## Hagley Surgery Easter Closing

Blood test results can be used to help diagnose a condition, to help eradicate a diagnosis or to check whether a patient is showing signs of improvement or deterioration.

Clinicians request hundreds of blood tests per week and our phlebotomists endeavour to undertake such requests as quickly as possible. The courier calls once per day, at lunchtime hence phlebotomy clinics are mornings only.

Often patients ask the phlebotomist extra questions such as checking for results, referral letters or to do blood pressure checks. The appointments are literally a couple of minutes, often double booked, so there is no time to do anything other than print off the request form, take the blood, label and bag the sample and record the details in the medical record.

We hope you will understand when, due to time constraints caused by sheer volume of requests, phlebotomy appointments are for blood taking only.

There is no guarantee of a place for all children living in our catchment area; however we have never had to refuse a place to a valid application from our catchment area which was made by the appropriate deadline for transfer to Year 7.

I hope this has clarified the point.



An audience of fifteen engaged in lively discussions at the meeting on 19th March meeting in the Parish Hall.

#### Pond

Volunteers have pollarded the willows, and following silt extraction, marginal plants will be placed around the pond's inflow.

#### Hedge

The radical cutting and intended re-planting of the hedge alongside Holy Cross has left a number of log piles for wildlife support. Please do not disturb!

#### Recreation

Two options for skateboard facilities were displayed. We will decide which to acquire depending on user preference, costs and grants.

The new gated access and the temporary cricket pavilion are now being erected. Cricket matches in Centenary Field will commence in May.

With the grant of  $\pm 1100$  from County that must be spent by end of March, we will purchase three benches and many pond plants.

We are applying for the 'Queen Elizabeth II Fields Challenge'. This will protect the Recreation Fields against future housing and commercial development.

We approved an additional sum to enable the newly appointed Play Safety Inspector to pick litter in the recreation areas. We look for volunteers to rid the Parish of the litter scourge!

A deputation from Hagley and Clent will meet with Bromsgrove Senior Planners to express opposition to CALA Homes plans.

## HISTORICAL & FIELD SOCIETY

In something of a departure from recent meetings, our March gathering featured a talk on the United States. Paddy Hannigan, making his first appearance at one of our meetings, enthralled us with a riveting presentation, entitled "Boom or Bust – the USA in the 1920s and 1930s".

Paddy started with the economic miracle of the USA after the First War. It seemed that everyone could enjoy the life-changing inventions of the 1920s – electricity, radio and the motor car and the country seemed determined to enjoy life to the full. However, beneath the glossy veneer lurked racial tension, religious intolerance, crime and corruption. Attempts to enforce prohibition actually resulted in the number of bars increasing and restrictions on imports resulted in American goods finding no outlets for export. Over production, extended credit and speculation on the stock market eventually culminated in the Wall Street Crash of 1929. Thousands were ruined overnight, unemployment soared and many people starved, the Great Depression only ending as war loomed in 1939. This was a fascinating presentation delivered with consummate skill and the parallels with our own time were obvious to all.

Our next trip to the Hurd Library at Hartlebury Castle is over-subscribed and so a second visit has been arranged in May.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 1st May, when Jo Roche will present "Abberley Hall and Clock Tower". This will be followed by a visit to Abberley. Visitors are most welcome at our meetings held at St. Saviour's Church Hall at 8pm.

The three Rotary Clubs in the Stourbridge area have joined clubs across the world, in raising \$200 million for a major polio eradication fundraising challenge – achieving their objective with months to spare. The fundraising milestone was reached in response to a \$355 million grant from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, which would be awarded as long as Rotary raised \$200m by June 30 2012.

Chris Fonteyn, President of Stourbridge says: "We'll celebrate this achievement, but it doesn't mean that we'll stop raising money or spreading the word about polio eradication. We can't stop until our entire world is certified as polio free." Neil Brazier President of Kinver, adds: "Raising this incredible amount is thanks to the support of communities across the world. Rotary is very much part of our local communities and seeks to support them, but we also need the communities to support us, and I would like to say thank you to everyone who has helped to stop polio."

Bill Harris, President of Hagley: "Every time someone donates to End Polio Now, we take another step closer to saying goodbye to the disease and saving children from a lifetime of crippling pain."

Rotary club members worldwide have contributed over \$1 billion toward the eradication of polio. In 1988, the World Health Organisation, UNICEF and the CDC joined Rotary as spearheading partners of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. The Gates Foundation gave Rotary a \$100 million challenge grant for polio eradication in 2007. This was increased to \$355 million in 2009 and an additional \$50million is being committed by the foundation. **David Dewhirst**

## Stourbridge Speakers Club

Recently I watched two people perform on stage. One had presence, the other did not. What was the difference? One walked on and off stage with her head held high and looking assured. The other had her head slightly forward, looking at the floor in front as she walked. I am not suggesting that we should swagger around, but it is important to remember that we will make more impact if we put on a 'performance'. Part of giving a performance is having a presence, 'owning the stage' if you like. And remember, we are on stage from the moment the audience can see us.

So how do we create presence? Firstly, we must believe in ourselves and the message we are about to deliver. We need to practise it. We must be able to deliver it in an authoritative manner. We should look the part – it is important to know the audience and the occasion so that we are appropriately dressed. It is always better to be over-dressed slightly than the other way around. Being well turned out will give us confidence.

Remember that research shows that the actual words we use account for 10% at most of the effectiveness of the message. The way we deliver it is all important. 


