

# **BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE**

Updates from both District Councillors were given at the Annual Parish Council meeting on the 26th March. I've summarised the various updates presented at the meeting and will form part of the HPC minute.

- As District Councillors it's pleasing to be involved in a number of activities bringing betterment to Hagley.
- Actively involved in various Boards, Committees and working groups.
- Attended Cabinet on a number of occasions to speak on local issues; full council meetings with very forth right challenges in respect of policies and decisions.
- As Independent Councillors our group is now numerically equal as the opposition Group.
- Top Issues faced by BDC in coming year
- The Government's consultation on a 'Negative Grant fund' which will effectively reduce annual income by £750,000; efficiency savings review is essential.
- Hagley Air Quality Management Area has been reclassified; good news that these air pollutants are reducing; there will be increased monitoring points and investigations into sensitive NOX and particulate matter monitors along the A456 and A491.
- Continued Challenge of WCC on highways and transport planning issues.
- The whole district of Bromsgrove faces housing and transient traffic from growth in the Wyre Forest, Black Country and Birmingham areas.
- Pleasing to be able to support significant bids from NHB and the BDC Community Support grant for Hagley betterment. Significant inward investment received for community projects.
- ... then there's the everyday issues important to individual resident households keeping the role of the district councillor very active, rewarding and undoubtedly important.

# Hagley Parish Council Update

I start with thanking Jane Morris for her service as a Hagley Parish councillor. Jane has made a fantastic contribution to HPC and been instrumental in a number of positive contributions, non-least the setting up and administration of the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan group. Jane has had to reluctantly resign due to personal reasons; on behalf of everyone at HPC and those that know her I wish her the very best for future. At the time of writing we are in the process of co-opting a new member which I'll report on in the June edition.

After a very cold, snowy and soggy winter the Pavilion and the playing fields are gathering speed having taken advantage of much better weather. During the Easter holiday the skate ramps had to be briefly closed due to essential repair. These repairs have now been completed and normal service has resumed.

It has been resolved that the 'haul road' between Victoria Passage and the Pavilion will be reverted back to part of the playing field after the completion of the re-build. The route is currently for safe access to and from the site. It was also resolved that no further path lighting will be installed along the same access points.

At a meeting in early April we received a presentation on new outdoor gym equipment to be installed in the playing fields. This follows successful section 106 negotiations from housing development in Hagley. Full details are available on HPC webpage or via the Clerk.

# Hagley Neighbourhood Watch May update

At the time of writing we are aware that PC Burling (retired) and PCSO Chelsea Lloyd (joined Police force as a full time officer) have left the Policing Team. We all wish them the very best for the future and thank them sincerely for the help and support that they have given to Hagley.

Further to this there are concerns that these two very important and valued posts remain unfilled. Through various means our concerns have been made clear to the Policing authorities that it is essential that replacements are in post as a matter of urgency.

There is a public consultation being run by the Police and Crime Commissioner across West Mercia (includes Hagley) whereby views on local policing are sought. This opened early April and will run until 6th of July 2018.

At the time of writing further details are unknown but the survey covers a range of subjects, including the visibility of local policing, relationships with officers and local crime priorities.

Between writing this update and being published in the News efforts will be made by the NHW coordinators to find out more details of how to get involved and to ensure that everyone is given the opportunity to express their views.

The aim of the survey is hoped to inform priorities for the PCC and the police force as well as identifying where and how local police relationships are working well, or if they can be improved.





# HAYBRIDGE HIGH SCHOOL

Haybridge High School and Sixth Form

on a range of topics by means of online surveys. Firstly, we have been conducting an extensive 'Student Wellbeing Survey', which has had a fantastic response – almost 800 responses at the time of writing. Our 'Social Media Usage Survey' has had 400 responses from students across the year groups and provided us with over 50 pages of student-eye-level insights and experiences of their lives online – the positive and the negative. We are listening carefully to what we are being told by both surveys in order to plan how best to advise and support our young people – and how to take the great advice they themselves are offering to us.

Sixth Form students who took part in the annual 'Lessons from Auschwitz' educational programme, including a one day visit to Auschwitz-Birkenau in March returned deeply impressed and moved by their experiences and are full of ideas on how to work with their peers to share their insights.

This academic year we have substantially increased the number of students going to Parliament for guided tours and interactive workshops with the Parliamentary Education Service. By the end of May over 100 students will have spent the day in Westminster getting acquainted with the work of MPs, debates and law-making. The better informed they are the better able to be active citizens.

