

Hagley Surgery – Patient Survey

Thank you very much to all patients who took part in this year's patient survey. Several patients was that they were unable to speak to the doctor on the telephone. We thought we would explain our procedure when a patient needs telephone advice.

Consultations are not interrupted unless there is an urgent message for the doctor. So doctors are not available to speak to patients regarding routine matters until after surgery. However, the receptionists are always happy to take details of a query and forward them to the doctor via email. The doctor will then either email a response and will ask the receptionist to contact the patient – or the doctor may feel it necessary to contact the patient in person and will do so but this would be after, not during, surgery. Therefore we do have access to the doctor via telephone but not necessarily at the time the patient calls.

If you would rather not give details about your problem to the receptionist please advise that you would prefer to discuss your enquiry with the doctor. We understand that queries can be personal or sensitive.

It is also very useful to have mobile telephone numbers in addition to home telephone numbers. This would mean that staff could speak to you rather than another member of your family. This is particularly valuable when cancelling appointments, unavoidable at times. Please notify us of your mobile number on your next visit to the Surgery or by writing to us at the practice.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

At a recent divisional meeting at Bromsgrove where our local police inspector, Chief Inspector Tony Love spoke of his commitment to working with the Watch. He appreciates the active work of members which helps to counteract the ever resourceful criminal.

Local policing is community based; active watch co-ordinators can have the local police officer's mobile 'phone number to quickly report incidents. Hagley, Romsley and Rubery, suffer with criminals from outside the area causing the majority of offences.

Smartwater, a form of invisible marking can be obtained through Bromsgrove Watch Office if there is sufficient interest. This product can be given its own type of DNA (the police can detect the product issue batch). The marking is permanent, a small container will cost about £20.

If Hagley had sufficient interest, local Neighbourhood Watch signs could be bought showing Hagley was a Smartwater marked area. Hopefully the criminals would move to a less protected area.

If a criminal handles a marked item they will carry the Smartwater on their skin. When arrested the police will be able to detect the product.

Changes in population, housing and lifestyle mean demands on neighbourhood Watch are continually changing. To be a viable force in the community new active people must come forward. Keep in touch with your local co-ordinator or myself if you have concerns and we will try to help.

HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL



ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

Thank you to all who attended the Annual Parish meeting on 17th March. The minutes and the Chairman's report can be found in full on the Parish Council website.

At the Meeting a question was raised in respect of household waste bins. It is confirmed that BDC is liable for the bins and boxes on the day of collection up until the point of collection. After the bins and boxes have been emptied they should be removed from the kerbside and pavements as soon as possible so as not to cause an unnecessary obstruction or hazard.

There were complaints of some problems with bins being left out causing an obstruction on narrow pavements for pedestrians, or items falling out of boxes onto the road. Although there are powers of enforcement, to date there has been no need for it in Bromsgrove, the council preferring only to take action where there is an ongoing problem and only as a last resort. It prefers that residents remove their bins and boxes as soon as possible leaving pavements and kerbsides clear for pedestrian use.

We believe this to be a listed building and the carriage road beside the property to be a public footpath, also a private access road to the fields behind. The proposal is to narrow the way from a road to a tightly enclosed footpath. This is unacceptable and we object to it.

ADOPTION OF THE PARISH PLAN

In response to Mr. J H Gemmill's letter to the Editor in March edition of the Village News I can say that I share Mr. Gemmill's concerns and I am personally frustrated that the Plan, to date, has not been adopted by the planning authorities. I am frustrated on behalf of all the members of the Parish Plan Committee and the Parish Council who gave up a tremendous amount of their free time to the project.

However, there may be good news not too far away. Bromsgrove District Council is considering a proposal to integrate the plan within the Sustainable Communities Strategy and Local Development Framework. This will not mean an immediate end to our problems, including traffic congestion but if accepted will at least mean that the opinions and concerns of Hagley residents will have been recognised.

It will be the intention of the Parish Council, mine as its Chairman and as one of the two District Councillors to ensure that our concerns are echoed where and whenever possible.

I hope my response has clarified the current position and hope that there will ultimately be some good news for all concerned.

HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Joan Ryder opened the Society's 4th March meeting by reminding everyone of the April outing and the forthcoming ramble. She then introduced Mike Miles who

was to talk on Graham Baron Ash - his life and the restoration of Packwood House.

Mike began his fascinating talk by explaining how Baron's grandfather had started the family business and how his father, Alfred, had made a fortune in galvanising. Baron persuaded his father to buy Packwood at auction in 1904 and for £4500 he acquired the house and 103 acres. In 1914 Baron joined the Red Cross and in 1917 the RFC. Alfred Ash died in 1925 and Baron then set about removing Packwood's Georgian and Victorian alterations: he added the long gallery and transformed a barn into a magnificent Tudor hall, using materials rescued from other houses. Mike illustrated his talk with photographs, including the gardens and Queen Mary's visit of 1927. Baron's year as High Sheriff of Warwickshire in 1938 was to be his high spot: in 1939 he joined the RAF and in 1940 the gardens were turned over to growing vegetables. He gave the house to the National Trust in 1941. Meanwhile, Baron had moved to East Anglia, where he continued to make substantial donations to local organisations. He never married and died in 1980, being buried in the churchyard adjacent to Packwood.




