BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

Reporting missed bins - Following a recent frosty period it is useful to remind residents that if your bin has been missed you can report it via The Bromsgrove District Council website via the link 'bins and recycling/missed bins'. Or by calling 01527 881188.

This only applies if the bin has been put out ready for collection by 7:00 am on the day of the scheduled collection and has been missed. Unfortunately if the bins has not been put-out by the required time on the correct collection day it will be collected the next time.

Disabled Grant Facility If you are a home owner you may be able to get help to pay for essential adaptation to your home if you or someone who lives with you has a disability.

After an assessment by health professionals, a disabled facilities grant may be available to help you with the cost of:

- · Widening doors and install ramps
- · Improving access to your rooms and facilities e.g. a downstairs bathroom or stair lift
- Providing heating and lighting systems that are suitable for you and that you can control
- · Improving access around your home to enable you to care for other people there

2017 has been a very busy year.

STW Flood alleviation work is completed and all roads have been re-opened. The playing fields will only be fully open once we are confident that they are back up to the required standard. We have started the rebuild of the changing rooms on the playing fields. After a slower than expected start we should see some good progress.

The lighting replacement programme has continued and will be extended into the New Year. The dial a ride service continues to be a success and is a much valued service, the more that use it the longer it will last. HPC has completed a tidy up of the cemetery and repaired the gate! We are pleased to see how well the Hagley Neighbourhood Watch is going and were pleased to see the public turnout for the meeting with the Police Crime Commissioner.

The year has seen us continuing our challenge to the Highways Authority on congestion, safety and air quality. Whilst at long last we have been able to secure a mobile speed camera along the A456 we know that this would be welcomed elsewhere in Hagley as well. We continue to be alarmed at the volume of traffic and safety issues that affect the local road networks. Despite some very strong challenges to the County authorities, including tabling our own junction proposals we remain concerned that there has been no positive response.

The Christmas event was well received with the several hundred enjoying what will hopefully become an annual event.

The Watch has alerted residents to actively report suspicious activities or crimes that perhaps wouldn't have been previously, meaning that the Policing Team are fully aware of the effect that crime is having in Hagley.

Whilst we can't eradicate crime completely on our own, I know the Police are appreciative of everyone's support. I do feel that we have a good working relationship with the Police and the visit we had from the Police and Crime Commissioner left the authorities in no doubt what so ever as regards the strength of feel in our community.

I'm sure Anti-Social Behaviour and crime across Hagley hasn't gone completely away and we wait with baited breath for the next criminal act, but whilst we have more eyes watching over each other we have made it a little more difficult for uninvited guests. Have a lovely New Year and as someone once said "Keep 'em peeled".

HAGLEY RAMBLER SCOUTS

This August nine Hagley Explorer Scouts (four boys and five girls) undertook their 'Explorer Belt' Expedition to Germany.

SCOUTS

The Explorer Belt is a challenge of a lifetime like no other. It is a chance to take part in a 10-day expedition that brings a real understanding of a different country, its culture and way of life by travelling through that country, working as part of a small team to complete a series of projects and, most importantly, by meeting local people. It is an experience and an achievement that young people will remember for the rest of their lives.

The two teams backpacked across Germany starting in Hannover and made their way to Berlin, passing through such historic cities as Magdeburg and Potsdam on their way. Due to the distances involved they also used public transport but trekked on average 15 to 20 kilometres a day, camping overnight.

The teams had to raise all the funds (nearly £10,000) to meet the costs of such a lengthy and large Expedition, and also had to undertake all the planning, and preparation themselves. Guidance and training was given over a period of over 12 months by the Explorer Leadership Team, in such competences as navigation, team building, expedition cooking, lightweight camping, fitness and first aid. Each team member had to attain these competences before they were allowed to go.

Travelling to Hannover by minibus the teams then took completely different routes to Berlin, supported by the Leaders. Each team had to undertake a major project of their choice which were German Unification and the East West divide, as well as 10

minor projects that included religion, biodiversity, food and the German language to name a few.

The Expedition was a great success, although hard and extremely challenging on occasions. To gain their award the teams gave an evening presentation of their experiences to a panel of County Scout assessors, parents, leaders and friends. They will now be awarded the Explorer Belt, which is without doubt one of the hardest Scouting achievements.

We wish all of our friends in the Community a very happy and healthy 2018.





Beatrice, born in 1887, was the youngest of seven children of William Cadbury, owner of the world famous chocolate empire, who along with the Frys and Rountrees were dominant in the chocolate world from the 1840s.

Beatrice was an exceptional woman who grew up with all the privileges: a fine mansion with servants, a well-rounded education and the chance to travel the world and see all its glories. Despite her annual income of £400,000 from Cadbury shares, her lifelong quest to create a fairer and more equal society was inspirational, if at times, bordering on self-destruction. The issues raised by her life – how the 1% of those who have most material wealth or power treat the 99% of those who have less are timeless, and utterly relevant today.

Her Socialist ideals made her wealth unacceptable and she gifted all her shares to Cadbury workers. Along with her husband, Kees Boeke, she relentlessly pursued their vision of a fairer and more equal society. One of her bold experiments involved sharing their house with waifs and strays who promptly stole much of the contents. She eventually ended up living in a tent but bad weather and poverty caused health problems and it proved a spectacular failure.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 2nd January 2018 at 8.00pm with a presentation by Mick and Carole Freer entitled "Leasowes Walled Garden". The Walled Garden lies at the heart of The Leasowes in Halesowen and was once internationally famous for its design and beauty. It is the mid 18th Century creation of the poet, William Shenstone and a reflection of its importance is its designation as a Grade 1 Listed Garden. "It appears to be eating something", the man with the binoculars declares quietly.


