

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL.....

Vaccinations – ensure you have appropriate vaccinations, in good time, before your departure.

Malaria – take malaria prevention medication if travelling to a malaria risk area **Diarrhoea** – affects a high proportion of travellers, go prepared with sachets to replace lost salts and fluids (available at chemist).

Insurance – the European Health Insurance Card may not be enough, ensure that you are properly covered by appropriate travel insurance.

Jet lag – common when crossing time zones. During the flight drink water, avoid coffee, fizzy drinks and alcohol. Set your watch and take your medication according to the new time.

Sun - sunburn and sunstroke may cause headache, nausea, chills and vomiting. Stay in the shade, especially 11am – 3pm Guard against skin cancer by using a high strength sun block.

Medicines – take a First Aid Kit and adequate supplies of any regular medication. Carry your medication in your luggage. If carrying needles and syringes you will need a letter from your doctor to explain why this is necessary. Safe sex – ALWAYS use a condom but remember that although condoms offer excellent protection it is not 100% effective.

The nurses run a travel clinic, please book in to discuss your travel needs.

The Cadles – Jeremy, Jane, John, Julie, Vanessa and Morgan wish again to thank everyone who has prayed, encouraged and supported us over the past two and a half years, for Tom's recovery from a brain tumour and update you on progress. He completed 78 weeks of chemotherapy in November 2008, and the result of his latest MRI scan has been both encouraging and positive, although it is early days yet. Tom will be under the care of Great Ormond Street Hospital for some years ahead. Meanwhile he is enjoying and very enthusiastic about school and is displaying a confidence that could not have been imagined a few months ago. You may see him around the village from time to time – please say hello to us.

The Cadles owe a debt of gratitude for the continued kindness and concern shown for Tom by the Clent, Hagley and neighbouring communities, by our relations and their friends, and by so many others both here in the UK and abroad.

Talbots Solicitors, of Kidderminster and Stourbridge, wanted to re-design the "welcome" cards they send out to their clients upon completion of a house purchase.

They approached Hagley Primary School to run an art competition and offered prizes for the best design. LITTER

This is still a major problem in the village. We get it picked up and will continue to do so, but when there is excessive litter it costs more of your council tax which could mean we do not have the funds to do something else. Please encourage your family and friends not to drop litter, but to use the bins or take it home. Remember it is actually a criminal offence to drop litter, with the possibly of a substantial fine. Help us to keep your village clean and litter free.

ROAD RESURFACING

The resurfacing of various roads around the village is now finished. We have heard many comments, please pass these on to the Highways Control Centre at Worcestershire County Council, whether they are in praise or complaint.

PLANNING

In April, the Council looked at:

- 1. 09/0216. 10 Sweetpool Lane. Construction of 5 bed house and garage. No Objections.
- **2. 09/0204.** Land off Woodland Avenue. Approval of condition 2. i.e. the reserved matters of planning application B/2003/0790. Details of design, external appearance and landscaping of site. **Object:** we object to the mock Tudor design and would like to see more trees.
- **3. 09/0262.** Erection of a boundary wall at Field House, Wassell Grove Lane. Comment: No objection but we ask that the bricks for this extension should match those being used for the two houses next door. The three together constitute a single (listed) building.

4. 09/0261 New house on the site of 1 Brook Crescent.

The proposal is for a four-bedroom house. The Council's Core Strategy Preferred Option identified a need mainly for two bedroom houses. Experience shows that four-bedroom houses are largely not to meet Local Needs (as defined in WMRSS), but the aspirations of people seeking to move out of the adjacent Major Urban Areas. We would accordingly have preferred a smaller house.

5. 09/0291 12 Brook Crescent. Proposed single storey extension, garage and utility. The proposal involves extending the house backwards substantially, with a utility room behind the garage that extends back even further. We are concerned at the latter aspect, which will provide an extremely long blank wall facing towards the rear garden of 14 Brook Crescent.





The castle continued to be occasionally used until 1750, when a huge fire burnt it to a shell. Thus it became the romantic ruin we know today.
