

HAGLEY SURGERY

Information Technology

This Autumn we are intending to install a Touchscreen automated arrivals system at the Surgery. This sounds very grand but it is in fact really simple to operate. It will be used by the patients to check in for their appointments. Please don't worry, this does not mean that our reception staff will no longer be available, staff will always be on hand to help and advise.... and also to check in if you prefer the old method. It is an additional facility not necessarily an alternative.

Patients can opt to use the automated arrivals computer screen to check in, for example if there is a queue at the desk, or if the receptionist is busy on the telephone. The idea is that the receptionist will

be able to spend more time on incoming calls and have more time to help patients with longer, more complicated queries.

The system automatically informs the clinician that the patient has arrived. Other changes that we are hoping to introduce this year include 'appointments on line' and 'repeat prescriptions on line'. Details regarding both services will be given nearer to the implementation date.

Dear Editor.

Victorian Hagley - an unexpected visitor

I am a self-confessed Victorian newspaper junkie, never happier than when I am scrutinising the exceedingly small print of a Victorian periodical. Unfortunately, these days this activity usually involves a microfilm reader, a piece of apparatus not designed with the aim of improving your eyesight. Recently, I had the great pleasure of working in the Bodleian Library in Oxford, on an extant run of a journal called the Herald of Peace. In this I came across several unexpected and intriguing references to Hagley.

On 4th January 1882, 9 October 1882 and 2 October 1884 the village received visits from the Birmingham Baptist minister, Arthur O'Neill. This man was quite a draw – nearly 1000 people had heard him speak from a wagon in Halesowen in July 1881. O'Neill's meetings were held at the Primitive Methodist chapel in Hagley. They were, it was reported, 'very good and lively'. This was, of course, the age of public meetings – there was no television at home, only Thomas Hardy novels. Several local men – identified in the reports as Mr Hughes, Mr Ince, Mr James and Mr Willetts - also spoke at these meetings.

What were these people getting so animated about? It was in fact a foreign war. In 1882 Britain invaded Egypt, bombarding Alexandria and inflicting a devastating defeat on the Egyptian army at Tel-el-Kebir. For men like O'Neill this was a wicked, unchristian policy. Though a few spoke up for the Prime Minister, Gladstone – whose sister-in-law, of course, lived in Hagley Hall - many in O'Neill's audiences seem to have shared his views.

Arthur O'Neill died in 1896 and was buried in St. Mary's churchyard in Handsworth, though his grave cannot now be located.

My thanks to you for allotting space in the Village News to this highway issue. I wrote on 20th August 2007 to Councillor Steven Colella, Chairman of Hagley Parish Council inter alia –

"As the vice chairman of the former Parish Plan Committee you will recall that the Hagley Parish Plan which highlighted the traffic congestion in Hagley was published in October 2005 and that a copy of that Plan was deposited for information in the Hagley library. So what has happened to the Plan in the 2 years since October 2005?

Is the Parish Council yet in receipt of the responses of the local planning and the local highway authorities in respect of that Plan and especially in regard to the necessary short and long term measures which are required to alleviate the traffic congestion? If so, can these responses be likewise published with copies deposited for information in the Hagley library?

Otherwise hopefully through the good offices of the Village News, you as Chairman of the Parish Council will be able to inform this community of the latest position regarding the alleviation of the intolerable traffic congestion in Hagley."

The Parish Council's response thereto is respectfully awaited.
