

CHANGE TO DON RICHARDSON MEMORIAL CUP

The Parish Council has decided to change the way in which it awards the Don Richardson Memorial Cup. As you will know it has been a tradition for the cup to be awarded during the Christmas period to the most decorative shop window in Hagley.

The Parish Council will now award the Cup to the most deserving group or individual as recognition of their community spirit or achievements during the year. The Cup will continue to be awarded during the Christmas period.

It is with great pleasure that we announce that the recipient of the Don Richardson Memorial Cup for 2009 is the Hagley Fête Committee. Mrs Janet Richards has accepted the Cup on behalf of all the members of the 2009 Committee in her capacity as chairperson.

Our congratulations and heart felt thanks go out to them for all their hard work and we hope that they will continue to work towards bringing the fête to Hagley during the coming summer.

LIGHTING

I hope you noticed the Christmas lights and tree displays again at Christmas. Additional lights were purchased which added to the intensity of colour along Worcester Road. The late night shopping in Hagley went well and was enjoyed by many. The Hagley Business Association combined their Christmas activities with the Parish Council lights to make a very pleasant evening. We look forward to this year's event.

During recent months and the early part of 2010 concrete lighting columns throughout the Parish will be replaced with galvanised lighting columns. This is part of a planned upgrade of lighting columns.

Please report any failed or failing street lamps to the Clerk at the Parish Office so that they can be corrected by the appointed contractor.

TREES

The Parish Council recognises that trees are an important part of our environment and a characteristic of the Parish. A number of trees in the playing fields have been replaced along with new trees being planted in the cemetery. The Parish Council has limited land on which to plant trees but will ensure that where trees need replacing they will be done so at the most opportune time.

DRAINAGE

A number of long standing drainage issues in the playing field changing rooms, outside the changing room, in the cemetery driveway and in Victoria Passage have been completed. These were outstanding issues that required an extensive repair and maintenance programme.

WAR MEMORIAL, PARK ROAD.

The Parish Council has been happy to support the addition of a special plaque to record the lives of five Hagley residents lost in World War II and previously not recorded on the War Memorial in Park Road.

This followed extensive research into the soldiers' history by Mr Don Freeth (Hagley resident and member of the Hagley Historical Society). Some of the surviving relatives have been contacted and will be invited to an official adoption service to be organised in the coming months. Please look out for more details in the near future.

For more information there is a very interesting official book (The Hagley War Memorial by Don Freeth) in the Library which is well worth reading.

HAGLEY YOUTH PROJECT AND SCOUTS ETC

We are used to hearing comments that there is little for the youth to do, not just in Hagley but nationally. How nice it was to hear news which reflected positive "can do" attitudes.

The Parish Council received a visit from the youth worker and representative of the Hagley Youth Project who reflected on how the Hagley Youth Club has continued to grow over the last two years. It was refreshing to hear how they have organised themselves into a very active group.

The members of the Parish Council discussed how the Scout, Cubs, Beavers and Girl Guides movements in Hagley have also grown and all maintain a healthy membership. In addition there is a youth club at the Free Church, youth participation in the Hagley Theatre and of course Hagley Colts Football Coaching sessions.

The Play Area continues to be used by many visitors both from Hagley and from outside the Parish.

PLANNING DECISION

As many residents will be aware "Our Plaice" appealed to the planning inspectorate against the decision by Bromsgrove District Council not to remove the condition preventing Sunday opening. This appeal was dismissed and the chip shop will not be open on Sundays.

Policing in Hagley

Vehicle Crime is still the highest crime offence we record for Hagley and it seems that people are still leaving expensive items such as lap tops and Sat Navs in cars. We have also seen a trend where no damage has been caused to vehicles to gain entry suggesting that people are also leaving their cars unlocked.

Just prior to Christmas we received information from West Midlands Police at Stourbridge that they had arrested a young man in possession of an ipod. It was found to have been stolen from a car in Hagley but hadn't been reported. After making enquiries the owners thought the car had been tampered with but didn't realise that is how the ipod went missing.

Intelligence suggests that as well as breaking into cars, offenders are walking around areas and finding more and more unlocked. This may be forgetfulness or a deliberate ploy to avoid the damage a break in involves and that would be fine if no property were left in the car. However if the property is stolen from a vehicle with no obvious signs of entry then insurance claims may not be honoured.

The only way to avoid a break in is not to leave property on view in your car including cables for lap tops, Sat Navs etc and to wipe the circle off the window that the Sat Nav holder makes. These are all clues that there may be property worth stealing and make sure your car is locked.





Stourbridge Speakers Club

Sweaty palms, shortness of breath, blurred vision? No, you aren't having a heart attack. You're giving a speech! So commenced an article in Forbes Business Magazine. On Monday February 1st undoubtedly there will be one or two experiencing the above symptoms, as it's the club's annual speaking competition. But competitions are a very small part of what we do at Stourbridge Speakers Club. The Forbes article went on to list top tips from 28 experienced speakers. We may not have that many speakers but we have sufficient to be able to provide help, advice, guidance and encouragement to anyone wanting to improve their speaking skills, whatever their current level of experience or confidence.

Here's a good tip: breathe! It is instructive sitting close to the lecturn when a nervous speaker is performing. You can hear them gasping for breath, which does nothing to help their performance. There are some simple fixes for this. Settle yourself before you speak—the audience will wait—and take a deep breath. Don't speak too quickly. Use frequent pauses to allow the audience to absorb what you've said and to allow yourself time to breathe. Watch the likes of Barack Obama or Tony Blair to see this in action.
