BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

Finally we're seeing the signs of the end of the winter, we hope. During December in particular we saw some severe weather in the form of snow and ice. This played havoc with normal services including bin collections. However, I would like to thank the staff at BDC, in particular the environmental teams for minimising the impact of the weather on the bin collections. Whilst some collections may have been delayed the teams quickly got back to normal.

As a reminder if your bins are missed you can contact BDC via the website under 'missed bins' or call them on 01527 881188 to arrange a special collect. Just a reminder your bins must be put out in time for the collection usually the day before your collection is due.

The snow did cause a number of issues with school closures and roads and pavements being either impassable or very difficult and dangerous to get through. I have raised this with the Worcestershire County Councillor to determine the County's policy on road and path gritting policy.

A recent meeting has been held between the District Planning Team and the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan team to determine mutual ways of working towards the completion of the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan.

Hagley Parish Council

I thought it would be useful if I took this opportunity to outline what Hagley Parish Council does and is responsible for.

A Parish Council is the most local level of government and has specific areas of responsibility and activity. These include representing the local community, supporting services to meet local needs and striving to improve quality of life in the parish.

HPC sits within the governance of Bromsgrove District Council and Worcestershire County Council and whilst it will make representations to these higher 'parent' authorities, they have ultimate responsibility for local issues such as planning and highways with wider responsible falling to authorities such as Policing, Healthcare and Education being administered through their own authority bodies.

HPC has responsibility for such things as the allotments; the village cemetery, shoppers' car park; community dial a ride; bus shelters; grounds maintenance, litter picking in and around the playing field, cemetery and Sweetpool Nature Reserve; supports the environmental betterment of the village including litter picking along the 'High St', outside the schools and passageways. In addition to these we maintain the street lighting and pay for the power costs; traffic calming measures and where possible support local community groups and initiatives such as the Christmas events and the Library.

As councillors we are unpaid and meet twice a month to make decisions on the work and direction of the council. In addition to formal Council meetings we attend special meetings and working groups, including meetings with the Highway Authority, Police and schools.

At our fortnightly meeting we ask for updates from District Councillors and the County Councillor to which we will ensure that they are held to account and that the greater good of Hagley is represented.

Each year the Parish Council raises a 'precept', which is used to fulfil the parish duties and to improve facilities and services for local people. On average, HPC costs local residents about 15p per day.

An attempted burglary in Romsley was thwarted when intruders, using lock snapping devices, triggered the alarm upon the attempted break-in. There are a number of varying types of intruder and alarm systems on the market and once fitted give a degree of peace of mind.

There was a case of vandalism along Station Rd and Station Drive on the lead up to Christmas. If anyone knows anything that will help the Police with their investigations please call 101.

Hagley Historical and Field Society



Our December meeting was one with a difference. The presentation by our speaker Andrew Crabtree, an accomplished musician, was entitled "Christmas Songs and Carols". Song sheets of Christmas songs and carols were provided and, accompanied by Andrew on his keyboard, were sung with gusto. Some members were provided with sleigh bells,

which they rang heartily. Our Chairman Ray was given two half coconut shells with which he did an extremely good impression of a horse and really enjoyed himself. It was a delight to see!

Andrew took some time trying to divide the audience into 12 to sing the Twelve Days of Christmas. Eventually it was done but some people were still not sure which day they were. When it came to standing up and singing the appropriate words for the day, confusion reigned. Some sang gustily and stood up where appropriate – others did not!

Quite a lot of historical background given about the songs and he explained that originally carols were sung at various seasons, not just Christmas. A carol was originally a dance song and Charles Dickens regarded them also as being a story. Some carols were written in very hot weather and some, which seem modern, date back several centuries

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 6th February 2018 at 8.00pm with a presentation by Heather Flack entitled "Bewdley under the White Rose". She will take us on a journey from 1376 when Bewdley was first recognised as a town to how it became a thriving port with four gateways. Brilliant bats and marvellous moths by Esther Gittoes

I pull up in the middle of nowhere, the headlights on my VW Beetle shine into the woods opposite. There's a chill in the August air as I approach the opening of Kinver Edge. I eagerly glance towards my naked wrist hoping to calculate the earliness of our arrival. I wait by the notice board, it reads, "Have you heard the Chiffchaff yet? They winter in the Mediterranean and are among the first migrant songbirds to arrive in spring. They pick insects from trees and also fly out to snap them up". I listen out for the Chiffchaffs, but I'm not here to see birds, instead I'm on the search for months and bats.

After a few moments I'm greeted by a young red-haired woman who wears a jam red fleeced jumper. Her sparkly smile makes me feel at ease, confirming I had the right date and time. The guide leads us along the dirt path around the cluster of trees. I can see a bright light, almost like a replica of the moon over a small bank. A picnic table is just in front and a group of visitors have huddled around the table.

"So you're the moth expert?" I ask a gentleman holding a collection of contained Moths.

"I wouldn't say expert", he responded, "more of an enthusiast".

I glance into the tubes of the captured moths; their names are scribbled on sticky labels. 'Large yellow underwing' and 'Coxcomb prominent' are written in handwritten ink. The moth catcher confidently waves goodbye as he leads us towards the young girl for our bat walk, he promises to catch more Moths as we leave. I press the switch on my black and white torch and begin the Bat walk around Kinver Edge. Our guide holds a bat detector up in the air as we take each step. I stumble across the raised tree stumps, past the leaning trees and through the squeaking kissing gate. The bat detector rumbles with a sound similar to a smoking shisha pipe or the noise of blowing bubbles in the bath.

