Dear Editor

I write in support of S. Hinton's letter, July edition, related to ongoing inappropriate development in Hagley. I live close to the proposed major office development at Hagley Hall; a planning application for an office development of nearly 40, 000 square feet (enough space to accommodate 400 office staff). The proposed site is the field adjacent to the Scout Hut. This is a Green Belt site which should not, therefore, be developed. Green Belt policy is not designed for aesthetic purposes; it is designed to protect villages like Hagley from being engulfed by urban sprawl.

As local residents we have employed planning consultants to represent our views. The development has been marketed as a project to generate funds for the Hall. Our calculations and those of our planning consultants have raised serious concerns over the financial viability of the project. The consultant's full report is available for viewing at Hagley Library.

Hagley does not require more housing and, judging by current vacant office space in both West Hagley and Hagley Hall Mews, there is no demand or requirement for more office space.

Selling off and developing land, in and around Hagley has, for too long, been a quick, easy and unimaginative way to make money quickly and usually to the detriment of the local environment and residents. It's time residents made a stand to protect our village and it's time Bromsgrove DC started making some strong, sound planning decisions.

Policing in Hagley

We held another PACT meeting in September, again the numbers attending were low but the previous priorities, anti social behaviour involving litter and graffiti in the park at weekends, and parking in the disabled bay, bus stop and on the zig-zags were discussed. The Parish Council reported the placing of new litter bins in the park and the appointment of a new litter picker. We reported that we had carried out joint operations with British Transport Police and Network Rail around the park and railway station and the Traffic Warden had been visiting to address the parking issues. We will continue to work closely with our partners to address these issues but they will no longer be priorities. Two new priorities were adopted which were the repair of lighting in the park and the repair of the road surface in Middlefield Lane.

HISTORICAL & FIELD SOCIETY

Despite there being no meeting in August, the Society remained active with a day out on the Severn Valley Railway, taking in Sunday Lunch and a guided tour of the Engine House at Highley. We were blessed with fine weather and all had a most enjoyable day. Several Society members have also been involved in guiding visitors around Hagley Park when this has been opened to the Public.

Andy Cameron from Avoncroft Museum addressed our September meeting with an engaging account of how the museum started and what is currently happening. We learned a little of the 27 buildings on the 15 acre site and looked in some detail at those with timber frames and, in particular, at the recovery of the Cholstrey Barn from Warwickshire. The illustrated presentation was punctuated by some exciting demonstrations of how wooden frame buildings were constructed. Andy's lively and in-depth commentary ended all too soon but members were left anticipating the planned conducted tour of the museum in April next year.

On 2nd November Keith Cattell will talk on 'Our Victorian Architectural Heritage' and on 17th November there is a trip to Bantock House, followed by either the Molineux Hotel or Park Brewery in Wolverhampton. The December meeting is on the 7th of the month and is 'A 1940s Christmas', presented by Discover History. All will find a warm welcome at the meetings in St. Saviour's Church Hall at 8pm and on the various outings and rambles.

VICTORIAN HAGLEY

Stephen Roberts, who is Head of History & Law at Hagley Catholic High School, is fascinated by the Victorians. Here he offers us a glimpse into a very popular way of spending an evening in the nineteenth century ...

What happened at a Victorian soiree?

For the well-to-do of Victorian Hagley an invitation to a soiree was a great event. Most evenings were spent quietly at home, reading, sewing or playing cards. A soiree meant a night out – an evening of socialising with neighbours, listening to music and readings and singing. Imagine the excitement in Hagley as the invitations were received for a soiree organized by Lieutenant Colonel Barrows in March 1867 ...

Barrows had gone to a great deal of trouble. The evening began and drew to a close with E. Moore playing his cornet. Short talks from two of the guests - on Her Majesty the Queen and on the merits of the Post Office Savings Bank – featured early in proceedings. Barrows' son, accompanied by a Miss Jay, provided a pianoforte duet and a Mr Beach and H. Lyttelton and E. Rolfe entertained those assembled with their versions of the popular songs 'The Swallow', 'Let me like a soldier fall' and 'Alice, where art thou?' But this was not all that the guests were able to enjoy. Samuel Lover (1797-1868) is a now long forgotten Victorian novelist. However, he was as popular as his friend Dickens during his life time – and extracts read by Captain Wolrich from one of Lover's novels would doubtless have gone down well with Barrows' guests. The evening concluded with the guests joining in the singing of 'God Save The Queen'. Sated with music and conversation, Hagley's elite climbed into their carriages and soon afterwards into their beds.



We should never underestimate the power of the eyes as a means of communication. Alastair Campbell commented on his first meeting with Princess Diana: "There was something about her eyes that went beyond radiance. They locked onto you and were utterly mesmeric."

In one-to-one conversations we can look into the eyes of the other person much of the time. In fact, if we don't we may look shifty as though we have something to hide. But as audience size increases we need to divide our attention. Here the opposite applies. If we lock onto one person, they will feel uncomfortable very quickly. The trick is to scan everyone and make brief eye contact with each before moving on. This way we involve them in what we are saying and make it more difficult for them to ignore us. If a presenter uses lots of PowerPoint slides or a speaker reads from notes, the opposite can apply, resulting in a failure to connect with the audience.

Next time you are in conversation with a group of people, try making eye contact with them all and notice how much more they will listen to what you have to say.

Dear Editor

Having noted local police's continued description of Hagley as a low crime area, I can inform residents that West Mercia Police's own website currently rates Hagley (and Rural) Policing area as 2 categories higher than that, i.e. average.

In both July and August 2010, taking year on year comparisons, all of the following categories (all current priorities of local police) have increased - total crime by 71% both months, burglary by 80% and 160%, vehicle crime by 50% and 37%, and anti-social behaviour by 27% and 18%.

I also note that West Mercia Police's own standards of service charter requires all local policing teams to provide residents with a monthly update on specific local crimes and how offenders are facing justice, including publicising arrests and convictions. I hereby invite Hagley Police to reply to my letter in this publication to inform Hagley residents how this is currently being done.

Following Her Majesty's Inspectorate Of Constabulary's recent critical report of police not taking anti-social behaviour seriously enough, and West Mercia Police being instructed that they specifically need to improve, it is somewhat bizarre that at the same time temporary Bromsgrove Police Inspector Julian Smith has informed me that Hagley Police will NOT be enforcing the night-time curfew which applies to the local playing fields in the village centre, an established area of night-time anti-social behaviour and criminal damage as many residents are fully aware of.

Dear Editor

In reply to the letter from Mr Rowbottom, crime figures are published on a monthly basis on our Force website under 'Crime Mapper' and show crime figures for every Council Ward. They show the actual numbers per month for three months on a rolling programme and are compared with the same period last year, any changes are shown as a % figure. Our actual figures for all the crime committed in Hagley do show an increase over the summer months from an average of 12 last year to 20 this, but we feel this is low even with a small increase in burglaries. If you compare it to Pedmore they had 42 last year and 46 this, more than double the crime. Information regarding how offenders have faced justice comes from the courts and is not vet available. However the Home Office are working on it and when it is available it will also be published through our force website. We continue to address anti social behaviour issues within the Haglev area using a variety of tactics, these are the same tactics used across the Bromsgrove district which currently show a reduction in ASB of 20% compared with this time last year. We have discussed the old Bye Law curfew with our partners the Parish Council and we will continue to use more practical up to date tactics.
