

Once again decisions, which will ultimately affect the health and well being of the community, are made by the elite few, our so called "local representatives". There are now three recent decisions which impact on us all:

- 1. The closure of the sports facility
- 2. The decision to impose car parking fees which will just force more cars to park in the side roads and add to the general level of congestion.
- 3. The £30 fee for the collection of recyclable waste or in the case of my road, the withdrawal of this service.

In regard to the latter I have had lengthy correspondence with our M.P. (not a very fruitful exercise), with copies to our District Councillor, all to no avail and in the case of the District Councillor not even meriting a reply.

Dr Richards and Helen Taylor deserve all our support and we deserve representatives who understand their their first duty should be to us, the residents of Hagley.

As I was concerned at the general level of crime occuring presently in Hagley, I have managed to obtain the following statistics from West Mercia Police Constabulary covering the Hagley Ward (including neighbouring villages) area:

Total Crime: Oct-Dec 2007 49 offences. Oct-Dec 2008 75 offences. 53% increase.

Burglaries: Oct-Dec 2007 7 offences. Oct-Dec 2008 15 offences. 114% increase, classed as "above average". Vehicle crime: Oct-Dec 2007 12 offences. Oct-Dec 2008 21 offences. 75% increase, classed as "high" crime area. Additionally, the following figures are for the current year April 2008 to 25 January 2009:

ADDITIONAL SERVICES AT KIDDERMINSTER HOSPITAL.



CAR PARKING

Our proposed parking scheme for the Worcester Road car park is still being consulted on with stakeholders. We will keep you informed. Please watch for future notices on our notice board, the website and the Village News.

REMINDER

The playing field, the car park, the train station and much of the surrounding area including the main Worcester Road is still an alcohol free zone. If you are seen by the police drinking alcohol in this area it <u>will</u> be confiscated and further action will follow in the event of any anti social behaviour. Patrols are being increased.

WARNING

There has been an increase in thefts of and from vehicles in this area. The police are advising everyone not to leave valuable items in cars; to make sure cars are secure and to make sure windows and doors at home are kept securely locked as properties have been broken into just to steal car keys.





HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Setting the scene was Irene Oliver, who told us something of the origins and activities of the Group. Started in 1990, its members were recruited from those with an interest and who were prepared to get their hands dirty! Profits from the sales of publications had funded further projects and Irene brought examples of many of the papers and booklets produced by the Group.

Don Freeth then talked about one of the Group's projects that had focussed on the names on the Hagley war memorial. From World War 1 we learned about the Gough brothers who had joined the Worcestershire Regiment on the same day and who died within six months of each other in 1918. Don's next account was of the Goodwin brothers who had joined the RAF and who both lost their lives in 1940.

Finally, the Group's founder, Tom Pagett gave a detailed insight into Bell Hall Chapel. Tom explained some of the history of this building which had been started in around 1130. Using detailed photographs, we learned not only what had happened to the building over the centuries but how the archaeologists had come to their conclusions.
