



Hagley Surgery urges older people to keep warm and well this winter.

Hagley surgery would like to take this opportunity to raise awareness of the government's national campaign "Keep Warm, Keep Well" to reduce cold related illnesses and deaths this winter.

As well as increasing the chances of slips and falls, cold weather lowers body temperature, which can increase the risk of heart attacks, strokes and breathing difficulties. It is also worth remembering that hypothermia is not only caused by brief exposure to extreme cold but by prolonged exposure to mild cold weather.

Tips for keeping warm and well

- 1. Wrap up warm, thin layers of clothes are better than one thick layer, don't forget a hat, gloves, scarf and non-slip shoes.
- 2. Don't sit still for long periods, keep active; this generates extra body heat, improving circulation.
- 3. Food is a vital source of warmth, so try to have regular hot meals and drinks throughout the day.
- 4. Try to keep a room temperature of 21°C (70°F) during the daytime and the bedroom above 18°C. Don;t sleep with the window open.
- 5. Get a 'flu jab.
- 6. Stock up on provisions and medicines in case it is too cold to go to the shops.

For further advice contact the Nurse Advisers to the Older Person available at the surgery on most days.

Finally, if you have an older person as a neighbour or a relative, please look out for them this winter.
