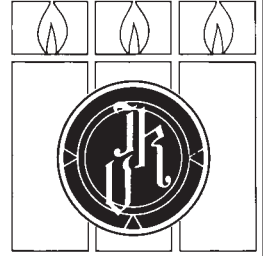

Dear Editor,

I refer to the Bromsgrove District Council Chief Executive, Mr Kevin Dicks' letter dated 11th July (copied to you) from which will be seen that he has omitted to provide the explanation for his Council's failure to coordinate the highway requirements before granting permissions for the residential developments and the provision of schools. But why?

A meeting is not a substitute for a full written reply and therefore I declined an offer in December 2004 to meet with the Bromsgrove Highways Partnership Unit.

In consequence of this planning mismanagement the inevitable traffic congestion on the road network in West Hagley is according to Mr Dick's letter "a highways matter which is in the domain of the County Council."

Thus the County Council's answers to the following question is imperative:-

1. What short term and also long term measures will be implemented by the County Council to alleviate the intolerable traffic congestion currently being experienced on the road network in West Hagley and what is the timetable?

Hopefully Worcestershire County Council will be able to provide Hagley Parish Council with explicit answers to these questions soon and that the Parish Council will then through the good offices of the Village News disseminate that information to the community.

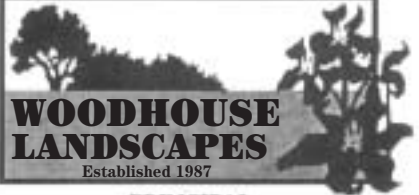

Wyre Forest & District Centre of the National Trust



This local group of National Trust members held its last meetings at Hagley Community Centre.

On 19th April the speaker was Professor Tim Mowl who teaches at Bristol University, specialising in garden history. He is writing the garden history of every county in England; five have been completed and published.

Professor Mowl knew Sir John Betjeman, describing him as his hero and an important formative influence. He described some of the characters and properties he has come across during his research, then concentrating on some outstanding gardens in Worcestershire, such as Birtsmorton Court, Madresfield Court and Croome Park.

On 19th May, the presentation was given by Shane Casey and Robert Turner on Brunel's S.S. Great Britain. Their firm in Shropshire specialises in conservation work and they have undertaken several high-profile projects, including the S.S. Great Britain in Bristol, and the Albert Memorial in London. The S.S. Great Britain was born out of the Great Western Railway's plan for an integrated transport system from London to New York. Work started on the ship in 1839 and she was launched in 1843, built in Bristol, 322 feet long. She had a varied career and was brought back to Bristol in 1970 and although had suffered extensive corrosion, was restored by July 2005, and is now a popular tourist attraction.

Next year we will allow school prefects to wear a light blue shirt, rather than white, and a specific tie, to enable prefects to be easily identified by other pupils and raise their status within the school.
