In addition to all the other work Hagley Parish Council is leading on, it has resolved to begin the process to deliver a Neighbourhood Plan. This will run throughout the year and where possible the newest generation of LED lighting will be used.

Hagley House

Hagley House was thought to be Georgian (1715) and stood on the land at the corner of Birmingham Road and Stourbridge Road. The gate house stood under what is now the east bound carriageway of the Birmingham Road at Milton Drive. In the early 1900's it was owned by the Hatton family but on Tuesday 10 October 1933 the house was sold at auction at the Talbot Hotel Stourbridge by Edwards Son & Bigwood. The large Holm Oak in the centre of Milton Drive was no doubt in the grounds.

Historical & Field Society

Did you read a newspaper this morning? Did you happen to notice whether it had be ironed or did you iron it yourself? If the later then you are likely to be working 'Downstairs'. If the former or you assume it always comes like that, then you are either very lucky or living 'Upstairs'. This contrast between life 'Upstairs' and 'Downstairs' portrayed in such television series as 'Downton Abbey' and others seems to have captivated people wherever they are shown in the world.

Whether the portrayal is entirely accurate or not, it represents a life that did exist for some. This was the topic for our speaker this month, Patrica Boyd who kindly stepped in as a replacement at short notice. She explained that for many large and desperately poor families in rural areas, to have a child accepted into the hard drudgery of service 'Downstairs' was a blessed alternative to starvation. In contrast, those 'Upstairs' faced the problem of having to eat twelve course dinners and for the ladies at least, to maintain an 18" waist, the fashion of the time. The secret apparently is to have small courses and spend three hours eating them. So simple really!

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 1st March when we will have a presentation by Ben Nock entitled 'Clandestine Communications in WW2'. Ben is a curator at the Military Wireless Museum in Kidderminster. He will describe electronic spy equipment used in wartime. A visit to his museum is planned for early spring. Visitors are most welcome at all our events – see hhfs.org.uk for details and contacts.

GARDEN TIPS FOR MARCH

Shower Caps

Cover your seed trays and pots with discarded shower caps to keep warmth and moisture in until the seeds germinate. They are more convenient than plastic bags as the elastic edge holds them in place.

Mothballs and Snakes

Mice chew off the seedlings in the greenhouse to prevent place small plastic snakes (from a toy shop) on the staging and around the pots, add mothballs or pieces of firelighter dotted around the trays. If the smell doesn't put them off then the snakes will frighten the life out them. It works!

Raising money for ShelterBox

At the start of the year, people often set themselves targets to get active, but Colin Bell, a member of the Rotary Club of Bodmin has recently completed a year-long challenge of epic proportions.

Colin aimed to run 2015 km during 2015, and if that wasn't ambitious enough, he completed lots of it with a Shelterbox strapped to his back, all to raise money for the charity.

The miles have been accumulated by taking part in fun runs, challenges and full length marathons right across the country, with Colin's total distance equating to 48 marathons over the course of the year.

ShelterBox is a disaster relief charity providing large plastic containers filled with essential items, such as tents thermal blankets and cooking equipment, for families who have been displaced following disasters. A new date for the visit to House of Commons is awaited. Hagley Rotary has suggested the possibility of a joint fundraising event.

Finance

A precept totalling £45,000 for 2016/17 was confirmed, implying a modest increase for Householders. Although expenditure was budgeted in excess, the shortfall will be taken from reserves.

Police Report/NHW

The appointment of a Rural and Business Crime Co-Ordinator was noted.

District/County Councillors

Cllr Mrs Sherrey advised that Bromsgrove DC had moved into their Parkside Offices in December. Reductions in Government Grants for 2016/17 were greater than anticipated, but a proportion of Business rates will be paid direct to Bromsgrove DC to partially offset the drop in Grant.

Cllr Collella advised changes to New Homes Bonus payments were being discussed which would result in reduced payments to local Councils.

Cllr Jenkins reported a substantial reduction in Grants for next year.

Grass Cutting/Centenary Field/Play Areas

Younger children's swings and climbing frames are to be replaced and skateboard ramp upgraded. The problem of water pooling near the pond is to be investigated. Leaves on footpath leading to school are to be cleared and a dangerous tree stump by the entrance to Pool Furlong is to be removed.







Hagley Surgery

This is an update on the changes that have taken and will be taking place at Hagley Surgery.

1. Dr Nick Hyde has now retired and we have a new GP, Dr Anna McDonald.

2. The Surgery became part of the Wyre Forest Partnership in December 2014 which involved 7 surgeries joining together to enable sharing of expertise, information, ordering of equipment etc., which hopefully will make management more efficient. The surgeries will still remain independent bodies, retaining their own individual identities, so there will no detrimental effects on patient care in Hagley. The other surgeries in the Partnership are from Bewdley, Kidderminster and Stourport.

3. Hagley Surgery is hoping to build an extension to allow for the increase in patients expected from the new housing developments going on around Hagley. This will inevitably mean some disruption to the surgery facilities as the roof will have to be taken off to allow further consulting rooms to be built – the situation is still under discussion and any developments will be notified in due course.

4. A new patient survey is being prepared to allow patients to have their say in how they think the surgery is performing – please watch out for this.
