

Hagley Surgery

Important Information

Our whole computer system is to be overhauled week commencing 25th February 2013.

This is a massive project whereby all of our patient records and attachments are transferred over to a clinical system called EMISweb.

There is also a huge amount of non clinical data to be migrated.

It will take a few weeks for the doctors, nurses and clerical staff to familiarise themselves with the new system, its hardware and the necessary software.

It may mean that some services will be temporarily affected, in particular, on line transactions via EMISaccess

Please be patient, this will be very stressful for all concerned, we have training days booked (which will help) but nonetheless it will take time for everyone to feel confident with the new system.



HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

Hagley Business Association

We would like to thank all the shops and businesses of Hagley for the Christmas Event. We hope to work with the Association for the future good of the village.

Vacancy

We still have a vacancy on the council. If you are interested please come and observe a couple of meetings (details on the notice board and website) and have a chat with one of the clerks.

Council Meetings

All the council meetings are open to the public. Sometimes the council will go into private session when the public have to leave. To clarify this, it is not intended to hide anything, but under the standing orders of the parish council, this is to discuss matters of a confidential nature. If appropriate such matters will be openly discussed and minuted at a later date.

Planning

In November, the council looked at five applications. There were no objections to 12/0913 65 Worcester Road; 12/0894 40 Summervale Road and 12/089624 Long Close. The council objected to 12/0818 49 Park Road due to the possible effect on the neighbour and 12/0921 The Cottage, Wassell Grove as an inappropriate development in the green belt.

This council also strongly objects to the Cala proposals, the plan for 70 houses in Western \sim Road and the plans for new houses in Hoarstone.

The Cala Homes app was withdrawn from the December planning meeting by BDC following legal advice received from 'Number 5 Chambers' on behalf of Hagley and Clent Parish Councils. In summary "The purpose of this advice is to consider the lawfulness of a decision by the committee if it were to grant permission in line with the officer's recommendations."

Apologies for those many residents who turned up to the meeting only to be told the news. The Parish Council was initially working to a planning committee date in early January.

BDC's decision to include it in the December meeting meant that objections had to be submitted sooner than planned with some omissions. The final objections were subsequently submitted as soon as they were complete. This included the legal advice and was submitted as soon as it could have been.

We are waiting to hear the outcome with the next likely meeting date 7th January 2013.

CLENT PARISH COUNCIL

Clent Parish Council Meeting 19th November, in Clent Parish Hall

An Outline of Major issues.

All areas of the Parish were represented by a lively audience of around forty people.

Following Mrs. Nation's regrettable resignation from Chair and Council, Councillor Robb was elected Chairman. He paid tribute to his predecessor.

Plans for 70 houses at Streathern, Western Road.

The Council are opposing this development. We agreed a contingency fund of £5000, and will employ RCA Regeneration to professionally analyse and criticise the details of the plans as they come forward. A number of well-informed suggestions from the audience together with other appropriate arguments will form part of our opposition, which will be co-ordinated with Hagley Parish Council and Hagley Residents Action Group.

Grass/Hedge/Maintenance

Weather conditions and late fall have delayed cuts. These will be carried out as soon as practicable. The working party will then meet the contractor to discuss future needs.

Our Lengthsman and our Maintenance man are retiring. We resolved to interview for a joint role.

Cricket Club

Following negotiations with the Cricket Club it was agreed that the Council will carry public liability when the field is open during the off-season. The club will erect a low fence around its pavilion, and curtail its fenced enclosure at the steeply sloped end, thus enlarging the meadow zone.

Skateboard improvements

The Council resolved in principle to improve the skateboard facilities. The nature of the improvements will depend on the total likely cost. Further research will be undertaken.

HISTORICAL & FIELD SOCIETY

Not inappropriately for its November meeting, the Society welcomed back Graham Sutherland to talk about the Gunpowder Plot of 1605. The story of how Robert Catesby led a group of Catholics in a plot to assassinate the Protestant King James 1 and replace him with his daughter Princess Elizabeth is well known but Graham's presentation focused on the Midlands connections. The plot started in Catesby's home in Lapworth but the plotters were betrayed and Guy Fawkes arrested and tortured. The remaining plotters had taken supplies from Warwick Castle and gunpowder from Hewell Grange before taking shelter at Holbeche House. Here they managed to blow the roof off when a spark ignited the gunpowder they had been drying in front of the fire. The following day the house was surrounded by the Sheriff of Worcester and the plotters killed or captured. Graham presented the story in his usual absorbing style with modern and contemporary illustrations and left us with some interesting questions over whether Fawkes was set up (even if he did achieve lasting infamy).

November saw two fascinating walks around Chaddesley Corbett led by Sylvia Beardshaw (followed by a pub lunch) and an equally interesting visit to the Birmingham Museums Collection Centre.

Our next meeting in St Saviour's Hall is on 1st January, when your scribe will present "Return to 1963" as an introduction to the Society's Fiftieth Anniversary.
