



PACT MEETING

Thanks to all who attended the meeting on the 12th September. Several issues were discussed, but the following issues were voted as a priority by those present.

- 1. Provision of youth facilities;
- 2. Speeding throughout the village.
- 3. Loading and unloading of lorries on Worcester Road.

The next PACT meeting will be in December (date to be confirmed) where the police and the local authorities will update on progress on the three issues prioritised.

OVERGROWN HEDGES

There are a number of properties in the village where hedges are overgrown over the pavement. This causes a problem for pedestrians. We receive many complaints about this. Be considerate to others and trim back these hedges. Of particular concern is Park Road, including the passage way to Rooks Meadow. Please note that the Highway Authority has the power to cut back such hedges and send the householder the bill.

LITTER

Litter remains a problem. We are now working with the schools in Hagley to address this.

CHRISTMAS WINDOW COMPETITION

The Council is considering whether to run the competition again this year. Please see the next issue for details.

PLANNING

In September, the Council looked at 10 planning applications. There were no objections to the proposals for: The Birches, Brake Lane; Easby House, Middlefield Lane; 47 Middlefield Lane; 31 Middlefield Lane; 10 Kidderminster Road; 10 Lyttelton Place and 53 Lodge Crescent. But objections were made to the following:

B2007/0878/RL5 Summervale Road: Formation of habitable rooms in roof space with front dormers: Object as this proposal would mean loss of yet another bungalow and will also adversely affect the character of the area.

B2007/0898 21 Chestnut Drive: Single storey side extension to provide additional garage and conversion of existing garage to form habitable room. Council objected because this development is already very dense and on the limits of what is permissible and the proposed extension will reach right to the edge of the pavement. While this is on the outside of a bend, we consider building right up to the edge of the highway to be undesirable.

B/2007/0998 New house adjacent Fourways, Brake Lane: Erection of boundary wall and gates to front of property, retrospective. This wall creates an obstruction for cars turning out of Sweetpool Lane and double yellow lines are needed to stop car parking on the corner.





HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

At the meeting on September 4th it was announced that the scheduled talk on "The Castle and Barony of Dudley" would not take place due to a late cancellation by the speaker. Fortunately a replacement, Mr Nick Harvey, had agreed to step in at very short

notice to give a talk about "Wilden Village, the Church and the Baldwins". Mr Harvey is the retired head Master of the village school and a long serving churchwarden. He described how the Baldwin family had established an iron works in the village, which by the mid 19th century was very prosperous. At this point in time the head of the family was Alfred Baldwin who became a generous benefactor to the village. Amongst other things he paid for the building of the church and the school. The factory has now gone but it's legacy, the church, remains. With it's rare stained glass windows, by Pre-Raphaelite artists Burne-Jones, it attracts many visitors. The members gave Mr. Harvey an enthusiastic round of applause, for his excellent talk provided at such short notice.

The final talk of the year is on November 6th at which Mr. Roy Peacock will talk about Earnest Stephens – "The Bucket King". New members are welcome to join us in 2008 for another series of talks together with our other activities including our monthly rambles and our historical research group. We meet at St. Saviour's Church Hall 8.00 p.m. on the first Tuesday of the month. Visitors £1.50 including refreshments.




