





HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

Please note that there will be a public meeting hosted by the Parish Council where you will have the opportunity to raise questions and concerns over the Kidderminster Rd development directly with BDC's Head of Planning and Regeneration (Ruth Bamford) and representatives from Cala Homes. Please see local notice boards and the website for more details. All welcome.

Other planning issues – Hagley Parish Council objects to the proposed McCarthy and Stone Development on the old middle school site in Park Road. The members believe that it is overbearing, out of keeping with the area and has a detrimental effect on the street scene and character. At the time of writing the full objections will be submitted shortly. The next available planning committee date where the application will be heard is on the 4th March. Please see the website for more details.

The Western Rd application hearing is expected shortly. Hagley Parish Council has submitted its objections and will be represented at the planning meeting.

CLENT PARISH COUNCIL

Meeting 21st January 2013, in Clent Parish Hall

Outline of Major Issues

The Chairman welcomed newly elected Councillors Alan Hess and Ed Sheppard onto the Council.

Youth Council

The young people have negotiated to take on an allotment plot, have agreed on the design of new skateboard ramps, and are eager to contribute to their page on the website.

Skateboard Park

The Council resolved to place an order for the new equipment. This will consist of two facing quarter-pipes on tarmac adjacent to the basket ball post (to be dismantled). Measures to reduce noise and improve safety are included in the total cost of $\pounds 13,000$.

Finance

Extensive discussion of anticipated expenditure resulted in an increase of the Precept figure to $\pounds 75,000$.

Streathern, Western Rd. plans

Councillors had received the draft objection document from our professional advisors. Our Ward Councillor Mrs. Sherrey had advised Planning Officers of a number of concerns, and said she was supportive of the Parish Council objections to the plans as they stand.

Street Lights

The resolution to remove/replace the 'Rocks' light was deferred. Council will carry out further consultations and enquire from County as to which authority is responsible for the light.

Newsletter

It was agreed to produce a Newsletter, both online and hard copy, during February. We re-iterated that in future the annual newsletter that precedes the AGM will continue to be hard-copy, but other quarterly newsletters will be online only unless specifically requested by a parishioner. HISTORICAL & FIELD SOCIETY

1963 was an auspicious year. The major world event was the assassination of President Kennedy in Dallas but the year started with the Big Freeze in the UK. Other notable events were the Great Train Robbery, the Profumo affair, Harold Wilson becoming Labour leader, Alec Douglas Home succeeding Harold McMillan and the publication of the Beeching Report. The Beatles dominated the music scene, the BBC transmitted the first episode of Dr Who and the Compact Cassette was introduced. In Hagley 1800 buses served the village each week (including the 253, Sweetpool Lane to Stourbridge) and you could have seen a Midland Red bus every three minutes on summer Sundays. The village was experiencing massive housing growth, the library had been opened the previous year, the A491 was linked to the new M5 and Issue 1 of the Village News appeared. Into this maelstrom was launched the Hagley Historical & Field Society on 31st July and its first event followed on 28th September with a visit to Buildwas Abbey. The first meeting was on 15th October, when Len Nock and Martin Lister showed photographs of the rapidly-disappearing old village.

Your scribe attempted to cover all this (and more) in his presentation at the January meeting, thus setting the scene for the Society's 50th anniversary.

Our next meeting in St Saviour's Hall is on 5th March, when Richard Perrin will present "Bewdley, a Riverside Town". Visitors are always welcome to our events – come and join us and you won't regret it.






