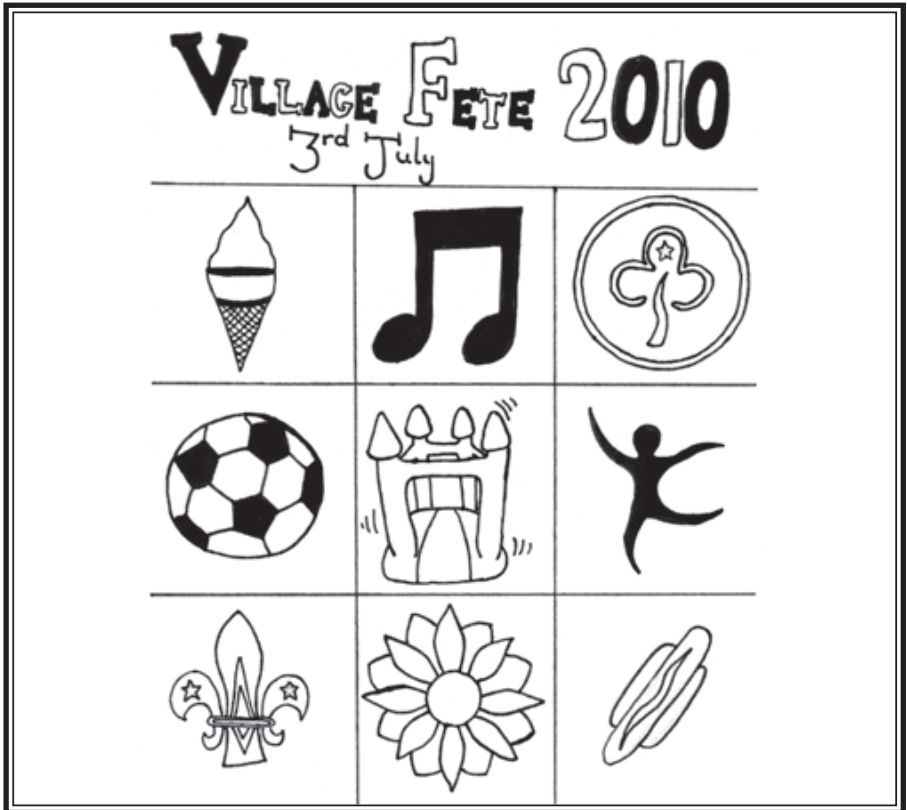

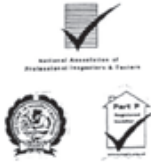

The car park in front of the Community Centre is for the exclusive use of any organisation hiring the hall. It is not a public car park and there have been a number of occasions when cars have been parked by persons not hiring the hall, causing inconvenience to hirers who have not been able to gain access. In several cases, when asked to remove their cars, the culprit has become abusive.

We will not tolerate abusive behaviour. The committee responsible for the management of the centre are volunteers and do so in their own time without reward. In future the barrier will prevent entry except for hirers, who will have a key to gain access and a notice to this effect is shown clearly by the barrier.

If anyone disregards this notice, advising that parking is prohibited, and subsequently finds themselves locked in they will have to leave their car in the car park until the next hirer appears which could be days in some cases.

We have taken this approach rather than use wheel-clamping companies as release fees are extortionate and we are not out to make capital from this necessity but are endeavouring to prevent it.

The car park may therefore be locked AT ANY TIME. The library staff will also be unable to open it.

Please also note that the bins in the Community Centre car park are for hirers only and not available to the public. HCA pays for these from hirer's fees.

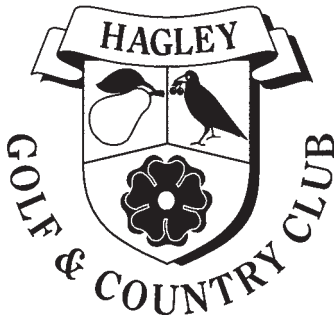

BRIDGE REPAIRS

The bridge between the railway station and the playing fields has been (or is about to be) replaced. Those of you that use it will know what a poor state this was in and it had become a safety concern. Apologies for any inconvenience caused by the access being closed for the duration of the works.

HAGLEY STATION

The Council has received details of planned renovation works to Hagley Station. The works are planned to start as soon as possible and be completed by the end of the summer.

PLANNING

Application **10/0378** Outline planning permission for 39 dwellings to the rear of Brook Crescent. The Parish Council has objected strongly to this application on grounds of the effect on the local infrastructure and community (services, schools, roads), road safety, housing needs, the Air Quality Management Area (A456), the Area of Development Restraint of which this location is part. This development is not needed or wanted in Hagley as per the Hagley Parish Plan.

