

## **Hagley Parish Council**

Hagley Parish Council November 2017 update

The Neighbourhood Plan Working Group has begun the tendering process to commission principal consultancy support for the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan.

A delegation representing HPC and three members of the public went to meet WCC Highways to discuss our proposed alterations to the A456/B4187 junction. The proposal, designed by the commissioned Technical Specialist ARUP, is focused on reverting the carriageways to its original layout (i.e. reintroducing the longer slip road on the approaches to the B4187 and removing the dual carriageway between the traffic lights) with the added benefit of improving access to Summervale Rd area and improving safety. -ARUP will now consult with WCC on our behalf and a response is awaited with interest.

As part of the plans for the Christmas 2017 event HPC is looking to buy and install Christmas lights on the tree on the corner of St Saviours and Park Road. This always was a popular decoration and was a focal point for the Christmas season. HPC is seeking sponsors of the main Christmas tree and lights as well as any small stall holders interested joining in on the event. Contact the clerk with expressions of interest in the event planned for Friday 24th November, 5pm to 8pm. Please note the road closure will between Worcester Road (A456) and Lloyds bank.

HPC has objected to the proposed Wildmoor Quarry application at Fairfield as it is concerned that the movement of HGVs will have an adverse effect on the air quality and add to the congestion through the village.

## Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

At the time of writing we are preparing for the public meeting to be held with the Police and Crime Commissioner and senior Police officers from the Policing team. Details from the public meeting will be published for the December edition of the News.

The CCTV in Hagley Village will be included in the on-going review of CCTV surveillance across Bromsgrove. The review is being carried out after being requested through Task and Finish Group by Bromsgrove District Council's Overview and Scrutiny Board. The Task Group, Chaired by Cllr Steve Colella, will also be interviewing the Police and Crime Commissioner, Senior Police Officers as well as the Portfolio Holder.

Winter is upon us now and it is worth reminding readers that there are simple measures that can be taken to ensure you and your property are protected. For example wearing reflective clothing for the whole family when going out in the dark winter hours. Don't forget your pets too; there are reflective collars for your cat and reflective 'coats' for your dog.

Also, if you're going out or coming home after dark leave a light on in a room or two. There are selections of automatic timers that are available and can be easily attached to lamps. Anything that makes an unwanted visitor think twice before calling must be welcomed. If you are away or you don't drive invite a neighbour to park on your drive, again, making it look as though the property is occupied.

- The handbells used in this performance are the same bells we use to this very day.



#### BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

- Because of how Christmas falls this year there are no changes to the bin collection cycles during the Christmas and New Year period.
- BDC is again supporting the 2017 Christmas event in Hagley (24th November) by paying for the
  road closure. The District Council's 'Centres manager' has also been working closely with the Parish
  Council, businesses and other stakeholders to help ensure that the evening is highly enjoyable and
  safe for all.
- BDC has responded to the Wyre Forest Development Plan Consultation with particular emphasis
  on raising concerns with the likely impact of development in the Kidderminster area upon Hagley, in
  particular transient routes along the A456 and A491. The response was unanimously supported by
  Councillors.
- A response was made in respect of the Worcestershire Rail Investment Strategy currently under consultation. Increasing the capacity on the rail infrastructure is essential to give an alternative to road usage and to reduce the reliance upon car journeys. This is particularly important here in Hagley as traffic between Kidderminster, Worcestershire and Birmingham and the Black Country extensively use the main Hagley highways that link these large conurbations.

# Nile High Bungee

I can feel the sharp wooden splints scraping my feet. "Hakuna Matata", the man in front of me shouts in Swahili.

I'm second on the long platform, similar to the plank from cartoon pirate movies. I can feel a queasy sensation in my belly, which began whilst walking up the stairs of the swinging platform. The platform hangs 44m above the source of the River Nile.

Moments later, the first person has jumped and I am next in line. I can see my fellow volunteers waving from the viewing platform in the distance. A man with the camera looks almost like a miniature figure as he prepares his next take. I cautiously sit on the wooden carved chair as they strap the bungee cords around my feet. The one man looks at my hands, my weight scribbled in red ink on the palm. This is perhaps the only time I won't lie about my weight, I ask for the man who weighed me to scribble the intimate numbers on my palm instead of the back of my hand. I nervously feel for the rings that have been dismissed from my middle finger. They're left in the safety of the front desk, in case I lose anything on my descent down.

The Ugandan men put what looks like towels around the bottom of my legs, they tie the bungee cord around them tight. I nervously smile to them, as they make sure they are fitted correctly. I can feel sweat beads dripping from my forehead and a nervous persona has inhabited my body.



"Ready", the Ugandan man asks me with a confident smirk.

I know that if I turn around now and walk down the stairs that I will lose my money. I nod half-heartedly and waddle to the edge of the platform. A brown sun-kissed arm holds mine with every awkward jump to the edge.

"Put your arms out, like a bird", says the instructor.

I hold my arms out straight, uncontrollable nerves have taken over.

"Smile and wave to the camera, look at the view", he sarcastically continues to say.

