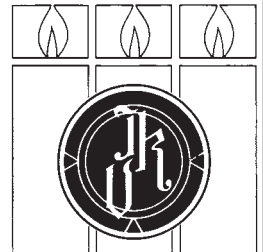

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

The Bromsgrove District Development Plan's current position is that it now requires it to prepare a Local Plan Review; this takes the form of a 'Local Development Scheme'.

- The implications of this review is to conduct a Greenbelt review to identify housing land for Bromsgrove's housing needs for the period 2023-2030.
- This will also include identifying land to help deliver the housing needs of the West Midlands Conurbation for the period 2023-2030.
- Both Councillor Colella and Councillor Jenkins voted against the continued discussions with the West Midlands Conurbation.
- A motion put before the District Council by Cllr Colella that asked that discussions are suspended with the West Midlands Combined Authority was defeated.
- The Greenbelt review will commence later this year.

As the planning process continues the various stages of the plan will be publically consulted upon, including District Councillors, Hagley Parish Council and the Neighbourhood Planning Team. At each consultation stage there will be the opportunity to make comments directly to the planning team at Bromsgrove District Council.

VILLAGE INFORMATION

Hagley Parish Council

HPC maintains the area off Chestnut Drive known as 'Sweetpool Nature reserve' as an open space with the intension of ensuring that it enhances the natural environment of the area and is protected from development.

Whilst it has not been recognised as a formal Nature Reserve it consists of a mix of wetland, open grassed space and wooded area. The area has recently suffered from ASB and it was regarded that the features of the area created an attraction as a 'hang-out' in areas that cannot be overlooked. The issue with ASB has been a matter that the Police have been dealing with and as part of this action there have been discussions between the Parish Council and the District Council. These discussions are in respect of what environmental management options there are that will discourage ASB as well as being sensitive to the environmental aspect of the area.

There are currently three allotment plots available (off Church St). Anyone that is interested please contact the clerk.

I would like to extend a very warm welcome to eight new volunteers to the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan working group. The new volunteers bring a wealth of experience, technical skills and knowledge to the group. A consultation strategy is being drawn up followed by a series of questionnaires on such as matters as housing, traffic, the environment and amenities.

The replacement of street lighting is continuing in the Long Compton area. These replace the old style lamps with LEDs, which are more efficient and effective.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

January saw a spate of car break-ins using a sophisticated electronic device which deflects signals from key-fobs that are within the property. The assailant does not need to gain access to the property or even to know where the key-fob is kept.

The crime called 'relay attack' is aimed at the most modern vehicles whereby the key sends out a message to unlock the vehicle of its own volition as the vehicle is approached. Vehicles with the older style press button key-fob cannot be activated using this device.

In order to offer a defence against such an intrusion there is a 'pouch' which when the key-fob is stored in deflects any such signals and as such negates the attempted unforced vehicle entry. These can be found in any outlet that sells household and personal security protection systems.

However, it should be remembered that any vehicle is an easy target and valuables should be removed from the vehicle and checked that it is locked when unattended.

Lords Arms Orphanage by Esther Gittoes



Her warm skin touches mine as she places her sagging arms around my neck. Her tears escape her watery eyes but no English words depart her lips, instead she smiles and releases tears of appreciation. My eyes too begin to well up; perhaps my small act of kindness will have a great impact on these children's lives. My homestay translates the ladies broken words and repeats them back to me.

"She was unsure of how she was going to afford the rent next month".

£50 was all that I had donated along with book supplies, stickers, and pens. I hold Grandma tight and smile into her scrunched up face. The orphans refer to this woman as Grandma; she is their provider, carer and saviour. I wander the orphanage school for one last time before I head back to England. I have visited this school many times during my six-week trip to Ghana but this would be the last time.

I beam towards the recognisable faces of the children and we greet each other with a hug.

"Obruni" (Ghanaian word for Westerner) they scream to me.

Most of the children here are orphans and the other children come here to go to school, although I'm not entirely sure that I can call it a school. There is one classroom outside which is structured from sheets of wood. The teachers volunteer and some are not even qualified. The older children tend to do the younger children's exams and sometimes it's two children to one seat. But their smiles are infectious as we practice the clap

game they had taught me last week.

Each child is wearing different school uniforms, some are in their own clothes and some clearly in their sibling's dress. Both the boys and girls heads are shaved, I'm told this is for hygiene reasons as well as keeping cool in the hot weather. Perhaps this is also the reason as to why they have a fascination with my long curly hair.

"Can I do your hair", the girls would beg.

