

# **Hagley Parish Council**

After a very busy summer we have some important updates to report on and some great news.

Firstly, congratulations to Hagley Scouts for securing  $\pounds 10,000$  towards a new mini bus and we are also pleased to report that that HPC has been awarded almost  $\pounds 6,000$  towards The Pavilion (rebuild of the changing rooms in the playing fields). Both of these sums have been granted from the Bromsgrove District Council's New Homes Bonus scheme.

Please note that work on the demolition and rebuild of the changing rooms is planned to start early October. This will mean the area around the changing room being fenced off and access to and from Church Street will be closed for the duration of the project. The plan is to complete the rebuild by January/February 2017. The closure is necessary to ensure the safety of both pedestrians, park users and contractors. Every effort will taken to minimise the impact of the closure, but we can reassure you that the park will remain open and all other amenities unaffected by these works.

The preparation for the build aspect of this project is now coming together in what promises to be a fantastic amenity asset for Hagley. We would like to thank fellow working group members for all their hard work and many hours of voluntary work over the summer.

Many residents may have been contacted directly by Severn Trent Water or at least seen markings at various junctions in Hagley. We can confirm that these are part of the investigatory work on a sewer flood alleviation scheme to be carried out by STW next year. Detailed proposals are expected later this autumn where a full detailed public consultation will be held leading up to the works.

There continues to be disappointing news on the Highways issues in Hagley, especially around the Hagley traffic Island and with the junction of Kidderminster Rd and Worcester Rd. As many will know Hagley Parish Council has been leading the 'Safer Roads for Hagley' campaign. This campaign was supported by residents including attending a public meeting with Highways officers. Unfortunately, a number of actions discussed at this meeting have not materialised. HPC has been in regular contact with WCC in an effort to resolve these issues as a matter of urgency. We can reassure residents that this pressure will continue to be applied wherever possible. Further actions will be reported by the Parish Council in due course.

Finally we are pleased to report that the 'Christmas in Hagley' event is planned to be resurrected this year. The proposed date of the launch is 24th November. More details will be circulated the festive season approaches.

## Great Houses of Hagley - HAGLEY LODGE

This house stood on the corner of Hall Lane opposite the drinking fountain and the gates to Hagley Hall, the drive entrance being on the corner.

It had been the home of Henry Rogers, a Stourbridge solicitor, who died there in 1878. Hagley Lodge is not identified on more recent censuses until that of 1911 when Lilian E.E. Jobson, an umarried lady of private means lived there.

It was demolished in c1970 to make way for a housing development.



St. John's Hand & Tower Bellringers Ringers have access to 1000s of towers worldwide. Pam one of our ringers on holiday recently in Pembrokeshire, joined local ringers at St. David's cathedral and had wonderful experience.

We all know the diversity of our ancient churches. Behind locked doors to the ringing chambers is an immense wealth, of the heritage that England's 40,000 ringers use. We are so fortunate to have access to these medieval buildings, where since the late 1600s the craft of ringing has rung out across our land. The variety of the towers, just in our area is enormous. At Clent the shiny very narrow spiral staircase almost has to be climbed sideways, but opens out into a big ringing chamber. At Belbroughton forget the staircase -there isn't one. The bells are rung from the ground floor. At Kinver you climb a few steps into a grand room overlooking the knave. Cookley's room is similar but to a much smaller scale.

A sobering thought is that all these towers sway a little when the bells are rung, as you have tons of metal moving about, quite frightening when you first notice it. The physicists however, will tell you the stone brickwork has to be a little flexible to accommodate the forces coming from the rotating bells.



# **Hagley Historical and Field Society**



In recent times it has become popular to research family history. The Internet has made it much easier to access the census returns taken every 10 years and which are one of the vital genealogical resources now available online. Probably the most popular website is Ancestry. com (there are others) but there is normally a charge made for using it on your home computer. Luckily, you can use it for free at Hagley Library by arrangement and also get some friendly

advice on how to start.

The first census taken in 1801 will be of little use as it only contains simple headcounts for each locality. It was primarily conducted in response to the threat of Napoleonic invasion to ascertain how many potential men would be available for conscription. In the Hagley Parish archives we still have the original summons requesting the Constable of Hagley to present himself in Stourbridge to record the Hagley count. From 1841 and onwards the names of everyone in each household was recorded. Now is the time to quiz your family elders for their full names, dates of birth and places of birth before starting your research and perhaps record their anecdotes of childhood.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 4th October. There will be a presentation by Mary Bodfish entitled 'Made in Smethwick'. Smethwick has a surprisingly rich and varied history and she will describe how a mere Anglo-Saxon hamlet became a Victorian boom-town producing many products which have become household names. Mary is a member and current chairman of Smethwick Local History Society. She has taught local history research and palaeography for the University of Birmingham's School of Continuing Studies.
