Hagley Parish Council

Hagley Parish Council would like to thank Fran, Rachel, Peter and the many volunteers who helped make Hagfest 16 such a fantastic event for the second year running. Proceeds are going to the CHub project and Birmingham Children's Hospital.

The weather completely behaved itself and everything went to plan, on time and without a hitch. This speaks volumes for the work and planning that went into this over the last three or four months.

The parish councillors are continuing to support the CHub project and are also supporting the use of the playing fields and supporting the provision of the working financial funds to underwrite the event.

To continue the theme of community events on the playing fields, the Street Theatre will again be coming to Hagley Playing Fields on the 4th August (11-3pm), all are welcome and it's free. This is an annual event organised by Bromsgrove District Council and again supported by HPC. Further details will be advertised nearer the day.

There have been a number of incidents of youths climbing onto the changing room roof and throwing objects into neighbouring gardens. As well as being an act of anti-social behaviour and so a matter for the police, it is foolhardy as the roof is unlikely to support excessive weight. The incidents have been reported to the police and the CCTV control room for further investigation.

The hanging baskets and planters at the entrances to the village have now been planted with a red, white and blue theme to commemorate the Queen's 90th birthday.

The 'Safer Roads for Hagley' campaign continues to be actively in dialogue with the authority that manages traffic management (similar to that in Blakedown); we have been encouraged by the initial support it has shown for Hagley's traffic problems.

Great Houses of Hagley

Park Farm stood in Park Road and was first recorded in the 1871 census as being occupied by John Taylor Birch and Nancy Birch (both aged 48). Nancy died in 1905 and John a year later. By 1911 Albert and Elizabeth Green were in residence and indeed later the farm was known locally as Green's Farm. The Greens lived at Park Farm until 1957 when it was demolished and Park Crescent

and Lodge Crescent were built on the site. When next in Park Road look carefully in the foliage which edges the footpath, there still exists a substantial gatepost which was at the entrance to the farm.



BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

At the June meeting of Bromsgrove District Council a motion was tabled to consider joining the West Midlands Combined Authority (includes Birmingham, Coventry, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall and Wolverhampton). The motion was ultimately withdrawn because of an irregularity and so may be re-tabled in September. In the meantime, both district councillors would welcome your thoughts on this matter.

At the same meeting there was a small majority decision to approve increasing the Capital budget for the new Dolphin Centre by £70k to £13.7m.

A unanimous decision was made to approve the 2016/17 New Homes Bonus scheme. This would see the scheme increase to £101,000 of which Hagley is able to apply for up to £20,000 for community capital bids. If your charity or self-help group (must be based in Hagley and for the benefit of Hagley) are interested in tapping into this grant please contact your district councillors who would be happy to give support and advise.

The District Council's leadership and cabinet has seen some major changes in July with Councillor Margaret Sherry resigning as leader and a number of cabinet members also resigning their posts. A new leader and cabinet would be announced at the July meeting of the District Council.

St. John's Hand & Tower Bellringers Our hand-bell ringers are preparing for another completion in Staffordshire later in the year. As with any new skill, practice makes perfect. Sue has joined the group recently and is having a very enjoyable time. All the bells are so much easier to ring having been renovated. The group are in urgent need of someone to join the group and play the larger bells. It's all about technique but the larger bells are a bit heavier, like waving about a

larger bag of sugar. So if you feel like being a hand-bell ringing heavy-weight, get in touch or just turn up at the Wychbury Room by the side of St. John's church by Hagley Hall any Wednesday evening from 7 pm. Other groups have gentlemen ringing the larger bells, so come on chaps, and have a go.

Our three novice tower bell-ringers are really getting stuck in. Thirteen year old Alice has mastered her rope handling skills. It's great to see the utter determination she has when ringing in rounds with the rest of the group. Her 12 year old brother Sam has just mastered hand and back stroke, so now it's just rope time / practice to put the two strokes together and he will be handling a bell on his own. The bell is over 5 times his own body weight, so some careful technique is involved. Our third novice is Shaz, who has just got the bit between her teeth and beginning to understand that to get the bell to ring slower you must pull the rope harder. Counter intuitive, but to ring slower the bell has to swing higher. The skill is letting the arms do the pulling while you listen to your own bell's sound.

The tower bell-ringers also meet on Wednesdays from 7:30pm. The group follows the Church of England's policy on Safeguarding. Children from about 10 years old are physically able to learn to ring the lighter bells.
