

HAGLEY PARISH COUNCIL

I am really pleased to report that the request to have the Parish boundary changed has been supported by Bromsgrove District Council. The Option 1 as submitted by HPC has been supported and will go to the next stage of public consultation from 1st April to 30th June. After which, assuming nothing changes, the final phases of the Community Governance Review will be concluded in the Autumn after which the formal administrative changes will be formalised in May 2016.

This is a significant change in Hagley's history and something that should be celebrated. The response in favour of a change across the whole of Hagley and the whole of Clent was overwhelming with 80% of those who 'voted' (1,450) favoured the change. HPC has formally thanked BDC and confirmed that Option 1 should be formally submitted to the Local Communities and Government Commission.

A further meeting of the Highways and Sewer flooding project group was held in April with continued support from the various statutory bodies. Severn Trent Water continue to carryout survey works to 'map' the capacity of the drainage systems.

The older youth play equipment has taken a step closer with the formally planning application being submitted to BDC. Works should start over the coming months.

There have been many complaints raised particularly in respect of the new traffic light and road junction layout at the junction of Worcester Rd and Kidderminster Rd; these complaints have been taken up with the WCC Engineer. HPC is concerned that these recent changes have had a significant adverse impact on road safety and congestion in the area and we will campaign to resolve these complaints. Please continue to send your complaints to your elected members and the Clerk of HPC.

Please watch out for 'Hagfest' a summer music event for all the family supported by HPC to raise money for the rebuilding of the community centre. Keep the 4th July free in your diary. This event is planned to replace the summer fete which unfortunately has had to be cancelled this year.

If you've missed it, 7th May is election day with some important changes; non least the split of Hagley into Hagley East and Hagley West for the district council ward boundary. This was as a result of BDC reducing its members from 39 to 32. Hopefully you will have seen whether you live in East or West. If in doubt check your ballot card for more details. Of course the Option 1 Parish boundary change will not take effect until next May; confusing I know.

Historical & Field Society

Notwithstanding road works and queues, we take our Hagley roads very much for granted and we rely on the County Council for their maintenance. However, 400 years ago it was a parish responsibility and each adult male was expected to spend six days per year on road maintenance without pay.

Roads improved, we were told by our speaker Julian Hunt, in the 1700s when acts of parliament were passed to introduce Turnpikes. These roads were maintained through the collection of tolls at toll houses along the route. Many toll houses have now gone but probably the nearest example is the 'Hasbury Stores' at Haley Green. Of course collection of tolls means toll collectors and local worthies bid for the right to collect these on the understanding that all money collected was spent on road maintenance. Not all of it was of course and profits were made. Some things do not change.

We are fortunate in Hagley that we still retain our parish archives. Among them you can find lists of the ten notable locals annually selected by the Constable of Hagley to assist the Highways Surveyor in determining what maintenance was required. These archives are kept under environmentally controlled conditions and supervised by a Parish Archivist. The post of Parish Archivist is currently vacant and there is an advert elsewhere in this magazine giving details for anyone interested in the post.

Our meeting on Tuesday 5th May at 8pm in St. Saviour's Church Hall is a ticket only Social Evening followed by 'Videos of Old Hagley'.






