

#### BINS

Once again a reminder to please use the bins—put rubbish in the bin, not on the ground, dog waste in the appropriate bin, not on the ground. Recycling must go in the right bank, not on the ground as this will not be collected. Anything that will not fit in please take it home to dispose of later. Everybody must make an effort to keep the village clean and tidy.

#### CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

There will be no Christmas tree recycling in Hagley, please check the local press **www.bromsgrove.gov.uk**, and any details we receive will be on the main village notice board.

#### PLANNING

In November, the Council looked at one BDC planning application and made the following comments:

**09/081 73 Worcester Road**—extensions and re-roofing to create first floor. Object, out of keeping with the area and adjacent properties, the resulting property would be too large and result in the loss of another bungalow.

View all Bromsgrove district planning applications at **http://appuview.bromsgrove. gov.uk** using the reference number as above.

We also looked at an application made to Wyre Forest District Council. 09/0744 The Oaks Paddock, Stakenbridge Lane, Churchill. This is a retrospective application for 3 caravans, utility building, septic tank and fencing. We have objected to this on the grounds that it is inappropriate development in the green belt. Details can be found at http://www.wyreforest.gov.uk/fastweb/welcome/asp.

We were also notified of an appeal by Clent Villa Farm against the refusal by BDC to vary the conditions 4 and 5 of planning application B/2007/0560 to remove the requirement for insulation and internal works. We have reiterated our objection to the Planning Inspectorate.

Policing in Hagley

Firstly can I wish everyone a Happy New Year and I'd like to report some successes with arrests made for offences in Hagley.

In September there was a burglary at a house in Hagley where two vehicles were stolen from the drive. Observations were quickly circulated and the vehicles were sighted in the West Midlands area. Shortly after, both vehicles were abandoned with two men being arrested and the vehicles returned to their owners.

Around Halloween there were a number of Criminal Damage incidents where ball bearings were being shot at the windows of houses, Pubs and cars around Hagley, Clent and Belbroughton. A registration number and description of the car were taken and three men were subsequently arrested for the offences. Finally you will be pleased to know that a man has also been arrested for a robbery offence which occurred in November at a home in Hagley.

With this update I'd also like to reassure residents that incidents like these are rare in Hagley and that as you can see if they do happen, with good team work, we do bring offenders to justice.

Also, by way of a reminder, we continue to work on the PACT priorities with all our partners and we will be updating residents at the next meeting at the Community Centre on 27th January.


