

Hagley Parish Council

Martin Freckelton (ex-President of Hagley Rotary Club) was invited to a recent HPC meeting to talk about the Rotary Club defibrillator project. The need for a defibrillator in Hagley had been previously raised by the Parish Council and it was recognised that this would be a fabulous opportunity for the two projects to come together with a common goal. The Parish Council congratulated the Rotary Club whilst Cllr Austin suggested that HRC might want to use HeartStart for any training in the use of defibrillator for village members and he would be happy to help. Further details in respect to where it will be installed and training will follow as soon as possible.

A number of complaints had been received about shrubbery overhanging pavements causing difficulty for pedestrians, especially those with pushchairs and in wheelchairs. Whilst pavements are a Worcestershire County Council responsibility members supported the Parish Council taking a proactive role in prompting residents to ensure that hedges and shrubbery are not overhanging the boundaries of their properties onto pavements and footpaths.

Outdated and inefficient street lighting across Hagley will begin to be replaced over the coming months. Old lighting will be replaced by LED lamps which are more effective and significantly cheaper to run. The works will be focused in the 'transfer' area and represents a commitment HPC made upon the recent change in the parish boundary and will be largely finished over a two year period starting this early autumn.

It may have escaped many residents' notice that BT has been working to install Superfast broadband in Hagley, go to www.superfastworcestershire.com to see if it is available to you. This is a good opportunity to remind everyone that the Library has a number of computers for public use, as well as the usual traditional aspects of a Library service. The Library staff and volunteers are always happy to help and there are a number of events and initiatives planned for all ages during holiday periods and throughout the year. Following a recent decision by WCC to reduce the opening hours of the Library we are pleased to report that HPC has resolved to take action to make sure that the opening times for the Library remain unchanged.

Great Houses of Hagley - THE COURT

Stood at the junction of the A456 and Stourbridge Road opposite Market Way and was in existence in 1600 because here Stephen Lyttelton and Robert Wintour, conspirator's in the Gunpowder Plot hid in a barn, were later captured, taken to London where they were hung drawn and quartered.

The Court was originally a farm was named after the Hollier family who owned it from 1734 until 1838. In 1849 John P Glazebrook

bought the farmhouse, and grounds and was very disparaging about it. It was his architect son Tom who drew up the plans for large extensions and the family changed the name to 'The Court'. Another Victorian farmhouse was built next door by the Lyttelton's for their tenant farmer and that was named Hollier's farm. A fountain was erected in 1915 to celebrate the Glazebrook's Golden Wedding opposite the house. This can be found now next to the large island at Park Road and the A449.

In the 1940s it became Hagley Court Nursing home run by Miss Muldoons. In the 1950s it became Hagley Court Hotel and Country Club. It was demolished in 1964 for extensive road widening.

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

At the BDC meeting on the 20th July 2016 it was agreed that a public consultation on the 'Proposed main Modifications' made by the Planning Inspector in the BDC Development Plan (DP) will commence on the 27th July for a period up to the 21st Sept 2016.

This is a recent requirement as part of the process to ensure that the DP can be adopted and for it to be seen to make the DP 'sound'. This sets in place the continued need for supplementary planning documents such as Neighbourhood Plans and Local Transport Plan.

Anyone interested in this stage please go to www.bromsgrove.gov.uk and search for proposed-mainmodifications-consultation. All documents related to the DP can be found on this site.

The BDC Finance Monitoring report showed that the council's underspend of £330,000 has been transferred to balances in addition to £8.3m (underspend on Dolphin project) from the capital budget.

A pre-consultation workshop for the WCC Local Transport Plan was attended.

The workshop was presented by senior WCC officers and was aimed at future applications for funding of strategic highways schemes and links into the Local Enterprise Partnerships strategic plans.

The opportunity was taken again to raise the many highways issues in Hagley

BDC's 'Community Safer Partnership' has supported Hagley Parish Council and Hagley schools by funding two new larger bins in the playing fields. This followed a period of increased littering on the playing fields and an increase in complaints.

It is a sad fact that when we are walking around our towns and cities we spend most of our time looking downwards, for all sorts of reasons, to watch where we are putting our feet. We rarely look upwards to admire the beautiful facades of our historic buildings.

This was a point was made by our speaker this month, Tim Bridges. Tim is a conservation advisor for the Victorian Society and his topic was 'Victorian Buildings of Birmingham and the Black Country'. We are lucky that the wealth generated during the Industrial Revolution centred in the 'Black Country' was lavished on many fine public buildings, churches and industrial buildings many of which still survive today. He showed many examples of these including St. Chad's Roman Catholic Church in Birmingham which is a fine example of Augustus Pugin's work. Nearer to home he cited the Red House Cone near Stourbridge as a now rare example of a building used in the glass industry. He did admit however, that it would be a brave man to suggest that Stourbridge was ever in the Black Country!

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 6th September. There will be a presentation by Simon Buteux, Director of the Birmingham Conservation Trust entitled 'The Coffin Works - Birmingham's Newest Museum'. His talk will describe the Trust's major project over the last decade to create a sustainable 'rescue' package for the Newman Brothers coffin fitting factory on Fleet Street in Birmingham's historic Jewellery Quarter. It is hoped we may be able to visit the Coffin Works later in the year. Visitors are most welcome at all our events – see hhfs.org.uk for details and contacts.
