

Hire Rates – Hagley Community Centre 2008/9

Each year the committee reviews the rates for hire of the Community Centre. Last year, apart from amendments, generally no increase was applied.

We have reviewed the running costs and unfortunately as the greatest proportion of expenses are insurance and utility costs, we have been affected by significant price increases in these two sectors. This has to be reflected in our rates and they will be increased from April 1st 2008.

The rates for 2008/9 are now published on our website and we have tried to ensure that the increases have been kept as low as possible.

We look forward to your continued support.

Hagley Surgery

Hagley Surgery now has the facility for patients to order repeat prescriptions and make routine appointments on line.

Patients are asked to bring proof of identity, either the new style driving licence or a passport. We also request that there is proof of address if not current on those documents.

Patients may only register themselves; if a patient came in to register herself and her husband, a pin number and instructions would be given to the wife but not the husband, to protect patient confidentiality. We are only registering adults at present.

Appointments

Not all appointments available will be shown on line as this would not be fair to patients without a computer. Appointments will be limited to one per person, to prevent patients booking for several consecutive months.

Prescriptions

Only routine repeat prescriptions will show on the screen. The message facility may be used to advise the prescription clerk of information that may be useful. The turnaround time will still be 48 hours before the prescription is signed. The chemist will then need time to dispense the medication as usual.

PACT Meeting

This was well attended and the agreed priorities are as follows:

POOR ROAD CONDITIONS – Attendees felt that the layout of the road junction at Summervale Road onto the A456 is no longer fit for purpose due to the amount of traffic using it.

Action – Highways to survey the junction to assess traffic flows.

SPEEDING TRAFFIC

Action – Local Policing Team to carry out speed enforcement at the locations and Hagley Parish Council to continue to work with the Safer Roads Partnership to establish sites for fixed speed enforcement cameras.

VEHICLE RELATED - CARS PARKED ILLEGALLY/INCONVENIENTLY – In Church Street near the junction with Worcester Road, Hagley.

Action – Local Policing Team will pay attention to the location with a view to enforcing parking restrictions.

Please look out for the next meeting which will probably be in April.

Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held at the Community Centre on Monday 17th March at 8.00 p.m. This is your chance to hear about the work of the Council over the last year and ask questions of the Councillors.

Road safety outside the schools

We have been advised by the County Council that works to improve the safety of Station Road and Brake Lane have been agreed and should be starting soon. Hopefully they will have been completed by the time you are reading this.

Also a highways issue is the condition of the roads in the village. We pass on the details of all potholes reported to us through the online system, where we can keep track of any action that is taken.

Planning

In January the Council looked at three planning applications: B/2007/1287, 180A Worcester Road; B/2007/1343, 53 Winds Point; and B/2007/1371, 106 Worcester Road. There were no objections.

The Workwise Scheme

This offers transport solutions for Worcestershire residents with employment and training opportunities who do not have suitable transport. The scheme includes travel planning and moped loans at £5 a week up to 12 months.

Beneficiaries must be 16 years or over, live in Worcestershire, have an offer of employment, training or furher education with a start date and have no other suitable means of transport.

There is Compulsory Basic Training, safety equipment, insurance, breakdown cover and full maintenance and servicing.

There are 50 mopeds for Worcestershire residents issued on a first come first served basis. Employers can also contact the scheme for advice and possible financial assistance.







HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Chairman Joan Ryder opened the Society's meeting on 1st January by wishing all members a Happy New Year before welcoming the evening's speaker, Nick Baker.

Nick had set himself an interesting challenge: his subject no longer existed, nor was there any archaeology and even the ground that it had occupied was no more! All this was even more incredible once we realised that Amblecote Hall, the subject of Nick's presentation, had only been demolished 56 years ago.

Using a series of maps, the earliest dating from 1688, Nick explained the development of the Manor of Amblecote Hall, which was owned by the Enville Estate.

Photographs had been difficult to obtain, but we saw fascinating views of the farmlands and the 16th/17th Century style Hall. Ominously present in some views were the brickworks and associated colliery that ultimately resulted in subsidence, condemnation by Amblecote UDC and finally demolition in 1952.

To complete the obliteration of the Hall, the opening of a huge opencast clay and coal pit in 1969 removed even the ground on which it had stood. Nick concluded his fascinating talk by comparing 'then and now' photographs and maps of the area.

On 4th March Mike Miles will talk on Graham Baron Ash and Packwood House. Meetings take place on the first Tuesday of each month in St. Saviour's Church Hall, beginning at 8.00 p.m. All are welcome, visitors £1.50 including refreshments.


