

### **Hagley Parish Council**

As mentioned previously Severn Trent Water will be carrying out extensive sewer and drainage works, which will include sewer pipes being laid in the playing field. This along with the work on the football changing rooms will mean that there will be disruptions, including access and parts of the playing fields being fenced off. We aim to keep the play areas accessible and as much of the playing field as possible during the works.

No access will be allowed beyond fenced off areas. This is for public safety and must be observed. I apologise now for any disruption these works may bring, however, this is a short-term disruption for long term gain.

I can report how disappointed HPC is at the recent increase in litter and disruption in the playing fields. I support the many residents who have reported these incidents and I would whole-heartedly agree that such repeated incidents give Hagley a poor name and gives the impression that no one cares. This is far from the truth and we will continue to seek ways of keeping the fields an attractive and pleasant place to visit. I have personally spoken to the schools and the Clerks who have written to the hot food take-a-ways asking for their support.

Finally please note two quick updates; mobile speed cameras are now in operation along the A456 and we will be carrying out further street lighting upgrades over the coming months.

### Haybridge High School and Sixth Form - Our new Community Ambassadors

We are delighted to have recruited sixteen Community Ambassadors for the 2017/18 Academic year. The core aim of the Community Ambassador Programme, which runs across the schools in The ContinU Trust partnership of Wyre Forest &

Hagley, is to utilise the skills and enthusiasm of young people to promote key safety, citizenship and wellbeing messages to their peers through a calendar of assemblies, literature, presentations and/or displays, social media.

The role includes engaging in approximately 6 activities over the year covering, for example, raising awareness around Personal Safety, Internet Safety, Anti Bullying, Domestic Abuse / Healthy Relationships, Drugs & Alcohol awareness and charity events with a local focus.

The Ambassadors will also conduct surveys and fact-finding work amongst peers in school, providing evidence-led approaches to tackling issues and promoting well-being.

Each year the new recruits are formally invested as Community Ambassadors by West Mercia's Police & Crime Commissioner at the Young Citizenship Celebration event at Kidderminster Town Hall in July, before an audience of parents, councillors, mayors and senior offices in the uniformed services.

'Helping and informing people about how to be safe', 'Coming up with new ideas to get people interested and make them aware of local issues.' and 'helping the community'.





# The Mexican Grackle

The sun rises over the other side of the complex. The cleaners trudging down the corridor and gossiping about the guests is our 7 am wakeup call. I wake up to the coldness of the air conditioning – a westerners dream. The windows are unmasked as I step out onto the balcony into the sauna-like heat. The pool boy begins his daily ritual of cleaning up after the thousands of tourists that descend to Mexico each year. Following my indulgence with the free bathroom cosmetics, I skip down the maze-like corridors to arrive at breakfast. An oversized man's dream of unlimited dining cuisine. I sparkle my gold band to the waiter and I'm hurried to the outside table, beneath the propeller-like fans that mask the architectural beauty. I pass the rows of countless delicacies, of spicy quesadillas, full English breakfasts and a colourful array of fruit. The smell of fresh bread baking with a mix of sun-creamed visitors fills my nostrils. I settle for granola and yoghurt, as I drew tired of being fattened up like a goose at Christmas. I sip my champagne and the bubbles tingle against my chapped lips, the popping of a cork and the squawk of birds capture my attention. Like a ghetto gang, these birds huddle together discussing tactics.

I am suspicious of these urbanised Mexican Grackle birds, as they taunt the waiters with their skilled pocketing techniques. As the waiter's backs are turned the bravest grackle subtly swoops in and fishes out an unidentified object from the bin. He catches the waiter's attention who claps in an attempt to scare off these jester-like scavengers. They regroup again, each standing on the backrest of a chair. They jump forward to the next chair; each one is edging closer and closer to an abandoned table aligned with leftovers. The almost blackness of their tails are similar to the Mexican night sky, tainted by light pollution leaving an eerie purple- blue tinge. I'm concerned about leaving my food unattended, so I watch as one pinches a packet of butter and fly's off showing off to his male rivals. The waiter claps again, and the birds fly away making various noises under their breath. With a large repertoire of vocalisations, these birds otherwise known as 'Zanate' are perceived as pests to the Mexican community. Mexican legend believes that these birds were first created with no voice; using their smart and cunning personality they stole their distinct songs from the wise and knowing sea turtle. The birds had taken the seven passions of life; Love, Hate, Anger, Sadness, Courage, Fear and Joy. Each of his songs represents a different passion. I finish up the taste of wild berries and crunchy granola and head to the pool for a routine swim. I pass a vigilant vocal Grackle as I walk across the burnt orange tiles, I'm now somewhat curious as to which passion he's squawking about.



