VILLAGE INFORMATION

Hagley Parish Council

This month's update is a reminder that this summer there will be some extensive sewer and drainage works, which will mean disruption to the playing fields and access to certain roads in Hagley.

Many will already be aware of these works, those who will be directly affected will be contacted by Severn Trent and there will be a period when planned works will be on public display. We have also been made aware of similar works, which will affect Stourbridge Road.

Just as a reminder any questions should be directed to Severn Trent rather than HPC. Contact details will be made available over the coming weeks.

Access to the playing fields will either be limited or closed via Church St and Victoria Passage. We will try and keep disruption to a minimum whilst works are on-going but we are conscious of the absolute need to ensure both the public and contractors remain safe during this period.

Parts of the playing field, the play equipment, community centre and doctor's surgery will remain open to public during these periods.

For information the cemetery gates are to remain closed and locked to vehicles. Pedestrian access will remain via the pedestrian gates. Should vehicular access be required please contact the Clerk who will provide the access code.

As previously reported HPC has commissioned an independent Highways consultant to develop an independent scheme for the Worcester Rd/Kidderminster Road junction. These will be presented to WCC Highways as a set of alternative options.

Following the Manchester attack on 22 May 2017, a Trust has been established by Rotary District 1285, which includes the city of Manchester and surrounding areas. The Manchester Arena Families Trust aims to provide practical help to the victims and families of those killed or injured by the attack. This may include supplying transport to families needing to visit victims in hospital and similar practical support and extends to people indirectly affected, be it physically mentally. The May meeting was our annual social night and 66 members and guests enjoyed a variety of wines, cheeses, patés and salads. This was followed by an illustrated presentation by member Eric Greenwood, entitled 'A Voyage Around My Grandfather – A Chauffeur's Tale'. Eric's Grandfather was chauffeur to a Northern

industrialist in the early part of the 20th century when ownership of cars was still the privilege of the few. He still has an original paper licence belonging to his grandfather, which at the time of issue had to be renewed each year upon payment of five shillings. No driving test was required but the maximum speed was restricted to 20 mph. This was really motoring as prior to the 'Locomotives on Highways Act, 1896' the speed limit was 4 mph in rural areas and 2 mph in towns. Still quicker to walk.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 4th July 2017 at 8.00pm. Gay Hill will give a presentation entitled "100 Years of Electoral Reform in the West Midlands". It is just over 100 years since the visit of influential suffragette Emmeline Pankhurst to Kidderminster to speak at the Corn Exchange in the town hall. She was campaigning for the vote to be given not only to the middle class but also extended to the working class. As you read this we will have just had a General Election and whatever the outcome it is a salutary thought that prior to electoral reform most of us would have taken no part in it. 

Temple of Water

"Breathe slowly through your nose, and then out through your mouth", the gentle whistle from the chimes echo into each corner of the temple. My eyes are tightly shut, and I am sat on the cushion with my legs folded, just like I'm back in middle school. There's a warmth to this room, the six of us are huddled in a circle, and then the mantra begins. Our guide commences the chanting, he sounds out the various vowels and I hesitantly join in, listening to the vibrations bouncing off the walls. "Louder" he shouts, our chanting becomes a choir and our voices seem to harmonise with each other.

This is my last day at Damanhur, I've been here four days living, and learning about the community. Located in the mountains of Turin, Italy, this spiritual community has adopted an eco way of life. The Damanhur began as a covert society, their leader, Falco built secret underground temples within these mountains in 1975, and was later revealed by a whistle-blower in 1992.

The singing has stopped, and my eyes start to peel open. This hall is called the 'Hall of Water'; its white washed walls are coated in various coloured paints of symbols and words. I skim over some of the writings, Sanskrit words are the only familiar pattern that I can see. These walls are lined with sixteen ancient languages, some of which are still undeciphered but are all spiritually and aesthetically intertwined. This temple is devoted to the feminine principle and adopts the shape of a chalice, which is a symbol of receptivity. I look up to the stained glass dome ceiling hovering above my head. The glass cupola is glazed in shades of cerulean, sapphire and sea blue mimicking that of the ocean. The four gold leaf dragons emerge from each corner of the room, a symbol of the pathway of energy known as the synchronic lines that unite faraway worlds in the galaxy.

I look to the floor and notice a mosaic of dolphins nestled inside a six-pointed star. The sphere on the back altar sits quietly as the man asks us to examine the scripture on the walls. We stop at each point of the room examining the languages that Falco had produced, meditating to each wall and each symbol. It's rumoured that the leader Falco was in a state of trance when writing these words and each symbol has a meaning and has a purpose to one's spiritual journey. Although a few of the cryptograms have been revealed, some of the languages are yet to be understood.

The windchimes echo in my ear once again, I close my eyes envisioning the symbols on these walls. I'm trying to understand this community and this spiritual journey that The Damanhur have adopted. Our teacher asks us to open our eyes and to choose a symbol to draw in our notebooks. The idea is to take this scripture away and to use it as a meditation but to not show anyone. I have been taken with a symbol that is similar to the hieroglyphics of Ancient Egypt. The symbols are within a scarab beetle painted in fine gold lines, the words MUN are at the bottom half of the beetle and drawings of a bird and other characters lie within.

This particular hall is said to be ideal for meditations on the life cycles, preparation for childbirth, to come into

contact with one's feminine essence and to reawaken profound memories. Although I long to be enlightened within these four walls, I'm yet to experience a profound reawakening. I thank my teacher and walk the underground passages back to the surface. We leave these hidden temples through a simple door in a house, nobody would have ever known. Concealed from the realities of the modern world, an exposed secret is still relatively hidden.



the plain bob doubles method. Still a long way for us to go but we are on the road, with our ringer Pam joining in on the treble for a touch of bob doubles. Thank you Halesowen.

Then on the evening of the choral evensong Saskia, one of the Worcester choristers, joined the band for our service ring. That's the thing; once you can ring you can drop into any church with the local ringers, as I did on Ascension Day. Hagley String Orchestra


The H.S.O. was established by the late much loved Joan Best in the late 1980s. She was a superb musician having played violin with the CBSO during WW2, and subsequently devoting her life to teaching music, being Head of Music at Stourbridge Girls High School and then joint Head of Music at Stourbridge 6th Form College. She died in 2013, and I took over directing the H.S.O. in September of that year.

In all these years, the seating arrangement of the orchestra stayed the same with 1st violins on the left of the semi-circle, with the 2nd violins to their left, then the violas with cellos and DB on the right.

Last May, I decided to swop the violins around putting the 2nds on the far left. A bit disconcerting at first, but then players said that they were hearing the music in a different way. After discussion, we all agreed to change again for our last 6 rehearsals in June and July with the 2nd violins on the right of the semi-circle, and cellos and DB between 1sts and violas.

This has been a fascinating experiment and a valuable new experience for all of us. I'll let you know about our plans for next Autumn Term in August. Do contact Haydn Thomas (01562) 885252; sanhay50@gmail.com for any information.

We continue with a variety of dances, from the Community Dance Book or the Playford and Apted traditions or from collections of dances written more recently.


