

The Parish Council is always very pleased to report some positive news for Hagley; the positive news keeps coming with the confirmation that we have been successful in an application for 30 trees donated by the Woodland Trust.

The trees will include Silver Birch, Rowan and Wild Cherry and dependent upon delivery it is hoped that two of the Wild Cherry trees can be planted by local children at the War Memorial in time for Armistice Day.

Some of the remainder of the trees will be used to form a memorial avenue at the Parish cemetery with others planted around the Parish after discussion and agreement by the Parish Council. This is a fitting way to remember the fallen from Hagley from two World Wars and each one will be dedicated to a named soldier on the war memorial.

VILLAGE INFORMATION

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

At the meeting of full council on the 21st September the members supported a motion to reinstate the Highways Forum and to make a formal representation, through the leader of the council to WCC Highways to highlight the District Council's concern with Highway's performance on strategic planning and major highways projects.

At the same meeting it was highlighted that the new Highways Traffic Model does not include Hagley i.e. A456 and A491. This is seen as a critical weakness in terms of impact assessment particularly from the proposed estimated 1,500 new houses in the Town. The assessment of the proposed housing in Whitford and Perryfields has been presented to ward councillors raising concerns of under representation of traffic impacts not only in the Town but in outer reaches of the district.

A recommendation to submit the Council's Medium Term Financial Plan to Government was defeated based on a number member concerns that there are serious risks that the Council's Efficiency Plan is flawed, there is excessive pressure on council reserves and the long term risk to the Council.

It was agreed to ask the Overview and Scrutiny's Finance and Budget Working Group to work with the Head of Finance to produce a viable and effective plan before the submission deadline. A meeting of the Group was followed by an extraordinary council meeting on the 13th October.

The Bromsgrove District 'Place Team' carried out a litter pick along the A456; this is to be followed by a coordinated 'tidy' of this route in conjunction with Worcestershire County Council.

Proposed enforced changes to health community services and primary care across Bromsgrove has recently been highlighted to members of the district council. This is as a result of cuts to Worcestershire County Council budgets and could have serious implications for NHS child care services in Hagley.



We supported World Osteoporosis Day on 20th October by fundraising with tea and cakes and a visit at one of our classes from Katie Hall Regional Development Manager for the National Osteoporosis Society.

We discussed of a diet rich in bone healthy nutrients – calcium, vitamin D and protein being most important for bone health along with safe exposure to sun shine to top up your vitamin

Fashions have changed over the years in the way in which we deal with our dearly departed. Cremation is now chosen by over 75% of us. Birmingham to make some 'brass' in both senses on the word.

Newman Brothers were brass founders and manufacturers of high quality brass coffin fittings which were distributed all over Britain. The story of the rise and fall of this business was the topic of our speaker this month, Simon Buteux. Simon is the Director of the Birmingham Conservation Trust responsible for turning the old Newman Brothers' works into Birmingham's newest museum. He told us that Newman brass fittings were used on the coffins of many high profile figures including Joseph Chamberlain in 1914, Winston Churchill in 1964 and the Queen Mother in 2002. They also made fine quality funeral clothes in which one would have been 'quite happy to be seen dead in' (Simon's quote). To keep up with trends in later years they made Birmingham City and Aston Villa football strips for ardent fans to be laid out in.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 1st November. There will be a presentation by Sandy Cale entitled 'Elegant Georgian Worcester'. Sandy has been a Worcester Walks Green Badge Guide since 2000. She will give us a pictorial guided walk through Worcester in Georgian times, dressed in period costume.

Garden Tip for November

In-fill pots for winter/spring.

Plant up many different plastic pots to fit inside various stone/ terracotta pots. Mark them clearly on the outside with a white permanent marker to identify which stone pot it fits. Once marked it is easier to exchange the dying display for a new one. Also plant up a range of 3"pots with miniature daffodils, iris, crocus, cyclamen and snowdrops to insert into a larger permanent display. This saves disturbing the whole pot. Using plastic pots saves the soil drying out and from freezing.


