

Dawn was born on 3.12.1914. She worked for solicitors in London and loved to walk over London Bridge where nearby she owned a flat. She was, during the 2nd World War, working with the WRAF plotting the whereabouts of enemy fighters close to the Southern coast.

She met her husband Paul Spencer in Berlin where they were both posted after the war, and involved in a commission to repatriate Art items which had been stolen by the Nazis.

Paul and Dawn came back to Britain and had three children whilst whilst living in Kineton, Warwickshire.

Dawn was always interested in assisting people and became involved with arranging meetings of similar like-minded people at her house. She also was involved in the starting of a new Abbeyfield Coventry and one in Knutsford.

They moved to Earlsdon Coventry at that time where Paul was the World Marketing Manager for Massey Ferguson Tractors.

Paul then took up a position as Warden of Foxhill Chester Diocesan Centre where he was ably assisted by Dawn and they met and worked alongside many people who had connections with their Church.

They then moved to Hagley and set up meetings at their home in Summervale Road, and made many long term friends.

Dawn's health has generally been fine, although she has had various falls and times in hospital, but has always looked on the positive side of life when anything difficult has occurred.

Dawn's life continues in a very pleasurable way at Abbeyfield in Hagley for herself and for all those she comes into contact with.

HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

Happy New Year from everyone at Hagley Parish Council and best wishes for 2015. It promises to be yet another busy year with a number of important dates and events coming up.

The first news is that the Hagley community bus is gathering registered users very quickly and at the time of writing preparations are being made to begin the service. If you haven't registered yet, there is still time, there are no limitations, the only qualification is that you live in the village of Hagley. Call 0121 453 9682. If in doubt call this number and help will be given.

The other news is related to the Parish Boundary review. The deadline is the end of January so there is still time to register your vote. Hagley Parish Council is supporting Option 1 as it believes this will be for the greater good of Hagley, bringing in additional investment and community unity without any additional cost to the tax payer, improving services at the point of use i.e. Hagley Village. There will be no changes to addresses wherever you live in Hagley. To stay the same will mean more of the same for the foreseeable future i.e. Hagley community subsiding the local precept and a split parish council representation. There is an extra way of downloading an additional form off the website *www.bromsgrove.gov.uk/cms/council-and-democracy/electoral-services/elections* which can be emailed a scanned copy to *democracy@bromsgroveandredditch. gov.uk* or sent to Electoral Services Manager, Town Hall, Walter Stranz Sq, Redditch B98 8AH. This will enable you to register extra votes for other household members whom I hope will also support Option 1.

Many thanks to everyone who attended the launch of Hagley Library partnership with Worcestershire County Council and special mention to the VIP Mrs Hazel Austin and lead Councillors for Hagley Library Cllr Margaret Pritchard and Cllr Austin.

There will be a Parish council election in May. More details later in the year.



Bartolomeo Cristofori called his invention of 1709 the "Arpicimbalo del piano e forte" and fortunately for subsequent generations this soon became shortened and today we know it as the "piano".

The Story of the Piano was the subject of our speaker this month, Andrew Crabtree. However, this was a story with a difference because Andrew is an accomplished musician and with his electronic keyboard it was more an intimate concert than a talk. He played us twelve pieces ranging from the Romantic music exemplified by the middle movement of Beethoven's Pathétique Sonata through Schubert, Schumann and Chopin to the Jazz age with Scott Joplin's Maple Leaf Rag. We are hoping that Andrew can be persuaded to return for another presentation next season and perhaps he will include a bit of George Gershwin and maybe Ludovico Einaudi and Michael Nyman.

Our monthly Sunday afternoon walk in November was through Hagley Park. Nineteen members and visitors were blessed with a mild and sunny late autumn afternoon to view the renovated cascades which were in full flow due to the heavy rain of previous days.

Our meeting on Tuesday 6th January at 8pm sees Tim Booth presenting 'The Mills on Dowles Brook in the Wyre Forest'. He will takes us back to the start of the Industrial Revolution and how ironworking brought employment and affluence to a rural backwater.