Looking ahead to our Meeting on Friday, 8th June, Di Cope, visiting Artist, is coming to demonstrate "Collage/Mixed Media.



May day this year falls on the 7th of May. It's a traditional Pagan Anglo-Saxon custom, which marks the beginning of summer. May day is a celebration of things coming to life, with maypole dancing being a poplar tradition. Maypole dancing is a way of saying farewell to winter.

- 8. Relax and enjoy yourself at the local spa, take a book and just unwind.
- 9. Make May Day special for your four-legged friend and go for a big refreshing spring walk.
- 10. Wine and dine a special someone at one of the many local restaurants.



I'm leaning over the bamboo balcony on a crisp Thursday morning, enjoying the moment of serenity. It's the wet season, but the air feels dry and the sun beats down on my exposed shoulders. I fixate my stare down to the backwaters hearing nothing but the cooks preparing our breakfast. The shirtless men on the wooden canoe like boats paddle on the backwaters. This is Kerala, the southern most point of India considered the most peaceful part of the country. As I open the double door French windows on to the world I enjoy the moment of true peace and blank space.

I'm staying in an eco resort in Kerala, which seems a million miles away from the true Indian atmosphere. Les Three Elephants is where we are, owned and ran by a French couple. This little slice of serene is exactly what I need. Just a five-minute walk from Les three elephants and you're at the beach, a very secluded and an almost abandoned beach. However every weekend the coastline becomes swarmed with coaches full of Indian tourists seeking refuge from the cities to this paradise. I sit and watch the beautiful Indian women in their colourful saris become consumed by the waves, laughing together despite their unusual bathing attire. They smile, they tease and they are all so full of seawater. A few hours pass and they get back on the coaches and begin their journey back to the cities.

Like most Eco resorts this one is alcohol free, a somewhat nightmare to the modern everyday man. However the feeling of being stripped from modern day indulges is refreshing and unique. I embrace this change, although there is a seafront bar not too far for that moment of relapse. In the evenings I spend my time in the small library, shielded from the mosquitos in my Indian silk shawl.

The restaurant is lit by candlelight as we enjoy the homemade curries. The taste of the spices inhabits my tongue and the tangy aroma fills my nostrils. I sit silently, appreciating the feeling of nothingness as I watch the men canoe back down the backwaters.

The Campaign will keep this traditional British art alive in memory of the 1,400 who lost their lives – linking together past, present and future.

# **Hagley Historical and Field Society**



The building of the Royal Naval College, Greenwich which started in 1696, was the result of the collaboration between Christopher Wren and Nicholas Hawksmoor. These two were also responsible for the building of St. Paul's Cathedral after the Great Fire of London. Apart from the beauty of its architecture, it claims to have

Britain's largest painted ceiling.

Unfortunately, over the years, while the Navy has trained some of our finest seamen there it has neglected the maintenance of the buildings to the point where serious restoration was required. Our speaker this month, Derek Clarke, described this restoration work which his architectural partnership undertook and his part in managing the project.

The original building was undertaken in a time of austerity and there is evidence of cost cutting. While the outward facing walls are faced with limestone the less obvious walls are faced with brick. At least the bricks were made in Birmingham, which partly makes up for it.

Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 1st May 2018 at 8.00pm. It is our annual Social Evening. There will be the usual refreshments followed by a 'gentle' quiz. # Hagley String Orchestra

We began our Summer Term on Tuesday 17th of April, finishing on the 10th of July (omitting Half Term on 29th of May) which gives us 12 rehearsals playing works by Andrew Downes, Prokofiev, Puccini, Telemann and 16th century Thomas Tomkins – quite a variety!

We're enjoying playing a little known work by Ignaz Pleyel (1757-1831). I guess that, if you've heard of Pleyel, it will be with Pleyel pianos which he began manufacturing in Paris in 1807 when he was 50. Chopin loved these pianos and both performed and composed using them.

However, before that Pleyel was famous in Europe as a composer. He was the 24th child out of a total of 38, which I find exhausting! He was a favourite pupil of Haydn, and Gluck, hearing one of his early compositions said "Young friend, now that you have learnt how to put notes on paper, all you need to learn is how to erase some of them again." Sensible advice!

Another interesting suggestion is that the theme for Brahms' *Variations on a Theme by Haydn*, was probably composed by Pleyel, and not by Haydn – well, well!




# Ladies of Hagley Shield.
