Hagley Parish Council

Hagley Parish Council would like to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

Thank you for coming and supporting the Christmas in Hagley 2016 launch - a fantastic way for our community to get together just before we launch into what is usually a very hectic period. Many thanks to the businesses who supported this event with great enthusiasm, the Free Church, the many community groups, Hagley Parish Council, Cheryl Welsh from Bromsgrove's Centres Manager and of course Santa and Hagley Rotary.

This event is planned to be repeated annually and launches a month of extended hours for some businesses. Please check your local business for further details.

Many users of Station Road and Brake Lane will have noticed that the hedge has been cut back away from the pavement to give more space for pedestrians when crossing the bridge. This work was done by the Parish Council Lengthsman (supported by Worcestershire County Council's Lengthsman scheme) which empowers the Parish Council to carry out some tree management works. 'Ed' is regularly seen carrying out similar works across Hagley.

Final contracts have been completed in respect of the rebuild of the changing rooms on the playing fields. There may be some disruption to access to and from Church Street. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption whilst the works are ongoing but please bear with us whilst this essential work is being carried out. We are sure when the work is complete it will have been worth it.

The Parish Council has carried out some much needed tree management and tree planting in Hagley Cemetery including removal of some large conifers from graves and the planting of young trees dedicated to solders from Hagley who died fighting in wars.

It has recently been confirmed that the Parish Council has received some really positive news from the Safer Roads Partnership that it will be introducing speed enforcement along the A456 (similar to that in operation in Blakedown). This follows a series of meetings between councillors and the Partnership and extensive monitoring of traffic flows. It is hoped that similar monitoring and assessment of traffic on other routes through Hagley can result in the same outcome.

The Parish Office will be closed on Friday 23rd December and will re-open on Wednesday 3rd January.

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

The impact of recently announced cuts to Worcestershire County Council's Health budgets have seen some potential changes to Child Health Care provision in Hagley. This has been highlighted through the Hagley Surgery with the Health and Care Trust.

Because of the importance of these proposed changes the issues were raised at BDC's Overview and Scrutiny Board who have agreed to the request that the matter is raised with the Health Authority.

A recent error in the BDC Direct Debit led to some council tax payment being taken early in October. If anyone has been financially penalised for this error please contact the District Council directly.

The next round of the New Homes Bonus panel will have met on the 16th November and the results will be known shortly.

The District Council's 'Place Team' has conducted an extensive litter pick along the main 'A' roads in Hagley as well as starting the winter path sweeps to remove fallen leaves. Other highways works are being co-ordinated with the County Council.

Please be aware that there will be changes to bin collections during the Christmas and New Year periods. Further information will be published in due course and is available on the District Council website.

Gardening Tips

Jeyes Fluid -pour a big dash of Jeyes into a full watering can. Don't forget to water your plants before storing in the greenhouse. Try to keep the liquid under the leaves. Vine Weevils do NOT like Jeyes. Also good for washing down the interior of the greenhouse.

Winter Greenhouse (instead of bubble wrap)

Line the north and east side of the greenhouse with empty polystyrene seed trays, it not only helps to keep the greenhouse warm but reflects the light onto the plants. Light is of paramount importance in the winter.

CLUB REPORTS

Hagley Historical and Field Society



'Made in Smethwick' is not a phrase that you see very often these days unless you are a connoisseur of iron manhole covers, a few of which can still be seen in some old Black Country streets. However, Smethwick was once the industrial workshop of the world and this fact is still proudly stamped on the town's seal. Its rise and decline was

the topic of our speaker this month, Mary Bodfish.

With the arrival of the canal in 1769, Smethwick became an industrial boomtown as it then had easy access to abundant supplies of the coal, iron ore and limestone from the Black Country necessary for metal founding. At its peak, Smethwick employed 50,000 people. When coal gas lighting was installed in Boulton and Watt's Soho foundry in 1800, the manufacture of steam engines could continue both day and night for the first time.

Glass production was second only to that of metal. Chance Brothers were responsible for the glass in the face of Big Ben and also for the tremendously successful invention of Crown Glass. 1.25 million square feet of which was used in the Crystal Palace built for the Great Exhibition of 1851. You may remember now with nostalgia such famous names as GKN, Ash & Lacy, Tangye, Evereds, the Cape Hill Brewery and Mason's Jafarade, all of which sadly no longer exist.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 6th December. There will be a presentation by Dr Gillian White entitled 'The Hugely Huggable History of the Teddy Bear'. Gillian is a NADFAS speaker and is well known to Society members. She will cover origin of the 'Bear' in the 19th century through Winnie the Pooh to Paddington.

touches were given to the bread before it was put in the oven.


