

Dear Editor

Anyone using the children's playground in Hagley recently will notice the large signs announcing the presence of a CCTV camera and that this is a no alcohol area with a £500 fine. The camera is not yet installed, but doubtless will be soon. I've lived in Hagley 6 years, but in that time, I have yet to notice any drunkards, drug addicts or indeed anyone dodgy using the swings and slides of Hagley's playground. Is this not completely over the top? This country now has 1 CCTV camera for every 14 persons, and quite frankly, I think our kids, and the rest of us, have a right of privacy when using a playground. The school has to get our consent to take a photo of our children, so what right has the council to take video footage of my children playing? Given the failings of data protection recently, how confident are we, as parents, about whoever is doing the watching? Has the council not got better things on which to spend its money (eg better facilities for teenagers) rather than intimidating and spying on the residents and children of Hagley? Finally, shouldn't the council stop spending our money on CCTV when there is virtually no evidence that it reduces crime?



HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ORDERS (ASBOs)

There have been a couple of incidents of anti-social behaviour. The Community Support Officers have queried their ability to prosecute under the alcohol ban, and have been advised that if offenders handed over the alcohol and complied with police requirements (such as giving names and addresses), there was no offence. The procedure is that the police take children home if there is under age drinking and PC Lord personally delivers a letter to the parents. This will be followed up by a second letter and then ASBO proceedings, but of late it has not been necessary to go beyond the first letter. Further ASBOs will also be sought if necessary once existing orders have expired.

LITTER

Bromsgrove District Council has agreed to provide some more litter bins. Please use these and all the bins around Hagley to keep your village clean and tidy.

PLANNING

In April, the Council looked at 5 planning applications, and made the following comments:

B/2008/0109RL 43 Middlefield Lane. Proposed living room, utility, study and bedroom extension. No objection.

B/2008/0321RL 5 Woodland Avenue. Demolition of porch and garage and erection of kitchen, lobby, utility, cloaks, office, garage and entrance lobby. **No objection**.

B/2008/0247RL The Cottage, The Birches Estate, Brake Lane. Conservatory extension to ground floor and new porch. No objection.


B/2008/0382RL 35 Cavendish Drive single story side extension to form toilet, lobby and covered passage. **No objection**.

B/2008/0381RL 14A The Crescent – Ground floor extension to living room. Alteration to existing utility. The Crescent is a development entirely of bungalows. As such it is identified for preservation (as an area of Distinctive Character) in Hagley Parish Plan. This house as a two-storey dwelling is an exception which is out of keeping with the rest of the street. We therefore do not object to this proposal but we are concerned to ensure that no extensions or alterations to it exacerbate the situation and that they do not provide precedents for further replacement of bungalows with houses.

SWEETPOOL NATURE RESERVE

Hagley Parish Council has entered into a Licence agreement with Bromsgrove District Council for the management of the Nature Reserve. We will be responsible for most of the grounds maintenance and litter collection while the District will remain responsible for tree works and health and safety inspections. We hope that this will preserve this area of natural beauty for residents and wildlife.







HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Joan Ryder opened the Society's meeting on 1st April by detailing the forthcoming Social, the Hughenden Manor trip and the Ramble in Hagley Park. She then introduced Greta Lacey, who was to talk on *Restoration Old and New – Kings Norton Grammar*

School and Saracen's Head.

Many had seen the BBC Restoration series in 2004 when the two buildings in Kings Norton had won the final vote but none of us was prepared for the riveting story that lay behind this. Greta started with a short history of the Saracen's Head. Built as a wool merchant's house in 1492, many alterations had been made to the building during its long history and it had existed as a pub only for 120 years from 1790.

The Old Grammar School dated from 1434-1460 but it had a 14th Century window. However, much of the detailed history of the building has been lost. It was certainly used as a school during its life but was it built as such? Could it have started out as a chantry chapel? We were left with many tantalising questions – but few answers!

Greta concluded by recalling the fascinating train of events that followed the phone call from the BBC in April 2004 and that culminated in the buildings receiving over £3m in grant funding for their restoration.