Many local residents have also objected, in fact 76 people turned up at our council meeting in May to voice their objections. Thank you to all who have sent comments and objections to Bromsgrove District Council on this. We await the outcome.

We are also awaiting the outcome of **09/1010** the proposed office development at Hagley Hall. Again there is a large volume of objections from residents, who have employed a planning consultant to make sure their views are represented to the planning authority. Hagley Parish Council has also raised objections to the proposals following representation from neighbouring residents.

We also looked at **10/0321-178** Worcester Road and **10/0382-1** Hall Lane, to which there were no objections. But with **10/0335-7** Station Drive, we objected on the grounds that it was not in keeping with the conservation area.

Local Policing in Hagley

I'd like to introduce a new member of the team, Sam Maher, our new CSO taking over from Claire who has moved to work as CSO in Leominster. Sam knows the village and attended one of the High Schools which should prove useful.

Hopefully we will see better weather this year so now is the time to think about keeping your home "Safe and Secure" when you are in the garden or popping out for short periods. We all like to keep our homes cool during the warmer weather but we also need to keep them secure against sneak in type offences.

We are a low crime area but this is the time when criminals target an area on foot looking to get into your home through an open door or window. They look for handbags, lap top computers, mobile phones and will steal car keys and cars if they can, but some simple steps can make your home more secure.

Please ensure side gates are secure so access can't be gained to the back of the house. Shut windows when you leave the house for any period and consider installing simple door alarms that ring when doors are opened which can also alert parents to the fact that a child has used the door. There are alarms like this that are small, cheap and hang on door handles which activate when the handle is touched and will help keep your home "safe and secure".

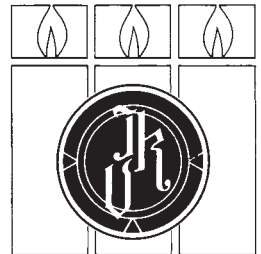

Dear Editor

I am sure that many of you will have noticed that there has been some considerable activity recently both at the Hall and on Wychbury Hill. When Tessa and I moved here two and a half years ago there was a long list of work that needed doing, some urgently and some not so urgently. The really important work involved the stonework at the Hall as many of the balustrades were crumbling and had become dangerous.

We had been talking to English Heritage about several initiatives that we needed to undertake and were delighted when they agreed to share the cost of the stonework, amounting to a total of some £440,000.

We have had an excellent team of stonemasons, scaffolders and other trades working over the winter and they have completed the project on budget and with only a couple of weeks slippage. Given the frigid weather conditions we experienced this was a tremendous result. Later this year we return to the programme of works. This phase is particularly exciting as we will be replacing the old mansard roof that was burnt off in the fire of 1925. This work is vital as the flat asphalt roof that we have had for the last 85 years is porous. This was probably not helped by the fact that, as children, we tended to use it as a skating rink in freezing weather!

The preparations and planning for this project are well underway and we expect to start the actual works in October. The total value of the new roof will be approximately £800,000 which, again, is being shared with English Heritage.

When we arrived back at Hagley it was apparent that the glorious grade I Park was in poor condition. Time could not erode the great beauty of the landscape in which it is sited, but the Park monuments, many of which are listed buildings in their own right, are in shocking condition. During a discussion with Natural England on the development of a higher level management scheme, the subject of the Wychbury Obelisk was raised. The monument has been in a parlous state certainly since the 1960s as I have correspondence between my father and the government dating back to those days noting that it was cracked and dangerous. Very fortunately it appeared that Natural England were in a position to help us and, at lightning speed, we developed a conservation plan which, as you will have seen, has been put into effect. We are hoping that in another few months the Obelisk will again dominate the Black Country. I climbed to the top of the scaffolding recently and I can only say that the view from up there is stunning.

The work that we have done represents a start on revitalising an incredibly important piece of our heritage. Much remains to be done. Apart from the Hall and Obelisk we have 7 other listed buildings in need of attention. The Temple of Theseus, by the Obelisk, has suffered terribly at the hands of vandals since it was last repaired in 1982. It is my great hope that over the next few years we will be able to set the estate back on its feet financially and that, again, we will be able to offer the Park as a haven of tranquillity to those who want to enjoy its unparalleled beauty.

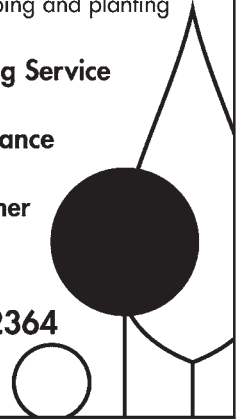
