

On behalf of the members of Hagley Parish Council I would like to thank Richard Bache for many years of service and support. Richard has decided to step down from the Parish Council and we all wish him the very best for the future. Given that the Parish Elections are on the 7th May it has been decided not to seek a replacement this late in the day.

A number of complaints have been received in respect of the road markings and signage on the new road layout at the signalised traffic island. It has been confirmed by County Highways that the markings have failed the safety audit and so will be corrected ASAP. We have also received complaints in respect of the light pollution from the traffic signals; light filters are being added to minimise the 'light spillage' ASAP.

There have recently been two major road traffic accidents on the A456 in Hagley; I have asked the Lead Councillor Paul Johnson to contact the Safer Roads Partnership and Road Accident Investigation Team on behalf of the Parish Council for further information.

There has been some good news in respect of the proposed link road between the Kidderminster Rd development and the Western Rd development. After submitting our concerns to WCC Highways, County Councillor Jenkins and Bromsgrove planning department, some welcome common sense was applied and the proposed road has been dropped. Whilst there is a further 17 houses being added to the development in the grand scheme of things this was a good result.

At the time of writing we are preparing for the Annual Parish meeting which will be reported on in full in the May edition of the News. Just a quick 'heads up' in respect of the forthcoming Parish Council elections on the 7th May. For further information please contact the Clerk.

One thing that these eight have in common is that they are supported by The 'Friends of Birmingham Museums'. Our speaker this month, Deborah De Haas, Chairman of the Friends, explained what she and her fellow members did to support the museums through social and fundraising events. The Trust has been in existence for 85 years and currently has over 1000 members. In recent years it has raised up to £25,000 per year to help acquire works of art of all descriptions to enhance the museums' collections.

Hagley PACT Meeting

Thursday 22nd January 2015

Update on Previous PACT Priorities (from September 2014)

1. Boy Racers on the A456 in the vicinity of the Badgers Sett public house.

West Mercia Police have carried out several recent operations. Councillors Jenkins and Colella observed an operation when a number of drivers were disrupted by police. Later unmarked police cars conducted an operation on the A456 when tickets were issued, 2 persons reported for careless driving and a male arrested for dangerous driving. Then 50 officers and an air unit dealt with over 400 boy racers in Worcester who moved all over the county and numerous cars were dealt with.

2. Illegal Parking outside Hagley Primary School.

Police have attended when resources have allowed, asking offending drivers to move on when necessary. District Council Enforcement Officers have also attended and County Councillor Jenkins has requested double yellow lines for the opposite side of Park Road to the school to dissuade illegal parking in that area too.

3. Community Speedwatch.

A formal request was submitted to West Mercia Safer Roads Partnership. Due to a high number of requests from communities across Worcestershire, Hagley is currently on the waiting list.

New PACT Priorities

Nuisance/illegal parking in Worcester Close area, posible breaching of Except For Access Order.

Police to identify any offending vehicles and issue warning notices.
