Hagley Parish Council

A lighting safety test and replacement plan has been agreed which will see the replacement and upgrade of old concrete lamp posts and old inefficient 'old' style lamps. New steel columns and LED lights will be installed over this year. This will not only replace outdated and inefficient lamps but will reduce energy costs and improve safety and give better street lighting. Once this first phase is completed a second phase will commence in 17/18 with any final sweep ups being completed the year after if necessary.

The Safer roads for Hagley campaign continues with the outcomes of the planned meeting between the County Highways Department and Cala Homes eagerly awaited. Depending on these outcomes will determine the next steps.

The hanging baskets and flower tubs will be planted with a 'Red, White and Blue' theme this year to commemorate the Queen's 90th birthday. The Hagley WI Branch will supply an additional bench to be placed in the playing fields. HPC is happy to support this and arrange for it to be fixed at the top of the playing fields overlooking the park.

A re-application has been made for a defibrillator which, if successful, would be put in a location where it can be easily accessed in cases of emergencies.

A formal notification has been sent to Bromsgrove District Council informing it that HPC intends to start work on a Neighbourhood Plan. There follows a brief consultation period where interested parties and stakeholders are informed. A project plan is being prepared by HPC and project team which will include community consultations, data gathering and surveys.

Since the last Parish Council update Francesca Evans and Rachel Jenkins have resigned as Parish Councillors. On behalf of everyone at Hagley Parish Council I would like to wish them every success in the future and thank them both for all their hard work. Both are still very active in the community and we look forward to continuing to work with them over the coming months. This leaves two vacancies on the Parish Council. Please make any enquiries to the Clerks.

Finally congratulations and well done to our Clerk, Alexandra Burkes, for completing the CilCA exams (qualification for local council officers). Alex has being working hard on this qualification and represents a fantastic achievement and something that HPC will certainly benefit from.

Great Houses of Hagley



The Brake (in old English a place overgrown with bushes, brambles, or cane) stood at the corner of Brake Lane and Sweetpool Lane and it's not known when it was built but the residents for many years were the Olivers who had semi-royal antecedents.

Edward Milward Oliver (a farmer), his wife Ann and their 7 children were resident in 1841. Edward was the grandson of Hungerford Oliver who lived at Wollescote Hall. Hungerford's wife Prudence was descended from John of Gaunt (son of Edward III).

Residents in 1911 were George Hungerford Oliver (b. 1843) Harriet Maria Oliver (b. 1839) and Emily Catherine Oliver (b. 1847). These had all died before 1920 and the house passed into other hands before being demolished in 1963 and replace by the group of houses having the same name.

VERVE MARTIAL ARTS



Historical & Field Society

When you travel from Ulan Bator to Beijing via the Trans Mongolian Railway you will encounter at least three amazing things. The first is that you will cross the Gobi desert which is a vast, barren and featureless expanse which stretches in all directions as far as the eye can see. The second is that when you reach the Chinese border the gauge of the track built by the Russians across Mongolia is different from that built by the Chinese. Instead of changing trains as you might expect, three hours are spent hydraulically lifting your train carriage by carriage to change the wheels for your onward journey.

Finally you are presented by the stunning scenery of the lush, green mountains and valleys of China, shrouded in mist. Here you encounter a culture which has changed little over hundreds of years. This scenery and culture were exemplified by the photographs of our speaker this month, Gill Nicklin. She has spent several years exploring South West China gathering examples of traditional Miau costumes, many of which have taken years to make. She brought along examples for members to examine the exquisite needlework and colour and to try on.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 7th June. There will be a presentation by Avoncroft Museum entitled 'The Development of a Nailer's Cottage 1840s to 2016'. This cottage, which has been moved brick-by-brick and rebuilt at the museum, is significant because it chronicles the decline of the nail industry in Bromsgrove and rise of car manufacturing. 





Churchill Forge Watermill

It is a 19th century forge built on the site of a Norman water mill and manufactured farm implements, garden tools and shovels for steam locomotives, The products were so good many were exported or sold at upmarket London stores.

Now it is one of only a handful of forges in the country using water power and the 2 enormous wheels are set working on open days.

Open Days: 12th June, 10th July & 11th September (2.30pm to 5pm) Adults £4; Children FREE



In an idyllic setting, the enormous pond boasts plenty of wildlife. Come and watch the water wheels turn and enjoy the atmosphere inside the forge with experts on hand to answer any questions, view the old machinery and observe the items being made.

Churchill Forge is located in the village of Churchill in North Worcestershire, just off the A456 (Kidderminster to Hagley Road). The forge can be found a short distance along a dr ive off Churchill Lane. The turning is about 400 metres after Churchill church when coming from the direction of Blakedown, shortly before the junction with Stakenbridge Lane. The entrance is clearly signposted on open days.

(OS grid reference: SO882795.)

There is no parking space available along the drive to the forge and visitors should park on Churchill Lane.