I plaster a fake smile on my face and wave to the camera in the distance. It feels unnatural to stand over the edge and jump off into the air. It reminds me of when I was a child and my friend would try to make me fall backwards on the trampoline. I could never do it, something in my brain would just shout no. I'm having the same unnatural feeling as I did then, my friend taunting me to fall backward.

"Three, two, one, bungee", they scream.

My feet don't move, I feel almost stuck to the floor as though I'm in sinking sand.

"I can't do it", I shakily say to them.

"Three, two, one, bungee".

I stop again, unable to bring myself to jump off the edge. They utter those three words one last time.

"Three, two, one, bungee".

They push me off the 44-meter platform and I fall into what feels like nothingness.

I open my eyes as I descend from the platform, I scream but my voice is absorbed by the adrenaline. A weightless feeling for a few moments as my body becomes half consumed by the River Nile. For a moment I'm plunged into the source of the river, my hair dripping wet with the cord pulling me back up towards the sky. An indescribable feeling of flight and an adrenaline boost depletes my body. Bewildering moments as I slingshot up and down until the motion is almost over.

I smile to the men in the boat waiting for me a little down the river. They start to paddle towards me as I swing upside down. I feel breathless and excited as I dangle like an object on a piece of string. The motion of the bounce has caused the bungee to start to twizzle. For a few more moments I spin in the air, as the men shout,

"Reach for the oar", they bellow.

With an almost intoxicated feeling I try my best to grab their oar. Eventually, I do and they pull me into the rubber dingy. I sit for a second feeling unbalanced like a child on a bouncy castle. I hear cheering from the platform above. I look towards them and put my thumb up, indicating that I'm fine.

As the men paddle to the shoreline and I depart the unsteady boat, I look back to the top of the platform. High above my head I can see the next visitor leaning over the edge, I wait there for a few minutes and hear those dreaded three words again. "Three, two, one, bungee", the next person starts to fly.



## **Hagley String Orchestra**

I wonder if any readers can throw some light on a problem I've been unable to solve. It concerns a piece we're playing this term by the English composer Gordon Jacob (1895-1984) entitled Denbigh Suite for String Orchestra.

London born, Gordon Jacob enlisted when he was 19 in the Field Artillery, fighting in WW1 in the trenches. In 1917, he was taken prisoner, and he kept the POW's spirits up by forming an orchestra using any thing that could make a sound and arranging music for it. It was during this time that he heard that his brother had been killed on the Somme. He himself was one of 60 from his battalion of 800 to survive.

He composed his Denbigh Suite when he was 34 in 1929 dedicating it 'For Howell's School, Denbigh'. Howell's school in Wales (Ysgol Howell Dinbych) was an independent girl's school that was commemorating its 70th Anniversary in 1929. Now the questions: -

Did the school commission Jacob to compose this piece? If so, why did the school choose Jacob? What was the connection? Could his mother have been a former pupil?

It's a fun 4-movement piece to play. If it was performed by the Howell's girls, they must have been jolly good!



## Pilot Patient Transport initiative for patients of Wyre Forest CCG surgeries.

A significant concern for many patients is accessing transport to attend their medical appointment. A recent survey established that around 20% of missed appointments are due to the lack of available transport which in turn has a detrimental impact on precious NHS resources.

During September, a new initiative to address this issue was established for patients registered to Medical Practices within the Wyre Forest CCG of which Hagley Surgery is a member. The three volunteer supported community transports schemes that operate within the district are working together to provide transport where no other means exists. Namely Wyre Forest Dial-a-Ride, Community Transport Wyre Forest and Tenbury Transport Trust.

This Pilot scheme will complement the existing Hagley Helpline scheme and provide additional resource as it offer's wheelchair adaptable vehicles as well as cars and minibus's. ### **Hagley Historical and Field Society**




The history of glass making in Stourbridge stretches back some 375 years. Not only was it the lifeblood of the community, but it was also a substantial contributor to Britain's manufacturing strength and national wealth. It appears that glassmakers were a migratory people, continually moving to where they could find suitable resources such as coal and fireclay which existed here in abundance.

Kate Round's topic entitled 'Stourbridge Glassmakers on the Move' might lead you to believe that she was referring to this migration. However, it appears that the word 'move' in this context refers to a continuous shift pattern of six hour on and six hours off where the change of shift was called the 'move'.

At the end of the 17th century, the distinctive cone shaped glasshouse appeared that came dominate the landscape and still does today. The industry grew and evolved for the next 275 years and glass from Wordsley, Amblecote and Brierley Hill is recognised as amongst the finest in the world. Unfortunately the final decades of the 20th century saw the loss of the four major companies. In 1990 Thomas Webb and Sons closed and in 1995 Webb Corbett was closed by Royal Doulton. Royal Brierley Crystal went bankrupt and closed in 2000.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 7th November 2017 at 8.00pm with a presentation by Fiona Joseph entitled "Beatrice, The Cadbury Heiress Who Gave Away Her Fortune". For her, being a 'have' in a world of 'have-nots' was troubling, and in 1920 she decided to 'give back' all the Cadbury shares she had inherited to the Bournville factory workers ... with unexpected consequences. 
