VILLAGE INFORMATION

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

Many will know that until recently there has been a footbridge over a small water course at the back of Newfields Rd. This was removed on safety reasons by the Worcestershire Countryside Services. The Countryside Service has now confirmed that this has already been replaced.

As part of BDC's review of CCTV surveillance across the district the Task Group is beginning to develop its recommendations around the existing fixed position cameras, the use of 'deployable' cameras and the use of surveillance cameras to tackle fly tipping etc. A visit to the control centre is currently being planned.

A further task group is being set up into the investigation into parking outside schools. This will start in the New Year and expected to be completed late spring.

Over the next couple of months Officers will be presenting proposals for members to consider in preparation for the 2018/19 council tax budgets which will of course include proposals for tax rises and fees and charges made for the discretionary services which provides.

Hagley Parish Council

On behalf of everyone at Hagley Parish Council I would like to wish you a merry Christmas and a happy New Year.

The Flood Alleviation works are close to completion with the final road closure scheduled to finish before Christmas. The hard standing materials will be removed from the playing fields and then re-levelled before being re-seeded. These areas will remain fenced off while the new grass takes hold. Once the surface has recovered sufficiently the fields will be returned to full public access. This will be the final commitment by Severn Trent to leave the site as it was found.

Hagley Parish is starting to develop its next Neighbourhood Plan. The plan will set out a shared vision for Hagley and it will play a key role in shaping the development and growth of Hagley. We would like help from residents who are willing to give their time to look at environmental, sustainable, and transport issues within Hagley. Anyone with data analysis or Geographical Information System (GIS) skills will be particularly welcome.

The Neighbourhood Planning team has joined forces with Churchill and Blakedown Parish Council to raise our concerns over the planned housing growth in the Kidderminster area, in particular the impact of traffic. We have met with Wyre Forest DC and Worcestershire Highways and will be included in on-going consultation into the traffic impact assessment.

Please note that the Parish Office will be closed for the Christmas and New Year period.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

Thank you to the 80 people who were able to come to the meeting with the Police and Crime Commissioner in October.

The meeting was informed of Anti-Social Behaviour by a group of youths around Sweetpool Nature Reserve. Residents were able to give the Policing team a great deal of information and details of these activities and as a result the Police have carried out a range of covert and overt operations. From the information discussed it was clear that there are individuals not from Hagley but are coming in and meeting up with local children.

It was alarming to hear what influence that this group is having on local children and we would like parents to ask themselves if they know where their children are and to ensure that they are not being led astray by this group.

It was agreed that the Watch team would arrange similar quarterly meetings. A few useful tips were raised such as the 'Whatapp' group set up by the residents of Wychbury Fields. This enables quick responses to messages between close groups of neighbours. This is a useful form of communications but please do not forget any non-users that also are your neighbours.

We are planning to have a Saturday drop in session, which will include producers of home security services and devices. As soon as we have a wide range of suppliers we will advertise the event in more detail.

From all at Haybridge High School & Sixth Form, we hope you have a very peaceful and enjoyable Christmas.





A taste of Damanhur

The taste of Gorgonzola cheese melts my taste buds, a crunch of a walnut and the juiciness of the apple. Never have I experienced such taste on an Italian classic. The crust of the pizza is subtle and I'm unhesitant as I go to grab another slice of heaven. We've been invited into a Nucleo of one of the members of the Damanhur. A Nucleo family is a house shared by a group of people who are not all related living together in a household. They share a communal space, they often cook, shop and eat together and have their own private spaces. Nucleo families tend to have between 15 and 25 people and they comprise of singles, the elderly, youth and couples with and without children. Each citizen chooses whom they would like to live with in accordance with their preferences and goals. The purpose of this is to exchange experiences among different age groups, as well as offering children with economic and well being care, despite not being related.

Once a week our host welcomes visitors and fellow Damanhurians into his kitchen, for a small donation he cooks pizza and serves wine. His kitchen is his studio as he creates culinary masterpieces that are rich in flavour and have experimental combinations. He chooses three pizzas for us and the last one is the Gorgonzola, apple and walnut pizza.

I clink my glass of red wine with the couple's glasses opposite me. The Brighton couple have travelled to Turin like me to attend the three-day Damanhur retreat. The atmosphere in the dining room is not as crowded as I thought and it feels like a home rather than a canteen. There are several long benches and tables in the room, it reminds me of the common room at sixth form. There are small clusters of people enjoying the homemade pizzas on the other benches, none of which I recognise from my earlier tours.

I arrived from a Q&A session organised by the Damanhurians a few hours before. I had the opportunity to ask one of the first members of Damanhur questions about the spiritual group. His name means sunflower, which seems to match his personality perfectly with his smile beaming towards mine. Whilst living within the Damanhur community I have learnt that the Damanhurians adopt animal and plant names, I ask the man why this is the case. His translator sits next to him and replies to me an audited voice.

"Changing our names is as though we are being reborn. It is a spiritual connection a name to begin our spiritual journey".

I wonder to myself what my animal or plant name would be. His grey hair looks similar to cotton wool and with each question he delves into the Damanhur life, their founder and the belief system. The Damanhur is a spiritual and eco community that believe in sustainability. They are also responsible for creating underground temples, which are rumoured to be the 8th wonder of the world. They have their own currency, schools and university, as well as producing their own organic produce. Their leader Falco, who created the community and the underground temples in secret, originally founded the group.

Damanhur is now home to roughly 600 residents and 400 more people live nearby, many of those are from different countries. I thank Sunflower for answering our questions and hurry to the Nucleo to indulge in Italians finest cuisine. I can't help but think whether a sustainable life like Damanhur is the new future. But I'm still unconvinced about the belief and purpose of this community.

I am certain that you will be familiar with the Birmingham Repertory Theatre, which now adjoins the new Library. Perhaps you will not be so familiar with its predecessor, which we now refer to as the 'Old Rep', in Station Street, Birmingham.

The Old Rep theatre, opened in 1913, as a permanent home for Barry Jackson's increasingly well established amateur theatre group. 'The Pilgrim Players', as they were then known became The Birmingham Repertory Company. Barry Jackson, a wealthy entrepreneur, funded the construction of the theatre, and established his professional company there.

It was the first purpose-built repertory theatre in the UK and amazingly only took four months to build. It was one of the UK's premier theatre venues and many great stars have walked the boards. There is still an original mirror from the opening of the Old Rep just before you walk on stage. One name you might remember is Arnold Ridley, probably better known to us as Private Godfrey, in 'Dad's Army'. Although an actor throughout his life, he also wrote over 30 plays, of which the 'Ghost Train' in 1923 is probably his best known.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 5th December 2017 at 8.00pm with a presentation by Andrew Crabtree entitled "Christmas Songs and Carols". This is a return visit for Andrew from 2014 when he presented 'The History of the Piano' Visitors are most welcome at all our events – see hhfs.org.uk for details and contacts.







Merry Mulled Wine Recipe

Ingredients:

750ml bottle of red wine

1 slice clementine

1 cinnamon stick

1 star anise

3 dried figs

4 cloves

3 black peppercorns

50ml of brandy



Method:

- 1. Pour the wine into a large saucepan. Add the clementine, cinnamon stick, star anise, dried figs, cloves and black peppercorns. Very gently heat the pan until it's simmering and then turn the heat off.
- 2. Remove the whole spices and peppercorns, and then stir in the brandy. Serve into mugs and add a slice of clementine to serve