### **Hagley Historical and Field Society**



The Battle of Worcester in 1651 was the final battle of the English Civil War. Charles II with his mainly Scottish army were soundly defeated. After the battle, the king was a wanted man with a reward of £1000 offered for his capture. There are many stories surrounding his escape, not least of which was hiding in an oak

tree at Boscobel House to escape a Parliamentary patrol. It is thought that on his way North he stopped at what is now the 'King's Arms' at Ombersley for refreshment and then onwards to Stourbridge.

As our speaker this month, Max Keen, asked us. How do you get to Stourbridge from Ombersley other than through Hagley? So here we have a very local connection with Charles II even if no 'Blue Plaque' marks the occasion. It was a brave decision to pass through Stourbridge as is had a Parliamentary garrison. We were told that he openly walked down the High Street speaking French. As unlikely as it sounds the ruse worked as by the 17th century there were many French speaking glassmakers in Stourbridge.

After many escapades he escaped from the South coast to France. How was it that he was not caught? Some think that after the disquiet of the execution of his father there was no appetite to repeat it and so he was pursued just sufficiently hard enough to keep him moving and ensure that he ended up where he could do no further harm.

We have no meeting in August so our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 5th September 2017 at 8.00pm. Dr. Kate Round will give a presentation entitled "Stourbridge Glassmakers - on the Move". Visitors are most welcome at all our events – see hhfs.org.uk for details and contacts.

Two simple things we should do is ensure that when we are away take measures to prevent this being obvious such as light timers and to mark all our valuables with such things as Ultra Violet pens, or Smartwater. Before going away; tell your neighbours and friends, cancel the milk, ask someone to pick up the post, ask a neighbour to put your bins back for you once emptied. If you have an alarm set it and if you go away or don't have a car invite a neighbour to park on your drive so that it looks like people are coming and going.



#### The Pony Express and why Cowboys came to the Black Country

You may not be aware, but at Hagley Rotary Club we have guest speakers who visit our meetings to talk to us about subjects that are very close to their heart. This could be a charity they support or represent or in this case, a personal interest. In June, our guest speaker was fellow Rotarian from the Kinver Club and Stourbridge Travel owner Neil Brazier, who gave a very interesting talk on the Pony Express.

The Pony Express, which in 1860 began using horse and rider relay teams to shuttle mail along a 2,000-mile route between St. Joseph, Missouri, and Sacramento, California.

We learned that although the company only operated for 19 months, it set a new standard for high-speed mail delivery which later became a recurring motif in comics, Western films and frontier lore. The cost to send post this way was determined by its weight and for everyday folk could be expensive, so items sent were usually Newspaper reports, government dispatches and business documents, most of which were printed on tissue-thin paper to keep costs down.

Back then, mail sent to California could take 25 days by stage coach or months if sent by sea. So the Pony Express average delivery time of just 10 days was very attractive. Made possible by the setting up of a string of nearly 200 relief stations across what is now Missouri, Kansas, Nebraska, Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, Nevada and California; Ione horsemen would ride between stations at a breakneck pace, switching horses every 10-15 miles, then handing their cargo to a new courier after 75-100 miles.

Speed was the priority; the Pony Express went to great lengths to keep its horses' loads as light as possible. Specially designed saddles were used and most of the riders were small, wiry men who weighed between 100 and 125 pounds. Their average age was around 20, but it wasn't unusual for teenagers as young as 14 to be hired. Riders were well paid and received between \$100-\$150 monthly salaries. They also swore a company loyalty oath before they were employed.

Neil went on to tell us about William "Buffalo Bill" Cody who claimed that he served as a Pony Express rider at the age of 14. Cody kept the Pony Express' memory alive with his famous "Wild West" vaudeville shows whose performers included sharpshooters Annie Oakley and her husband, Frank Butler. Performers re-enacted the riding of the Pony Express, Indian attacks on wagon trains, Custer's Last Stand and stagecoach robberies In fact on 28th April 1904, Buffalo Bill's Wild West and Congress of Rough Riders of the World staged a spectacular show at Eggington Farm Wollaston, situated between where Meriden Avenue and Bridle Road now stand. It must have been some sight to see real Cowboys and Indians riding down the High Street!