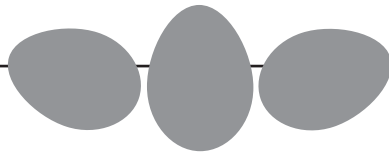
After a while I give in and the one girl scrapes every strain of hair back, pulling with all her strength to tame it into a French plait. Grandma shouts at the children to calm them down. She is wearing a bright red flamed inspired Ed Hardy top and has a piece of cloth that is used to tie up her hair, keeping it off her face.

The children take me into a room where a child is sleeping on the floor, in the same room a chicken wanders around. They share a room, a home and a life together. The ages of the children vary and most never leave. My host Sam tells me that the majority of the children who aren't adopted will live here all of their lives and then help out with the other orphans. The children here will most likely become street sellers, earning pence selling goods on the side of the roads. Outside the house but still within the compound the ground is rocky and some children walk around bare foot. There is no structure here, no different ability classes, no qualified teachers or hygienic living conditions. But where else would these children go? Without this establishment most of the local children will have no education and the orphans no home.

I look towards the handmade coat pegs hanging on the wall. Tattered rucksacks are placed on the crooked pegs, attached dangerously to the wooden sheet wall. But I can't help but smile, their contagious spirit encourages a grin as I watch them laugh and play. Here a child has nothing but a pure soul full of aspiration and laughter.

I wave one last time as I depart the orphanage that has impacted my life more than I ever imagined at the age of eighteen. Most people my age would have never experienced poverty like that. They stand in front of their compound door and wave to me, still smiling.

1. Line a cake tin with 12 fairy cases
2. Melt the chocolate, golden syrup and butter in a bowl set over a pan of gently simmering water. Stir this mixture until smooth.
3. Remove from the heat and stir the cornflakes into the bowl, until all the cereal is covered.
4. Divide the mixture into the cases and position 3 chocolate eggs on top.
5. Chill in the fridge for 1 hour to set.

Hagley Historical and Field Society



I am sure you will have heard of or even visited the Lost Gardens of Heligan in Cornwall. I suspect it is less likely that you have heard of the Lost Garden of Halesowen. Our speakers this month were Mick and Carole Freer and their topic was 'Leasowes Walled Garden – Lost in Time'.

The Leasowes, once internationally famous for its design and beauty, is the mid 18th Century creation of the poet, William Shenstone. A reflection of its importance is its designation as a Grade 1 Listed Garden. It vied in importance with Hagley Park and Enville Hall. The Walled Garden which lies at its heart together with an outer garden cover about two acres and although they have been in existence for 240 years their historical significance has not been understood. The fact that it is unknown is largely due to it not being open to the public, being used as a storage compound for the Council's Parks Department and latterly as an educational Horticultural College.

Mick and Carole are members of the Halesowen Abbey Trust, which purchased the garden in 2014 and dedicated it to public benefit in perpetuity. Work has recently started by an army of volunteers to restore it to its former glory and we hope to invite them both back in the future to review their progress.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 6th March 2018 at 8.00pm with a presentation by Derek Clarke RIBA entitled "The Repair of the Old Royal Naval College at Greenwich". Visitors are most welcome at all our events – see hhfs.org.uk for details and contacts.

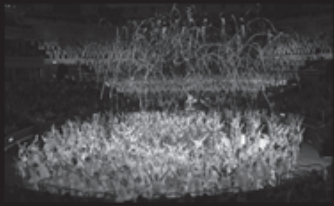

Hagley String Orchestra

We seem to be concentrating on composers' youthful works this term. Haydn wrote his *Cassation* in his early twenties, and Mendelssohn composed his *8th String Symphony* when he was about 14. Another amazingly talented youth was Benjamin Britten (1913-1976).

We're playing Britten's *Simple Symphony*, which he wrote in 1934 when he was 20. However, the tunes he uses in this 4-movement piece he originally composed from the age of 11. He had begun piano lessons when he was 7, and these early pieces were written for solo piano. He became a superb pianist, particularly in accompaniment, although his shyness made him reticent in performing in public. The world-renowned accompanist Gerald Moore wrote that he avoided playing at the Aldeburgh Festival 'as the presiding genius there is the greatest accompanist in the world.'

The *Simple Symphony* is in the traditional Classic symphonic format: 'Boisterous Bourrée'; 'Playful Pizzicato'; 'Sentimental Saraband' and 'Frolicsome Finale'. Britten's string orchestration inspired by these piano pieces is masterly, but the 'Simple' title is a misnomer as technically the music is challenging! Britten dedicated this work to his viola teacher.
