

Results of tests

Information technology has meant massive changes in the speed that results can be tested, returned and acted on.

It would be wonderful to think that thanks to all of the above mistakes can no longer be made...they are.

Results can be delayed or misfiled. Samples can disappear into thin air, be contaminated, lack identifying labels or simply be inadequate in quantity. Everyone involved in the chain tries to avoid any of this happening of course but inevitably, from time to time, there are hiccups.

It is helpful to us if patients make a point of checking whether any results requested by the GP are back. Ask if they are normal or if further action is required.

The results are checked by a doctor every day, there are lots - help prevent yours slipping through the net. A quick telephone call, preferably between 11 and 2pm (when the lines are not so busy) would reduce the risk of missed results.

Allow a week before chasing and please, bear in mind, we only receive results of tests we have personally requested at the Practice. Results of tests requested by a hospital consultant will be returned to the consultant's secretary, not to the Practice. We do not link up nationwide.



HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

Parking

Indiscriminate (and often illegal) parking is a problem in Hagley. Not only do we see it but it also generates a lot of complaints from residents and visitors. Please be considerate in your parking, do not cause an obstruction, and those who do park illegally will get caught eventually.

The village car park is well used and we are aware that it is not just used by the shoppers for which it is intended. We do not have any plans to charge for using it but we are looking at imposing time restrictions to prevent all day use. Hopefully this will free up the car park spaces for shoppers.

Planning

In February the council looked at six applications. There were no objections to 11/0050 21 Summervale rd; 11/0045 Hagley Golf and Country Club; 12/0104 69 Summervale Rd and 12/0018 5 Hawthorn Coppice. We had no objections to 11/0050 67 Middlefield Lane but we did comment on the size of the extension and the location of the garage. We objected to 12/0017 to change the use of 76 Worcester Rd to a pizza takeaway as this is an unsuitable location.

We have objected to the appeal regarding 74 Worcester Rd but not 71 Lodge Crescent.

Precept

As you will be aware, part of the council tax you pay is the precept, which is the portion collected by the Parish Council. We will not be increasing the precept for 2012/13 so the amount you pay to us will not go up. Bromsgrove District Council has also agreed a 0% increase. At the time of writing we do not know the decision of the county council, the fire and police services.

CLENT PARISH COUNCIL

At 6.30pm CALA Homes gave a presentation of their plans for

housing and commercial development on land adjacent to the Newfield/ Western Rd. area of the Parish. An estimated 170 people attended Hagley Free Church Hall. Most of the audience remained dissatisfied with measures to deal with problems of traffic congestion, transport, air quality and access to schools and

These and other concerns were raised again during public question time and Parishioners were urged to write detailing their concerns to Bromsgrove Planning Department, as soon as CALA re-submit their plans. The Parish Council, together with Hagley PC will be submitting professionally supported objections at that time.

The Parish Council will be consulting on production of **Local Neighbourhood Plans**, over the coming year. These will give strength to the Parish in relation to future planning Issues.

Hedge and grass-cutting and pond clearance in Centenary Field will be carried out under strict environmental guidance, so that appropriate DEFRA grants may then be available.

Flashing speed sign, Newfield Road. Despite the low response to our inquiries, we will go ahead with installation.

We were advised that an application has been submitted for a grant to defray Parishioners' expenditure on the **Diamond Jubilee events.**

A Parish Council working party will develop plans for a Youth Council.

The main one is 230 houses proposed by Carla Homes in West Hagley, and the Western Road site, with approval for 37 new houses. A 12 house proposal for the Prince of Wales site has not yet been approved.





Who are you talking to? And why? Those might seem slightly odd questions but it is surprising how often presenters don't consider the questions with sufficient care before they get up to speak. The harsh reality is that the audience isn't particularly interested in the speaker. They want to know what the speaker has to offer them. If it is a business presentation, then the listener wants to know how they or their business can benefit from what is being said. If it is a social occasion, it is entertainment that is sought.

If we think carefully about the audience and ask ourselves what it is they really want to hear from us, it will help us to focus on creating a relevant message. While we should always address every member of the audience, it is worth keeping in mind that there could be key people who we may want to influence in particular. Without staring intently at them while we are speaking, it will do no harm to look at them a little more frequently than the other listeners. The way they respond to this eye contact could give us a clue as to how our message is being received. This may offer the opportunity to adjust our approach slightly. For example, if someone is leaning forward and cupping an ear, it is time to increase voice volume!






