



Flashing Speed Sign adoption –Bromsgrove Road

Following concerns of speeding vehicles along Bromsgrove Road by the Lyttelton Arms expressed by residents, I have offered to pay for a flashing speed sign this requires adoption by Hagley Parish Council from whom I am awaiting a response (at the time of going to press).

Hagley Dial-A-Ride

A further £5,000 this year is going towards Hagley's Dial-a-Ride Bus Service as the service needs additional funding to keep it going. I was involved in the idea and set up of Hagley Dial-a-Ride Bus Service set up over 2 years ago whilst I was a Hagley Parish Councillor and also supported financially its introduction by contributing £3,500 from my divisional fund. This extra money will ensure the service continues for the next 3 years at least depending on usage. Extra money is needed to subsidise each journey not at full capacity payable by the Parish Council.

Park Road / Oldfields

I have supported double lines yellow in parts of the service road of Park Road and Oldfields from a number of residents who have access issues at certain times of the day. This is now on the county list to take further. There will be a public consultation on this in the future.

I am sure you will know what I mean by the term 'status symbol' and can think of any number of modern examples from the iPhone to the Rolls Royce. However in the 18th Century an unlikely status symbol was the Pineapple, which in 1780 cost about £40. In many well-to-do homes a Pineapple would be prominently displayed and rather than be eaten would sit on

a mantle for months, quietly rotting away. If you weren't rich enough to own one, you could rent one for an evening. However, for families who were looking for a more permanent status symbol, for £70 you could purchase a piano. That would represent about £7,500 today and you had to learn to play it. You now understand the real cost of a Pineapple!

With increasing prosperity, the gentry wished to differentiate themselves from the hoi polloi. The importance of the piano at that time was that it indicated the material status of the family and was at the heart of the rising middle class social culture and aspiration. This included comportment, deportment, music and dancing and it introduces us to the Helm family of Worcester, the topic of our speaker this month, Madeline Goold. Her research into the history and restoration of her own period piano had brought this family to her attention. They were a dynasty of Dancing Masters who set up a Dancing School in College Square opposite Worcester Cathedral. Within a generation, through their encouragement of music, they were a major influence on style and etiquette in the heart of the City.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 7th March 2017 at 7.30pm. There will be a presentation by Derek Clarke RIBA, entitled 'The Back to Back Houses Project in Birmingham'. Derek was Project Architect for their restoration, and has been involved in many other prestigious schemes, including rescuing the Perseus and Andromeda Fountain at Witley Court. 

It's always fun discovering something new, and this Spring Term we've been trying out a piece of music that none of us had played before or knew anything about. It's called Spring Pastorale and was composed by the Birmingham born and bred composer HERBERT LUMBY (1906-1987).

Born in Hall Green, Lumby was not only a composer of many songs written for his wife, contralto Muriel Normansell, and lots of compositions for strings, but he was also a superb violinist, viola player and pianist. He was able to play the Sibelius Violin Concerto when only 17 years of age, and he became Principal Viola in the City of Birmingham Orchestra (the precursor of the world famous CBSO) before leaving in 1944 to concentrate of composition and teaching.

His Spring Pastorale and other works were broadcast by the BBC Midland Orchestra during the 1940s and '50s. There is an annual 'Lumby Prize for Violinists and Violists' at Birmingham Conservatoire in his memory.

The most skilful ringing bands get the bells up and down every time with the 8 bells in order sounding one after another. This is very difficult to perfect, but easy for those outside the tower to note any mistakes. 





Hagley Helpline has celebrated various milestones over the years. Last year was our 25th - to mark the occasion an Anniversary Supper for Helpline volunteers was held. We were delighted to welcome Margaret Oliver who had originally suggested forming a group to provide a service for Hagley resident's way back in 1990.

In our first year nearly 100 individuals approached Helpline. In excess of 500 specific tasks were undertaken by a team of 55 volunteers. Last year in 2016 – 415 requests were made. To date we have 47 volunteers, 32 of whom are drivers.

In the beginning some people questioned the need for such a service in Hagley. Many of our aims and objectives didn't reach maturity either for legal, insurance restrictions or health and safety reasons.

Today, requests are for transport mainly for medical appointments or occasionally for essential shopping. We do our best

to respond positively to each request received and with the knowledge that our clients are very grateful for the service we provide for local residents.

Hopefully we can continue for many more years to come
