Hagley Surgery

Most of us enjoy sunny weather but extreme heat can seriously damage your health. In a heatwave you may become dehydrated and your body may overheat, leading to heat exhaustion or heatstroke. Both need urgent treatment.

Symptoms include headaches, dizziness, nausea and vomiting, muscle weakness or cramps, pale skin and a high temperature. You should move to somewhere cool, drink plenty of water or fruit juice and, if possible, take a lukewarm shower.

If a heatwave is forceast, plan your day to allow you to stay out of the heat.

- Avoid the hottest part of the day, 11.00 a.m. 3.00 p.m.
- If you must go out, stay in the shade, wear a summer hat and loose fitting cotton clothes.
- Wear sunscreen, high factor for children
- Drink regularly even if you do not feel thirsty; water and fruit juice are best as alcohol, tea and coffee can make dehydration worse.
- Eat as you normally would, particularly salads and fruit which contain water

If you are concerned that someone you know may be suffering from heatstroke seek medical advice as quickly as possible. Enjoy the Summer safely.



COLUMN AND ADDRESS.



HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Ray Porter opened the May meeting by detailing the forthcoming social and ramble and visit to the Drakelow Tunnels on 24th June. Ray then introduced the speaker, Bernard Mills, talking on 'Shopping over 200 years – a History of Kays

of Worcester'.

Bernard was the founder and current Chairman of the Kays Heritage Group. He started with John Skarratt's clock and watch making shop of 1794. Skarratt's grandson took over the business before selling up in 1896 to William Kilbourne Kay who had worked in Skarratt's shop. Kay started 'Kays of Worcester', selling jewellery, clocks and household goods by mail order and supplying clocks to the Great Western Railway.

We saw photographs of the company's extensive premises: the Art Deco architecture still appeals and we were treated to many period views of employees at work. Bernard had spoken to several of the pictured workers in their later years and was able to relate many of their anecdotes.

Our speaker punctuated his history with fascinating views from the Kays catalogues. Sadly, time passed all too quickly both for Kays and for Bernard's audience: we reached 2007 and Kays' withdrawal from Worcester.

The next meeting of the Society is on 7th July, when Mrs B Middlemass presents 'The Tale of Two Mansions – Impney at Droitwich and Ynas y Maengwen'. All will find a warm welcome at our meetings at St. Saviour's Church Hall at 8.00 p.m. on the first Tuesday in the month and on trips and rambles.