The guide waves the detector to the tops of the trees and a black silhouette races past, then another flutter amongst the branches. They are quite small in size I thought to myself; I've never seen a bat in the wild before. Our guide tells us that the Rock houses are home to a rare bat called Lesser Horseshoe a few months of the year; these bats are dwindling in numbers.

We carry on our tour up the steep hill following the noise of the bat detector. When no bats are present the detector exudes the sound of Television static. But a bubble of the device and another shadow appears above. We reach the top of the hill and look to the view over Kinver. The silhouettes of houses and the lights from the windows pose a perfect view, almost like a city of lights.

The rest of our group have started the descent down the hill towards the man and his Moths. We quickly follow them passing the last of the bats flying above us. I've been lent the bat detector as I jog down the hill and I raise my arm above my head. The detector makes a sound, apparently bats use different noises for socialising and eating, I wonder which they are doing now.

The light from the moth trap can be seen for miles. I wander down the slope towards the light mimicking the journey of the Moth to its trap. The enthusiast catches the Moths as we watch from the bandstand, we're told not to look directly into the light. I ignore the health warning and as a result my vision is beclouded with black spots. Maiden's Blush, Brimstone, Small Rivulet's and Early Thorn moths are some of the insects contained in the pots. The children stand in amazement whilst helping to catch the Moths as they fly into the light.

Following the talk and the capturing of Moths, we decide to call it a night. I thank the Moth man and the Bat lady and we wander down the rocky path, back towards the car. My handheld torch is the only light to be seen as we edge further away from the Moth trap. The clock ticks over to 11 pm. Tonight under a starry sky I had the opportunity to experience two different types of flying creatures. I'm thankful for that.

Risotto with chicken, smoky bacon and butternut squash

For the roasted butternut squash: -

• Roast ½ Butternut squash cubes in oil with sea flakes for 25 minutes.

For the Chicken: -

- Marinate two chicken breasts for at least an hour in 2tsp of Italian seasoning, 2 finely diced gloves of garlic and 2tsp of oregano
- Add a drizzle of oil and bake in the for 20 minutes or until cooked through

For the Risotto: -

- In a large pan add oil, 1tsp of thyme, 2 cloves of chopped garlic, 1 finely chopped white onion and 3 rashes of smoked streaky bacon. – Cook till the onions are soft for roughly 10 minutes.
- · Add 200g of risotto rice, stir to coat in the oil.
- · Add a splash of white wine. let it absorb,
- Prepare 1 ½ to 2 pints of chicken stock and add the stock to the rice a bit at the time. Only add
 more once the rice has absorbed the last drop. This can take up to 45 minutes. The risotto
 should look thick and all the liquid absorbed.
- Add 50g of Parmesan and season to taste, add the roasted butternut squash to the risotto.
- Crisp up 2 slices of streaky bacon.
- · Top the risotto with the sliced chicken, streaky bacon and rocket
- · Serve with some crusty bed with a chilled glass of wine

White chocolate and raspberry cheesecake

- Melt 600g of white chocolate, 65g unsalted butter and a vanilla pod over hot water.
- Pour the hot white chocolate mix into 180ml double cream, 50g of caster sugar, 500g of cream cheese & 1 packet of raspberries.
- Mix this altogether.
- Crush 300g digestive biscuits till it resembles breadcrumbs, poor over 140g of melted unsalted butter.
- Press the biscuit mix into the bottom of a 20cm circle tin.
- Top with the white chocolate cream mix
- Let it chill overnight.



Lead up all a D. forwards and back, set and turn S. That again.

The men take all hands, and the women hands meet all a D. back again; the first on each side go under the others arms on their own side, and meet below. Hands again, and the next Cu. as much. Hands again, and the next Cu as much.

Sides all, set and turn single. That again. As before

Arms all, set and turn S. That again. As before.

Fortunately, our callers are a bit less cryptic.

Hagley String Orchestra

We're having much fun playing an exuberant, little-known symphony by Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847). Like Mozart, who had died 18 years earlier, Mendelssohn was an amazing child prodigy, and he composed twelve symphonies for string orchestra between the ages of 12 and 14! These were written for performances by a private orchestra in his family home for the Berlin intellectual elite. We are playing No. 8 in D major.

He took as his model a typical Haydn 'classical' symphony of four movements – fast, slow, a Minuet, fast. The Sonata Form 1st Movement opens with a short, slow Introduction in D minor, leading to an Exposition in the major. This is repeated as was customary, before a Development section and final Recapitulation. And then, surprise, surprise, for his 2nd Movement he writes a not-to-slow Adagio in which all 1st and 2nd violins are silent i.e. 'tacet'. Instead of the bright-sounding violins, he divides the violas into three parts with cello/bass accompaniment resulting in a dark, sombre tone quality. Is the young lad intentionally breaking new ground? Is this a symphonic first!

Thank goodness we've got four jolly good viola players to luxuriate in this unusual piece. How about joining in; for more info please contact Haydn Thomas (01562) 885252; sanhay50@gmail.com .

As with Mozart, who died just before he became 36, Mendelssohn died young at the tragically early age of 38 after a series of strokes.

Hand & Tower Bellringers On 11 November 2018, 100 years since Armistice, bells will ring out in unison from churches and cathedrals in villages, towns and cities across the country. Big Ben will also strike at 11am to mark the centenary.

Church bells across the UK remained restricted throughout the course of the war until Armistice was declared on 11 November 1918.

The heavy fall of snow meant that it was felt to be dangerous to expect members to venture out and efforts were made to inform everyone of the cancellation.


If, by any mischance some members were not contacted and actually arrived at the Community Centre the Committee's profound apologies to you.
