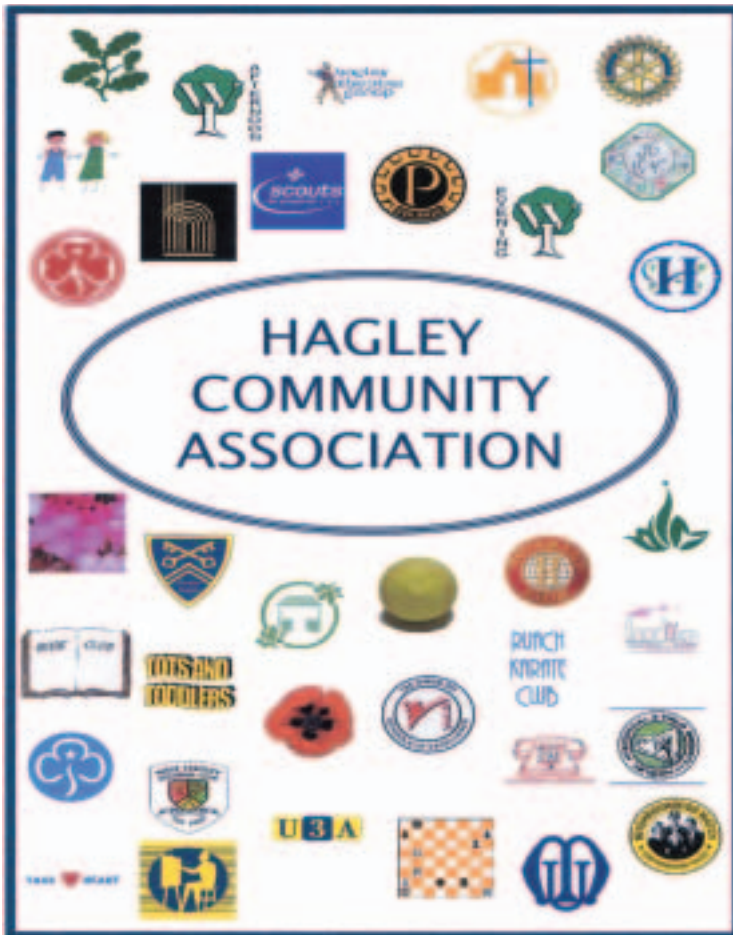

PACT MEETING

A reminder that the next PACT (Partners And Communities Together) meeting is at the Community Centre at 7.00 p.m. on Tuesday 8th January. All are welcome to attend. This is your opportunity to put your concerns to the various councils and the police. Please see posters around the village for more details.

STREET LIGHTING

The Parish Council is responsible for the footway lighting in the village, while the County Council takes care of the lighting on the main roads. If you see a light out of action, please inform the Clerk who will pass the message on as appropriate and get the repairs done as soon as possible.

PLANNING

In November, the Council looked at 4 planning applications:

B/2007/0937 Beacon Hill, 30 Bromsgrove Road – application for detached garage, and B/2007/1207 1 Clent Drive – proposed bedroom and ensuite over existing garage, raised no objections.

B/2007/1160 Hagley Hall Park and gardens – erection of a compressor building and construction of a surge vessel, creation of access road and minor ground reproofing. The Council had no objections to this in principle but objected to the siting of the above ground structures and asked that these be reconsidered.

B/2007/1212 Land adjacent Bellona, 81 Sweetpool Lane – outline application for 5 dwellings (renewal of B/2002/1477). The Council objected to this as the access is inadequate and the village does not need any more houses.

The Parish Council receives copies of all the planning applications for the village. Please contact the Clerk if you wish to view any of them.

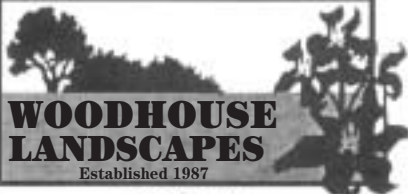

Roy enthralled us with his account of the Stourbridge holloware manufacturer who became one of the town's greatest philanthropists. Ernest was born in Lye in 1867, attended King Edward's school and eventually took over the family business making galvanised buckets and bowls. Despite the first factory buildings falling victim to mine subsidence, he built up a successful local trade, roaming the area by horse and trap. By 1914 he was selling his enamelware across the Empire, supplying the Army during the War and thriving throughout the depression of the 1920s and 1930s.

Having made his fortune, Ernest decided to use it to benefit local people. Roy told us about his support for Corbett Hospital, his purchase and donation of Stevens Park in Thorns Road, Haden Hill and Congreaves Parks, Mary Stevens Maternity Home, Mary Stevens Park in Norton and Stevens Park in Wollescote. This legacy remains for all to enjoy, the Stour Works still exists, although not making holloware, and the Stevens brand, Judgeware, still on sale but is now made in Portugal!

The January meeting is on Tuesday 1st, when Nick Baker will talk about Amblecote Hall. Meetings take place on the first Tuesday of each month in St. Saviour's Church Hall, beginning at 8.00 p.m. All are most welcome, visitors £1.50 including refreshments.

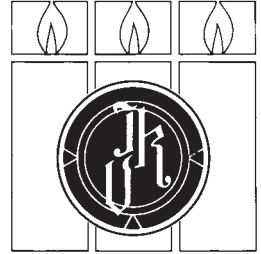
