbye, writing your medical record and (if relevant) dictating a referral letter.

The administrative stuff takes on average three-and-a-half minutes per problem you discuss. That leaves six-and-a-half minutes to do the rest. Bring two problems to the consultation and it's seven minutes administration and one-and-half minutes per problem. It's a lot to get in. If every slot runs over by just a minute-and-a-half we are running half an hour late by the end of morning surgery.

There is a common idea that some problems can be dealt with very quickly. In reality, if we are to practise safely, these are few and far between. Some problems are a lot more involved than you'd think.

Space limits more detailed discussion of this, and there are questions probably coming to mind which, believe me, we have asked and failed to answer repeatedly. However, if we are all aware of the time pressure, we can do better for everyone. Thanks for thinking about it.

# HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

#### **Road Safety Partnership**

Representatives from the Road Safety Partnership came to a recent Parish Council meeting following our expression of concern at the speeding in Hagley. This is constantly being brought to our attention by residents. They agreed to monitor the situation for a period, particularly in Worcester Road. Once the data is available they will advise us what measures would be appropriate to control this and what options may be available for Hagley. We will keep you informed.

#### Summervale Road

The new lighting column near to the junction with Worcester Road is now up and working, brightening up that busy pedestrian route.

#### Planning

In June the Council looked at 10 planning applications: There were no objections to the proposals for 26 Long Close; 46 Willow Close; Haybridge High School and 52 Long Compton Drive.

#### Objections were raised on the following:

B/2007/0562 – 67 Lodge Crescent, 2 storey side extension and single storey rear extension. Objection: this proposed development is too close to the boundary of the site.

B/2007/0560 – Clent Villa Farm, Wassell Grove Lane, alterations to barn 2 so as to reflect the original structure. Objection: The present building appears to be bigger than the original.

 $B/2007/0587-4\ Meadowcroft,\ new\ 4\ bedroom\ detached\ house\ on\ land\ formerly\ part\ of\ garden\ (reserved\ matters\ application).$  Objection: This is above a culverted brook which according to

Worcestershire County Council and the regional Structure Plan should be opened up.

B/2007/0645 – 14A The Crescent, first storey side extension. Objection: inappropriate development in an area of bungalows (as per Hagley Parish Plan 2005)

B/2007/0648 – 20 Kidderminster Road, side and rear extension. Objection: too big, this should be set down and set back or a similar extension next door would create a terracing effect.
